Program Title: Camp Architecture

Event Description: What is it like to be an architect? How do architects design buildings? Is it true that you don't have to be good at math to be an architect? (YES!).

These summer day-programs for students are fun and educational. While learning about sustainability and careers in the design professions, participants learn to draw (by hand and on the computer), construct models (in the School's Materials Lab), and test structural models (by destroying them in a HI-TECH compression instrument). Taught by the inspiring and vivacious young architect Madeline Gradillas, an adjunct professor at the School of Architecture, students will get a unique glimpse into the world of design while acquiring skills unavailable outside of a college setting.

Designed for middle school and high school students, CAMP Architecture is a five-day sequence of highly orchestrated workshops.

Session B - available to rising 6th graders to rising 8th graders, June 27 to July 1

Session C - available to rising 6th graders to rising 8th graders, July 11 to July 15

Session D - available to rising 11th and 12th graders, July 18 to July 22
