ST. BONAVENTURE OUTLOOK

Last season, St. Bonaventure fielded a much more competitive team that won eight games and certainly could have surpassed the 10-win mark if several close games fallen its way. Now, as Anthony Solomon enters his fourth season at the helm of the program, the roster is easily the deepest and most talented in his four years, giving the Bonnies' faithful reason to believe that their team will continue to improve.

It has been a while since the Caswell Cyrus-Peter Van Paassen days in the late 1990s that St. Bonaventure featured a frontcourt worth bragging about. Well, this year the Bonnies have something to talk about with 6-8 junior forward Michael Lee and 6-10 senior center Paul Williams. Last year, that duo combined to average 22.8 points, 13.6 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game. Lee finished among the top 20 in the A-10 in scoring (12.7 ppg), rebounding (6.5 rpg) and blocked shots (1.1 bpg). Williams finished seventh in the A-10 in rebounding (7.1 rpg) and averaged 10.1 points per game.

Ivan Kovacevic and David Fox, both 6-10 seniors, and 6-11 redshirt freshman Jeff Foote (15.0 ppg, 13.0 rpg in 2004-05) will back up Williams. At the power forward spot, junior college transfer Lounceny Kaba (6.0 ppg, 5.1 rpg) and freshman Jourdan Morris (14.0 ppg) will compete for time and give the Bonnies additional muscle and rebounding ability. Last season, the Bonnies finished even in rebounding margin, a prime reason for their competitiveness.

Sophomores A.J. Hawkins and Tyler Benson and junior college transfer James Williams will man the small forward spot. Hawkins earned 10 starts last season and averaged 6.3 points per game, while Benson's season was interrupted by an ankle injury. Williams (11.0 ppg, 4.6 rpg) is a versatile small forward who can play inside or on the perimeter.

Point guards Tyler Relph and Terron Diggs will lead a backcourt that is much deeper than in recent seasons. Last year, Relph missed the first nine games due to ankle and foot problems, then struggled to regain his form. He eventually did and wound up averaging 6.9 points per game. If the former New York State player of the year can remain 100 percent healthy, the Bonnies will be a dramatically improved club. Diggs (2.2 ppg, 2.8 apg) provides a steady ball-handling and defensive presence. Newcomers Jermaine Calvin and Zarryon Fereti, former junior college teammates at Southern Idaho, should both see playing time. Calvin (7.6 ppg, 6.0 apg) is a playmaking point guard while Fereti (14.3 ppg, 2.7 apg) is a three-point specialist from Australia with a flair for the dramatic.

SAINT JOSEPH'S

SAINT JOSEPH'S OUTLOOK

Youth will be served as Saint Joseph's head coach Phil Martelli puts one of his youngest groups ever on the floor in 2006-07.

Rob Ferguson, the lone starter from last year, is the team's leading returning scorer (10.3 ppg). The 6-8 junior has always possessed the offensive skills, but last year gained the confidence he needed to become the player everyone felt he was capable of being. Ferguson has good range, shooting 50.2 percent (141-281) from the field and 39.8 percent (35-88) from behind the arc, thus presenting a serious match-up problem for opponents.

Atlantic 10 All-Rookie performer Ahmad Nivins (6.1 ppg, 5.0 rpg) joins Ferguson in the frontcourt after having shown glimpses of his tremendous potential with his athleticism and shot-blocking prowess. Sophomore Alvin Mofunanya (1.4 ppg) got a significant taste of the college game in his first year and will aid the rebounding and defense, as will 6-9 freshman Rockwell Moody (8.0 ppg, 11.0 rpg).

In the backcourt, 6-10 junior Pat Calathes (4.8 ppg, 3.5 rpg) is the Hawks' most experienced player. Calathes was one of the Hawks' bright spots in the latter part of last season, showing a much-improved shooting stroke and an aggressiveness that helped him average 10.7 points, 5.1 rebounds and 2.4 assists down the stretch.

The point guard duties will fall into the hands of two talented freshmen, Jawan Carter and Darrin Govens. The 6-0 Carter was the 2006 Delaware player of the year as he led the Tatnall School to the state title, averaging 29 points and seven assists while finishing his career as the state's all-time leading scorer with 2,464 points. Govens, from Chester High School, was the Class 4A Pennsylvania player of the year as a junior and senior and helped Chester to the 2005 state title. As a senior, he averaged 17.9 points and 4.4 assists.

Another highly-touted freshman is 6-2 guard D.J. Rivera, who earned all-state and all-Catholic League honors in leading Neumann-Goretti High School to its second straight Philadelphia Catholic League title. He scored 17.7 points per game a year ago and graduated as the school's all-time leading scorer with 1,122 points.

Garrett Williamson is a 6-4 swing player who joined Govens and Rivera on the Pennsylvania all-state team. He helped Lower Merion to its second consecutive state title and finished his career with 1,349 points, ranking second on the school's scoring list to Kobe Bryant.

SAINT LOUIS

SAINT LOUIS OUTLOOK

In 2005-06, Saint Louis was arguably the surprise team in the A-10. Picked 13th in the annual coaches and media preseason poll and no higher than 10th in any preseason college basketball periodical, the Billikens finished tied for third with La Salle. Had SLU won either of its final two games (including an overtime home loss to Dayton), the Billikens would have finished second.

The Billikens return four starters from that squad along with 82 percent of their scoring and 86 percent of their rebounding. The Bills have three All-Conference caliber performers in that lineup. Senior center Ian Vouyoukas finished last year sixth in the league in scoring (13.9 ppg), 15th in rebounding (7.4 rpg), and fifth in blocked shots (1.9 bpg). Those figures resulted in the Chris Daniels Award that signifies the A-10's Most Improved Player.

Sophomore guard Tommie Liddell was the 2006 A-10 Rookie of the Year after averaging 10.3 points, 6.9 rebounds, and 2.7 assists per game. Sophomore guard Kevin Lisch joined Liddell on the A-10 All-Rookie team when he finished as SLU's second-leading scorer at 11.1 ppg. Lisch emerged as the Billikens' most reliable perimeter shooter as he finished third in the league with a .414 percentage from the arc.

Junior Danny Brown (4.7 ppg, 2.0 rpg) began last season in the starting lineup after leading the Bills in scoring early, but was unable to maintain consistency at either end of the floor. The 6-4 Brown is one of the Billikens' most explosive athletes and best finishers in the open floor. The quest for another consistent perimeter shooter may be answered by the presence of freshman guard Dustin Maguire. A *St. Louis Post-Dispatch* first-team All-Metro selection, Maguire helped Edwardsville High to a 30-1 record, a Southwestern Conference championship, and a trip to the Illinois Class AA quarterfinals by averaging 16.4 ppg. He shot 60.6 percent from the field, 50.5 percent from the arc.

The power forward spot is a key as SLU needs a consistent scoring threat and an able rebounder to take pressure off Vouyoukas. Redshirt freshman Obi Ikeakor (15.2 ppg, 7.3 rpg in 2004-05) and true freshman Adam Knollmeyer (18.0 ppg, 11.0 rpg) could step into that role, or perhaps 6-8 senior Justin Johnson (2.9 ppg, 2.7 rpg) could fulfill his vast potential.

Under fifth-year head coach Brad Soderberg, SLU is always a top-ranked defensive team. Generating consistent offense is the key to even greater improvement. With SLU's wealth of young players, that improvement should come through experience gained from a year ago. Soderberg has a versatile roster and is capable of playing big or small with the athleticism to push the tempo when the opportunity arises.

TEMPLE OUTLOOK

How does one replace a legendary coach of the likes of John Chaney? That is the question that new Temple head coach Fran Dunphy has heard ad nauseum since taking over the reins of the Owl program from his good friend on April 10, 2006.

"It's going to be difficult," Dunphy readily admits. "It will be a daunting task, but I look forward to the challenge."

Dunphy may not have compiled as many wins as the 741 that Chaney posted in his 34-year Hall of Fame career, but his resume is far from shabby. In his 17-year tenure as the head coach at Pennsylvania, Dunphy went 310-163 while guiding his teams to nine NCAA Tournaments. He led the Quakers to 10 Ivy League titles and nine 20-win campaigns over the last 14 seasons.

The Owls' new mentor's main concern is not how to replace Chaney; it is how to replace departed seniors Mardy Collins and Antywane Robinson—the former a two-time first-team All-Atlantic 10 performer who led the Owls in scoring, assists and steals each of the last two seasons, and the latter a second-team All-Conference honoree in 2005-06.

Dunphy does, however, inherit some talented players with which to build his first Temple team. Junior Mark Tyndale, who has started all but one game since his arrival on North Broad Street, leads the Owls' returnees. The 6-5 guard was the team's leading rebounder (5.1 rpg) while finishing second to Collins in assists (87) and steals (73). He also boasted a 10.9 scoring average to rank third on the squad. He looks to be ready to play after the first semester.

Senior Dustin Salisbery is expected to join Tyndale in the backcourt. A starter last season, the 6-5 guard averaged 9.7 points and 4.3 rebounds per game. He also hit 46 three-pointers, tops among returnees, and had 41 steals.

Senior Wayne Marshall, who missed the first eight games of last season due to health issues, will look to become the presence in the middle that everyone expected him to be. The 6-11 center averaged 7.2 points and 4.3 rebounds while playing a little more than half a game (21.9 mpg). He, like Tyndale, will miss the first semester.

Senior forward Dion Dacons (1.3 ppg, 2.3 rpg) and sophomore guard Donte Christmas (3.5 ppg, 1.6 rpg) are expected to see more playing time, as is junior guard Chris Clark (1.2 ppg). Developing sophomore centers, 7-0 Sergio Olmos and 6-10 Anthony Ivory, will provide depth in the post while 6-5 junior DaShone Kirkendoll and 6-4 Semaj Inge will vie for minutes in the backcourt.

Freshman Luis Guzman, a 6-2 guard from Paramus (NJ) Catholic, should see time at the point for the Owls. Sophomore Brian Shanahan, a 6-0 guard, also returns after making the squad as a walk-on last season.

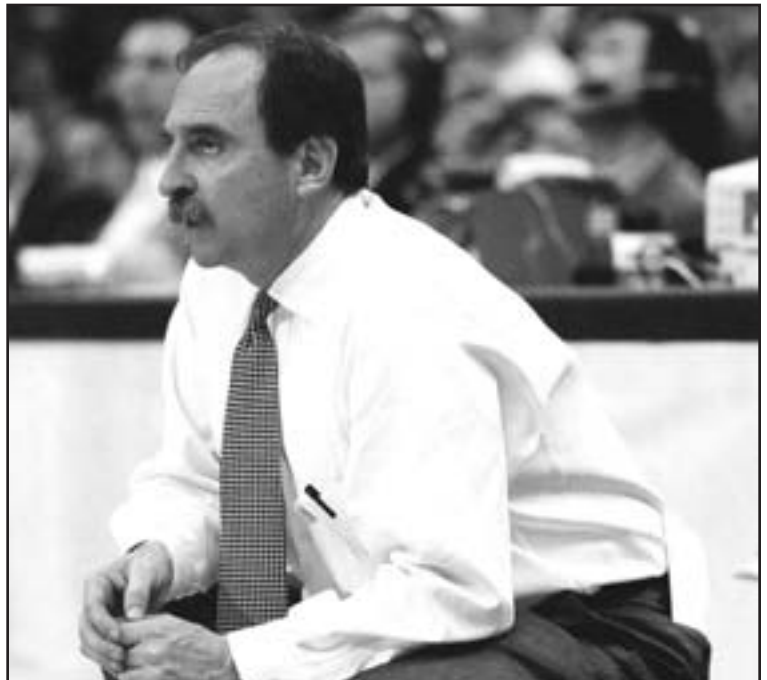

XAVIER

XAVIER OUTLOOK

The Xavier Musketeers, 21-11 last season, recorded their ninth 20-win season in the last 10 years and earned their ninth postseason tournament berth in the last 10 years, including seven NCAA Tournament berths. In addition, Xavier became the first school in NCAA history to win four games in four days in its conference tournament twice (XU also did it in 2004). That's quite an impressive recent history to brag about but Xavier fans may have good reasons to be even more optimistic this season.

There is a long list of reasons for optimism for Sean Miller, who is entering his third year at the helm at Xavier. Miller returns all five starters from last year's team. In fact, XU returns the top seven players that put together that championship run.

Three returnees are seniors, including forward Justin Cage, the 2006 Atlantic 10 Championship Most Outstanding Player and two-time All-Defensive team selection. Cage came on strong last season after the season-ending injury to first-team forward Brian Thornton in the 21st game of the season. Cage, who averaged 10.5 ppg and 5.4 rpg for the season, raised those averages to 14.2 ppg and 6.0 rpg after Thornton's injury.

Cage and fellow senior forward Justin Doellman are expected to start for the fourth straight season. The duo has earned two A-10 Championships and two NCAA Tournament berths in three years in the starting lineup. Doellman led the Musketeers in rebounding last season for the second straight year at 6.7 rpg (10th in the A-10), while also leading the team and ranking in the top 10 in the league in steals and blocks (51 each). He is also the team's second-leading returning scorer at 11.0 ppg. The third senior is forward Brandon Cole (2.1 ppg, 2.5 rpg), who became Xavier's top big man off the bench as a junior.

Xavier also has a solid backcourt in the junior tandem of Stanley Burrell and Drew Lavender. Burrell, a 2006 Atlantic 10 second-team All-Conference selection, led the Musketeers in scoring each of his first two seasons, including 14.4 ppg as a sophomore to go with a team-high 105 assists (3.3 apg). Lavender, a transfer who becomes eligible this season, was a two-year starter at the point at Oklahoma and is a former prep McDonald's All-American and all-Ohio standout. Two years ago, he averaged 9.7 points and 3.2 assists a game.

Miller is looking for a big junior year from forward Josh Duncan, who hopes to build on his progress from last season. Duncan was a big factor in Xavier's A-10 Championship run, earning All-Championship team honors after averaging 11.5 ppg and 4.5 rpg in four tournament victories. Another key returnee is sophomore Johnny Wolf (3.7 ppg), who started at point guard and had an impressive 2.74:1 assist-to-turnover ratio. Sophomore swingman B.J. Raymond (3.4 ppg) averaged 21 minutes a game over the Musketeers' last 11 games of his rookie year and is expected to battle for major time again.

In addition to Lavender, the impressive list of newcomers includes redshirt freshman forward Derrick Brown (15.0 ppg, 10.2 rpg), guard Adrion Graves (19.8 ppg, 9.7 rpg), and 6-9 forward Jason Love (14.0 ppg, 9.1 rpg).

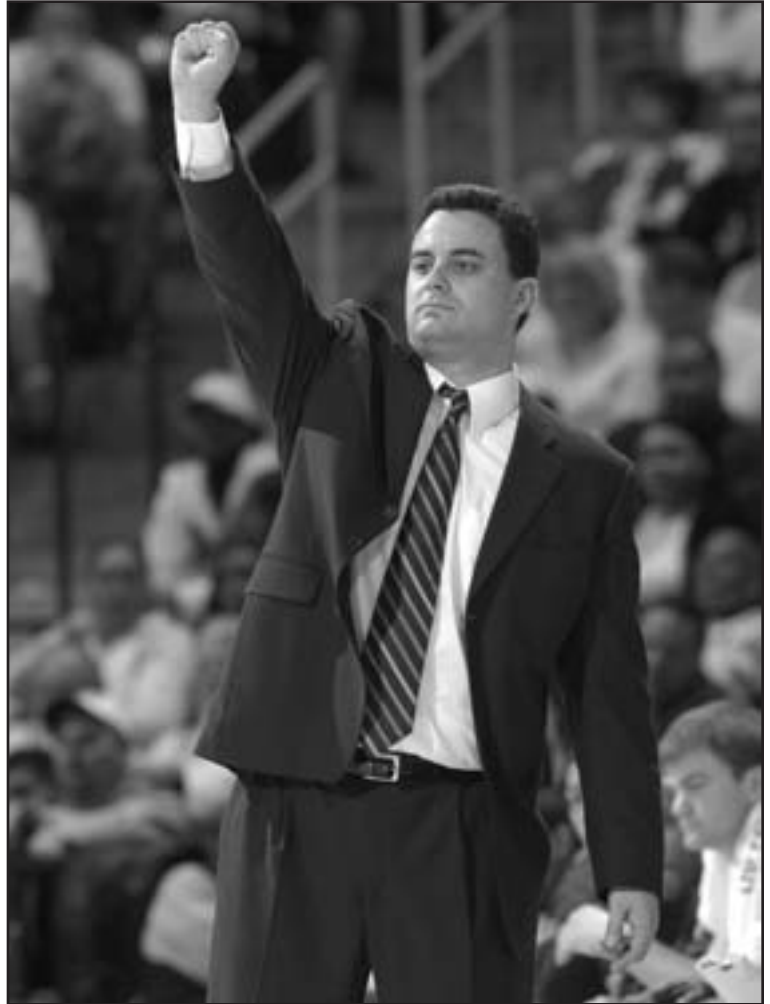
