FIU COMBAT CLASSIC

UAB will kick off the 2012 campaign at the FIU Combat Classic in Miami, Fla., Friday. The Classic features six teams and a total of 15 games that will be played over the three-day span. The Blazers will take on tough competition in No. 25 Louisville and UMass, who is currently receiving votes in the national polls. The Green and Gold is also slated for matchups against first-time opponent Illinois, Michigan State and host FIU.

Last season, the Blazers went 39-19 overall, tying the most wins in school history, and 17-6 in C-USA play, the most league wins in program history. UAB returns six position starters and four pitchers to the 2012 roster, including All-C-USA Second Team selection Mandy Lowman and All-Freshman Team member Leigh Streetman.

STARTING OFF RIGHT

With just 12 years of competition under its belt, UAB has been able to post an impressive record in season openers. Despite losing the 2011 opener, UAB has an impressive 8-4 record in season openers. The Blazers' only losses in season openers came in 2000 against Auburn, 2001 against Troy, 2009 against LSU and 2011 against Jacksonville State. Between 2002 and 2008 the Blazers were 7-0.

SCOUTING UMASS

UMass ended the 2011 campaign 29-19 overall and 14-5 in the Atlantic 10, finishing in second place in the conference. Currently, the Minutewomen are receiving votes in the national polls. This year the Minutewomen return eight of their starters and lost just two from last season, including two-time Atlantic 10 Pitcher of the Year Sara Plourde.

UAB and UMass have met one time in history. The Blazers won that contest 1-0 in eight innings on March 4, 2011 as part of the Buzz Classic hosted by Georgia Tech.

SCOUTING LOUISVILLE

Louisville is currently ranked No. 25 in the nation in the USA Today/NFCA Division I pre-season poll and is receiving votes in the latest ESPN.com/USA Softball poll. The Cardinals finished 2011 with a 38-20 overall record and 12-7 mark in the Big East. The Cardinals earned their eighth consecutive NCAA bid, but went 1-2 in regional play.

Louisville leads the all-time series 17-3. UAB fell, 6-1, in the teams' last meeting, which came on March 30, 2005 in Louisville, Ky.

SCOUTING ILLINOIS

Illinois wrapped up its 2011 season at 27-22 overall, while placing third among Big Ten teams with a 12-8 conference record. The Fighting Illini return five positions starters and two pitchers in 2012.

The Feb. 11 matchup will mark the first between UAB and Illinois.

SCOUTING MICHIGAN STATE

The Spartans closed out the 2011 campaign with a 27-27 overall mark and 6-14 Big Ten record. The team returns 13 letterwinners, including senior standout Brett Williams behind the plate. Williams batted .336 with 34 runs, 52 RBI and 13 homers.

The Blazers trail the Spartans 1-0 in the all-time series. The teams' last meeting was on Feb. 15, 2008 in Tallahassee, Fla. as part of the Seminole Classic. UAB dropped that contest 5-1.

SCOUTING FIU

Tournament host FIU went 31-27 overall and 14-10 in the Sun Belt last season. The Panthers are lead by first-year head coach Jake Schumann and return three all-conference players in senior outfielder/pitcher Ashley McClain and junior infielders Jessy Alfonso and Kayla

Burri.

UAB and FIU have competed against each other just once before in Miami, Fla. on Feb. 11, 2005. The Panthers defeated the Blazers, 3-0, in that contest.

2012 BLAZERS

The 2012 squad returns 15 letterwinners and six starting position players, including 2011 All-Conference USA Second Team selection Mandy Lowman and C-USA All-Freshman Team and NFCA All-Region Second Team member Leigh Streetman.

UAB returns four pitchers from last season's 2011 NCAA tournament team in senior Amber Torres, junior Lauren Webster and sophomores Lannah Campbell and Leigh Streetman.

Behind the plate, senior standout Mandy Lowman, who started all 58 games, returns for the Blazers last year, returns as the starter for the 2012 season. The Huntsville, Ala. product owned a .242 batting average, knocked in 20 runs and ranked third in the league with 29 walks. She also tallied the third-most putouts (412) and tied first in runners caught stealing (17) in C-USA.

With six position starters returning and the addition of two newcomers, the Blazers will have plenty of depth in the infield this season.

Senior Erica Sisson returns for the Blazers at first base. Sisson started 42 games primarily at first base last season where she tallied the second-most putouts (212) for UAB and committed just four errors for a .982 fielding percentage.

The Blazers have options at second base with freshman Amy Dennis and Webster competing for the starting job.

At shortstop, there is a three-way competition among senior Catherine Crawford, red-shirt-freshman Heather Pearson and freshman Hayley Davis.

At the hot corner, junior Kate Armstrong and sophomore Kristen McGrath will be competing to be the primary starter. Armstrong started all 58 games a season ago, registering a .265 batting average and a .374 slugging percentage.

The outfield will see a lot of competition due to the departures of 2011 seniors Caley Walden and Sallie Van Kirk. Senior Tiffany Smith, junior transfer Whitney Fletcher and junior Hailey Glynn will see time in the grass. Orr and Crawford could also play in the outfield.

BLAZERS PICKED TO FINISH THIRD IN C-USA

The Blazers have been picked to finish third in this season's conference race. Tulsa was picked to win the league in 2012, receiving 79 points and seven first-place votes from C-USA's nine head coaches. Houston was chosen to finish as the runner-up with 67 points and one first-place vote, and UAB was picked to round out the top three preseason selections,

receiving 60 points and one first-place vote.

TIED THE MOST WINS IN UAB HISTORY

With 39 wins last season, UAB tied the record for most wins in program history, set by the 2002 squad (39-22).

The Blazers picked up the record-tying win when they blanked Florida State, 2-0, in the opening game of the Athens Regional in the 2011 NCAA Softball Championship on May 20.

SECOND-STRAIGHT NCAA APPEARANCE

The UAB softball team achieved its second NCAA Championship bid in as many years in 2011. The Blazers received one of the tournament's 34 at-large invitations for the second year in a row.

UAB was one of five C-USA schools to compete in the NCAA tournament. C-USA regular season co-champions Houston and Tulsa also received bids, along with C-USA tournament champion East Carolina and Memphis.

The Blazers competed in the double-elimination tournament at the Athens Regional in Athens, Ga. UAB shut out Florida State, 2-0, in the first round before falling to host and No. 6 seed Georgia, 9-2, and then dropping the rematch against FSU, 13-1 (6) in an elimination game.

30-WIN MARK

The 2011 season was the second-straight year that the Blazers earned at least 30 wins and the fifth 30-win season in UAB lore. The Blazers earned their 30th win with a 7-0 victory over Jacksonville State on April 15.

In addition, UAB began conference play with a perfect 6-0 record, another first in school history. The Blazers swept back-to-back league series against then-No. 25 Houston and Southern Miss.

ALL-CONFERENCE HONOREES

Centerfielder Caley Walden was named to the 2011 All-Conference USA First Team and catcher Mandy Lowman earned second-team honors. Pitcher Leigh Streetman rounded out the Blazer honorees, earning all-freshman team accolades. Walden and Lowman each earned their second career all-conference accolades. Walden was named to the all-freshman team in 2008, while Lowman received first-team honors in 2010.

13 YEARS AND COUNTING

The 2012 season marks the 13th year of competition for UAB softball. The Blazers have an all-time record of 343-355 (.492) and a Conference USA record of 128-137 (.483). UAB has recorded five 30-win seasons and reached seven conference tournaments, including reaching the 2002 championship game.

14th Season

Alabama, 1986

Townsend's 13th at the helm of the UAB softball program and the campaign was one to remember for the Blazers.

Named UAB's first head coach on Sept. 1, 1998, Townsend has guided the program since its infancy. Since coming to UAB, Townsend has coached 40 all-conference athletes and has guided the Blazers to an all-time record of 343-355 (.491) and Conference USA mark of 128-137 (.483).

UAB enjoyed one of its most successful season in school history in 2011 as the Blazers earned the program's second consecutive invitation to the NCAA Championship. UAB's win total (39) tied the most in program history set in 2002 and the 17 victories in Conference USA play surpassed the school record (15).

In addition, three players were named to the Conference USA All-Academic Team, representing the most selections in program history and the most among any C-USA team in 2011. Furthermore, the Blazers began conference play with a perfect 6-0 record for the first time in school history.

The 2010 season was also one for the record books as the Blazers earned the program's first-ever invitation to the NCAA Championship. UAB's win total (37) marked the second-highest in school history and the 15 victories in Conference USA play tied the school record at the time. The Blazers were never ranked lower than No. 38 in the RPI during the season.

In addition, UAB had six players named to all-conference teams, including three first-team performers. The Blazers also had four student-athletes receive all-region accolades.

The Blazers concluded their 2009 campaign with an overall record of 21-34 and placed seventh in Conference USA with an 8-16 record. Outfielder Martina Landrum and outfielder/infielder Catherine Douglass, earned all-conference accolades.

The 2011 season was Marla

In 2008, Townsend and her squad ended the season at 24-35 (9-15 CUSA). Infielder Holly Krzan also concluded her career on top, capturing the all-time records for doubles, games played, games started, total bases and walks. Freshmen Laura Callaway and Caley Walden picked up nominations to the C-USA All-Freshman team. Townsend herself also received honors when she was inducted into the Alabama Amateur Softball Association's Hall of Fame.

For Townsend and her 2007 Blazer squad, the season featured several record-breaking performances and new milestones. Townsend earned her 200th career victory in February as the Blazers won the USF "The Game" Tournament. The Blazers finished the season 31-27 (10-13 C-USA). Centerfielder Lindsay Stanley, who broke the school's career record with 100 stolen bases, earned first-team all-conference honors, while shortstop Krzan was named to the second team.

The 2006 season marked the Blazers' best campaign in four years as they finished 31-22 overall and tied for second in Conference USA. Townsend guided her team to a 15-9 C-USA record and received the C-USA Coach of the Year award. The Blazers earned six spots on the C-USA All-Conference teams. Krzan and Stanley took home first-team honors, while Jennifer Nelson and Kayla Harris were named to the second-team. Harris, along with Andrea Rogers, also earned all-freshman honors.

During the 2005 season, Townsend led the Blazers to a 23-37 mark as UAB finished seventh in the conference. Stanley was named second-team all-conference while Amanda Antonovich was named to the all-freshman team.

The 2004 campaign saw the Blazers post at least 20 wins for the fifth season in a row and was one in which UAB claimed two tournament titles. UAB also placed two players on the all-conference team, as Beth Mullins was named to the second team and Krzan made the all-freshman squad.

In 2003, the Blazers posted their fourth-consecutive 20-win campaign and advanced to the Conference USA Tournament for the fourth straight season.

Prior to the 2002 season, UAB was picked to finish seventh in the C-USA preseason polls, but Townsend's team proved the critics wrong by placing third in the regular-season standings with a 14-10 record. The program's accomplishments did not go unnoticed as Townsend was named the C-USA Coach of the Year by a vote of her peers in the coaching community.

The Blazers' success in 2002 followed a rigorous 2001 season in which UAB finished with a 27-35 overall mark and ended the year as the sixth-place team in the C-USA standings (10-11 record).

In 2000 -- UAB's inaugural season -- Townsend guided the team to a 23-38 overall record and a fifth-place finish in the conference.
