Arizona Rivers - Riparian Research Experience (RRE)

This field experience takes 10 high school students on a 2-week journey of discovery, adventure and learning - visiting and collecting hydrology and ecology data from dozens of Arizona's precious desert streams. The RRE begins with an intensive 3-day field methods workshop, which is also accessible by the student's teacher or mentor. Students are encouraged to develop follow-up projects near their homes over the following year. Many expert scientists and naturalists join the students in the field and share their perspective of natural history and riparian management. Participants should be in good physical shape due to summer temperatures and some hiking.
