



Boardwalk Hall, Atlantic City, NJ

The 31st annual Atlantic 10 Men's Basketball Championship returns to the East Coast as the league will hold its 2007 and 2008 championships at Boardwalk Hall in Atlantic City, NJ.

"We are delighted that the Atlantic 10's premier event will be held in one of the country's premier entertainment centers," says A-10 commissioner Linda Bruno. "Atlantic City has undergone a tremendous revitalization in recent years, as anyone who has been there recently can attest. Boardwalk Hall, which has also undergone a remarkable renovation, is a beautiful venue for college basketball. The city offers our alumni and fans great family entertainment and the Atlantic 10 will keep up its end of the bargain by providing great basketball in 2007 and 2008."

"We are thrilled that the A-10 has recognized Atlantic City as a premier destination with a first-class venue," says Jeff Vasser, executive director of the Atlantic City Convention & Visitors Authority. "Our location makes it convenient for most of the schools, fans and alumni to attend the tournament and guests will find our new dining, nightlife and shopping exciting. Boardwalk Hall has a long history of hosting a variety of sporting events and this tournament is helping us to fulfill our goal of showcasing Atlantic City as a must-play market."

Boardwalk Hall was dedicated on May 31, 1929. Known primarily as the home of the Miss America Pageant from 1940-2004, Boardwalk Hall was placed on the United States Register of Historic Places as a National Historic Landmark on Feb. 27, 1987. Most recently, Boardwalk Hall underwent an extensive restoration and rehabilitation process. Begun in November 1998, the five-phase renovation cost \$90 million and transformed Boardwalk Hall into a state-of-the-art special events arena under the auspices of the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority.

Boardwalk Hall has hosted numerous athletic events, including college basketball, world championship boxing, the New Jersey State High School Wrestling Championships, professional tennis, college football, and minor league hockey. The format of the 31st annual Championship remains the same. The top 12 teams will compete in the Championship, which begins on Wednesday, March 7, with opening round play. The winners will then join the top four seeds for quarterfinal round action on Thursday, March 8. The semifinal will take place on Friday, March 9, with the final round being played on Saturday, March 10. 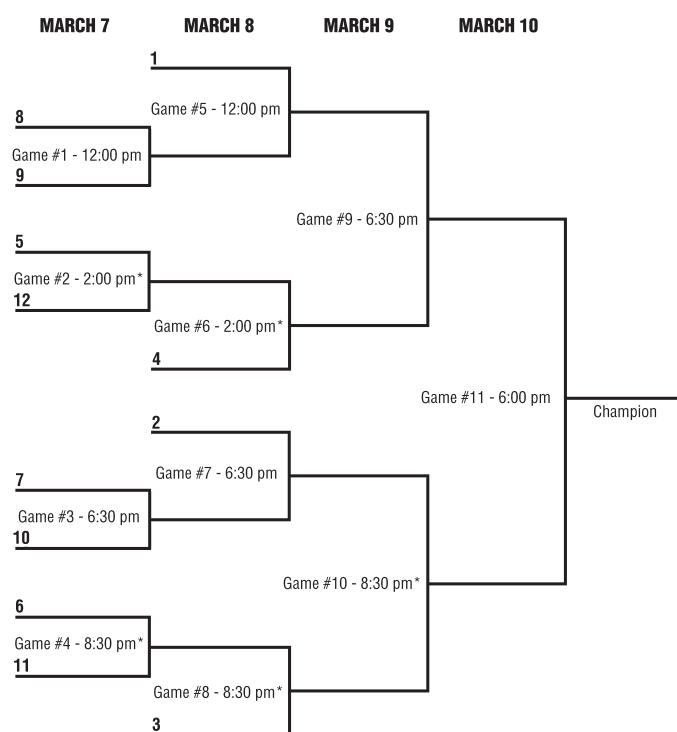

### Atlantic 10 Championship Tie-Breaker

The following tie-breaker format is utilized for determining the seeding in the Atlantic 10 Men's Basketball Championship:

#### TWO-TEAM TIE

- Head-to-head competition.
- Conference record of the tied teams based on winning percentage versus the highest common opponent and proceeding down to the lowest common opponent, if necessary, until one team gains an advantage.
  - All ties are broken in descending order.
  - When arriving at another pair of tied teams, use each team's record against the tied teams as a group. When comparing records against a group of teams, the higher winning percentage will prevail. In case of tied percentages vs. the team or group of 1.000 or .000, the following shall apply: 2-0 is better than 1-0; 0-1 is better than 0-2.
- Coin toss.

#### THREE OR MORE-TEAM TIE

- Head-to-head competition.
  - Use each team's record against the tied teams as a group rather than performance against individual teams. When comparing records against a group of teams, the higher winning percentage will prevail. In case of tied percentages vs. the team or group of 1.000 or .000, the following shall apply: 2-0 is better than 1-0; 0-1 is better than 0-2.
- If the above results in two teams remaining, the two-team tiebreaker is used.
- If more than two teams still remain, use the Conference record of the tied teams based on winning percentage versus the highest common opponent and proceeding down to the lowest common opponent, if necessary, until one team gains an advantage.
  - All ties are broken in descending order.
  - When arriving at another pair of tied teams, use each team's record against the tied teams as a group. When comparing records against a group of teams, the higher winning percentage will prevail. In case of tied percentages vs. the team or group of 1.000 or .000, the following shall apply: 2-0 is better than 1-0; 0-1 is better than 0-2.
- Draw lots.

Players and Rookies of the Week and standings are released on Mondays with statistics available on Tuesdays. Men's and women's basketball service bureaus are updated daily during the season and available on the web usually by noon. Basketball and Football Players and Rookies of the Week are announced on Sundays.

### PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

The Atlantic 10 selects a player and rookie of the week in each of its sports. The men's and women's basketball honorees are announced on Sundays during the season with all other award winners announced on Mondays.

# A LOOK BACK...

## XAVIER WINS A-10 CROWN

The 2006 Atlantic 10 Championship will go down as one of the most unpredictable in the history of the Conference. First off, 10th-seeded Xavier became the lowest seed in A-10 history to win the title, earning wins over #7 UMass (75-66), #2 Charlotte (59-55), #6 Fordham (70-59), and #5 Saint Joseph's (62-61). Xavier also became the first team in NCAA history to win four games in four days of a conference tournament twice, having previously done that in 2004...Justin Cage garnered Most Outstanding Player honors for leading the Musketeers to the crown. In four games, Cage averaged 14.3 points and 4.3 rebounds. He was joined on the All-Championship Team by teammate Josh Duncan (11.5 ppg, 4.5 rpg), Mardy Collins of Temple (13.7 ppg, 3.7 rpg), Fordham's Bryant Dunston (16.3 ppg, 8.7 rpg), and Chet Stachitas of Saint Joseph's (17.5 ppg, 4.0 rpg)...For the first time in A-10 history, the top four seeds went down in the quarterfinal round as #1 George Washington, #2 Charlotte, #3 La Salle, and #4 Saint Louis all lost their openers.

## THE POSTSEASON

By virtue of its remarkable run in the Atlantic 10 Championship, Xavier garnered the Conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament, while regular season champion George Washington earned at-large berth. The Colonials advanced to second round play with an 88-85 overtime win versus UNC Wilmington before falling to top seed Duke. The Musketeers gave third-seeded Gonzaga all it could handle before succumbing, 79-75...Three A-10 teams were accorded NIT bids as Charlotte, Saint Joseph's, and Temple advanced. The 49ers beat Georgia Southern (77-61) before losing at old nemesis Cincinnati (86-80). The Hawks beat Rutgers (71-62) prior to falling to Hofstra (77-75) in overtime. The Owls, in John Chaney's final official game at Temple, also lost in overtime to Akron (80-73).

## ALL-AMERICANS

Atlantic 10 Player of the Year Steven Smith of La Salle and Temple's Mardy Collins were named Associated Press honorable mention All-Americans. Smith, who became just the fifth player to earn A-10 Player of the Year honors twice, led La Salle to its best-ever finish in the Atlantic 10. The Explorers posted an 18-10 overall mark and a 10-6 record in the Conference, ending the season tied for third. For his part, Smith averaged 19.7 ppg and 7.9 rpg, second and third, respectively, in the league. Collins averaged a team-high 16.8 points and an Atlantic 10-best 2.8 steals a game as the Owls reached the postseason for the 23rd year in a row. The senior concluded his career fourth on Temple's all-time scoring list with 1,919 points.

## SMITH AGAIN EARNS PLAYER OF THE YEAR

La Salle's Steven Smith ended the regular season leading the Atlantic 10 in scoring, averaging 20.0 ppg...the 6-7 senior from Philadelphia was also third in the A-10 in rebounding at 8.0 rpg...his .490 (204-416) field goal percentage ranked fifth in the Conference, while his 14 20-point scoring games led the league...in earning his second Player of the Year award (he shared it with Pat Carroll of Saint Joseph's in 2005), Smith became just the fifth player in league history to earn the honor twice, joining James Bailey of Rutgers (1978, 1979), Earl Belcher of St. Bonaventure (1980, 1981), West Virginia's Greg Jones (1982, 1983), and David West of Xavier (2001, 2002, 2003).

## LIDDELL NAMED ROOKIE OF THE YEAR

Tommy Liddell of Saint Louis earned six Rookie of the Week awards in 2005-06, becoming the ninth player in A-10 history to earn at least that many...the 6-4 guard from East St. Louis, IL, was all over the Billikens' leader board...he was the team's third leading scorer (10.5 ppg) and second leading rebounder (6.9 rpg), while his 76 assists and 28 steals led the team at the conclusion of the regular season...he also had 18 blocked shots - second-most at SLU.

## LASME CLAIMS DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE YEAR AWARD

Stephane Lasme of Massachusetts, who was named the Atlantic 10's Defensive Player of the Year, entered the A-10 Championship as one of the nation's leading shot blockers, ranking third nationally with a 3.89 per game average...the 6-8 junior from Libreville, Gabon, also pulled down 6.9 rebounds per game during the regular season, with six games of at least 10 boards to his credit this season...offensively, he averaged 10.1 ppg during the regular season.

## VOUYOUKAS IS MOST IMPROVED

Ian Vouyoukas of Saint Louis was named the Atlantic 10's Chris Daniels Award winner, presented to the Conference's most improved player...in 2004-05, the 6-10 native of Athens, Greece, averaged 6.9 points and 5.4 rebounds while seeing time in 27 games...this past season, Vouyoukas averaged team highs of 13.9 ppg and 7.3 rpg during the regular season, while his 54 blocked shots also led the Billikens.



## RICE BEST SPARK OFF THE BENCH

George Washington's Maureece Rice became the second consecutive George Washington player to garner Sixth Man honors, following in the footsteps of Danilo Pinnoch...Rice came off the bench in all 27 regular season games for the Colonials to average 12.6 ppg - second-best on the team...the 6-1 sophomore from Philadelphia shot 45.7 percent (128-280) from the field, which included a .398 percentage (35-88) from three-point range...his 81 assists and 43 steals ranked third among the Colonials during the regular season.

## THORNTON REPEATS AS STUDENT-ATHLETE OF THE YEAR

Brian Thornton managed to combine academics and athletics very successfully after transferring to Xavier from Vanderbilt...the 6-8 senior from Louisville, KY, improved his game tremendously from 2004-05 before a broken ankle sustained on Feb. 11 ended his season...

Thornton posted averages of 15.3 points and 6.8 rebounds - both best for the Musketeers...his .640 field goal percentage (114-178) ranked fifth in the nation at the time of his injury...in the classroom, Thornton had a 3.30 graduate school grade point average in Xavier's MBA program...he also earned second-team Academic All-America honors this past season.



## HOBBS TABBED AS COACH OF THE YEAR

Karl Hobbs led George Washington to the fourth perfect record in A-10 history, taking his Colonials to a 16-0 league mark and a 26-1 overall regular season record...the Colonials, who twice reached a high of sixth in the Associated Press and USA Today/ESPN rankings, joined Saint Joseph's (16-0, 2003-04), Temple (18-0, 1987-88), and Temple again (18-0, 1983-84) as those who posted perfect A-10 regular seasons....the Colonials set a school record for wins...GW previously won 24 games in 1954-55 (24-6) and 1997-98 (24-9).

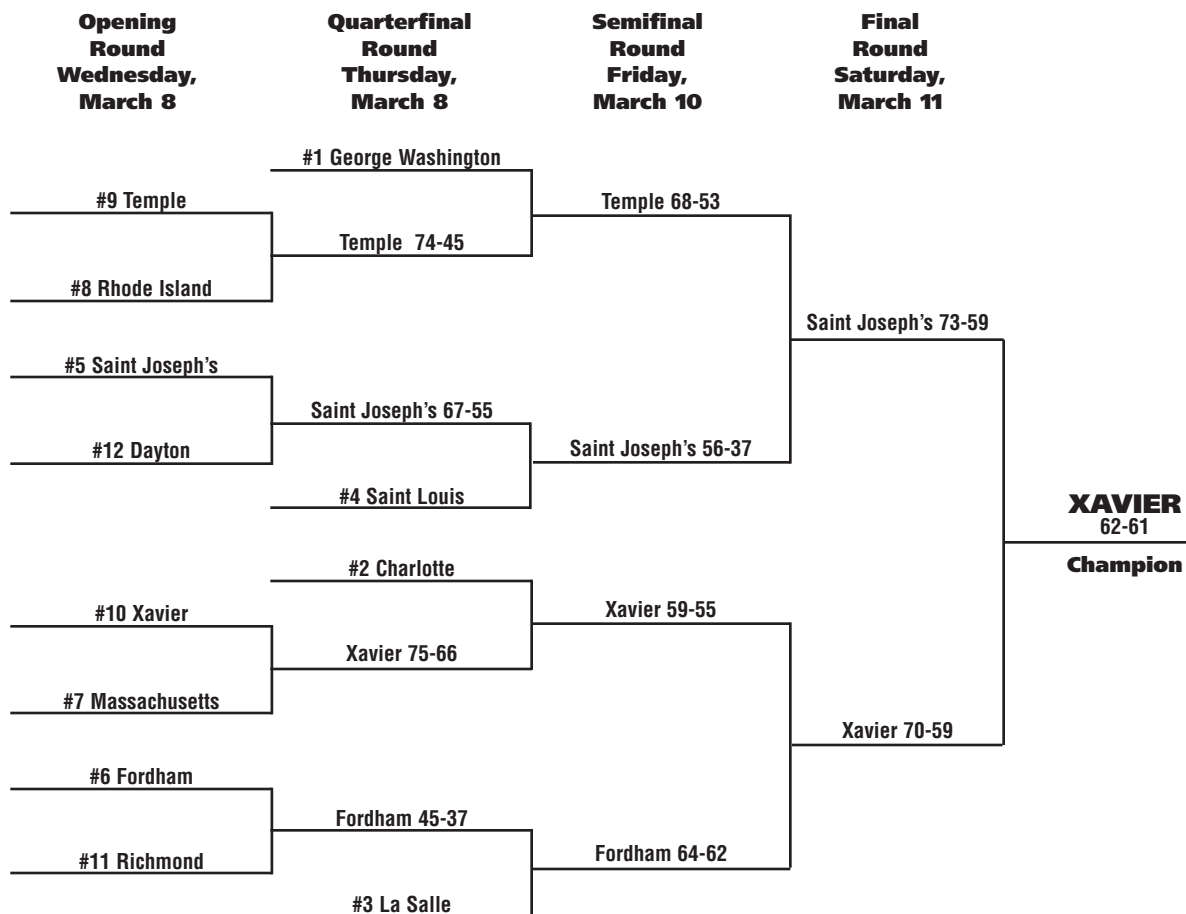
