

NATIONAL AWARD WINNERS

WALTER PAYTON AWARD

The Sports Network established the Walter Payton Player of the Year Award in 1987, and it is presented annually to the most outstanding college football player on the Division I-AA level. Below is a listing of the Atlantic 10 recipients of the Walter Payton Award:

Brian Finneran, Villanova, 1997

The first-ever receiver to win the Payton, Finneran caught 96 passes for 1,389 yards and 19 touchdowns, and led the Wildcats to an undefeated regular season, Atlantic 10 title and NCAA playoff berth. Finneran's 17 regular-season touchdowns rank fourth in I-AA history.

Jerry Azumah, New Hampshire, 1998

Azumah rushed for a then-Atlantic 10 record 2,195 yards, along with 22 touchdowns, to become the first Walter Payton Award honoree from a team with a losing record. Azumah finished his career with 60 rushing touchdowns, the highest total in Conference history, while his 6,193 rushing yards are the second-highest total.

Brian Westbrook, Villanova, 2001

A two-time Atlantic 10 Offensive Player of the Year, Westbrook amassed 1,603 rushing yards, 59 receptions, and 29 touchdowns for the Atlantic 10 quad-champions in 2001. Westbrook led I-AA with 2,823 all-purpose yards during his senior season and his 9,512 career all-purpose yards are an NCAA all-divisions record.

Lang Campbell, William & Mary, 2004

The first-ever Atlantic 10 quarterback to win the prestigious honor, Campbell established program single-season records for passing yards (3,988) and touchdown passes (30). Campbell guided William & Mary to its first 11-win season as well as its first-ever appearance in the semi-finals of the I-AA playoffs.

BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD

Presented to the most outstanding defensive player in I-AA, The Sports Network established the Buck Buchanan award in 1995. The award is named for Junious "Buck" Buchanan, the NAIA All-American and Pro Football Hall of Fame defensive lineman who played for Grambling State University from 1959-62. Below is the Atlantic 10 recipient of the Buck Buchanan Award:

Derrick Lloyd, James Madison, 2001

Lloyd became the first-ever Atlantic 10 player to claim the Buck Buchanan Award after collecting a league-high 157 tackles, including 19 for loss. The 2001 Atlantic 10 Co-Defensive Player of the Year registered 7.5 sacks, five fumble recoveries, and had nine double-digit tackle performances during the season. The senior linebacker led a JMU defense that ranked first in the Atlantic 10 and 11th in the nation in pass defense, surrendering just 149 yards per game. Lloyd finished his career with 320 tackles, good for 10th all-time in school history.

EDDIE ROBINSON AWARD

The Sports Network established the Eddie Robinson Coach of the Year Award in 1987, and it has been presented annually to the top coach in Division I-AA. Robinson is college football's all-time winningest coach with a record of 408-164-15. Below is a listing of the Atlantic 10 recipients of the Eddie Robinson Award:

Dan Allen, Boston University, 1993

Allen directed Boston University to a perfect 11-0 regular season just one year after the Terriers compiled a mark of 3-8. BU captured its first outright league crown since 1980 after going 8-0 in Conference play, with just two of its league games decided by less than 10 points. The Terriers led the Conference in both passing offense (288.6 ypg.) and scoring defense (16.2 ppg), and Allen was named Yankee Conference Coach of the Year.

Andy Talley, Villanova, 1997

Talley guided Villanova to a perfect 11-0 mark during the 1997 regular season, winning the Atlantic 10 Championship and entering that year's playoffs as the No. 1 seed. The Wildcats won seven of their eight A-10 games by double digits and averaged 430 yards of total offense and 40.2 points per game during the regular season. Eleven VU players earned All-Atlantic 10 honors, including Walter Payton Award winner Brian Finneran, and Talley was named the Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year for his efforts.

Mickey Matthews, James Madison, 1999

Matthews engineered an astounding turnaround in his first season at James Madison, taking the 3-8 Dukes to an 8-4 mark, an Atlantic 10 title, and the school's first trip to the I-AA playoffs since 1995. Matthews' team would rise to as high as No. 8 in the national rankings, and entered the postseason at No. 13. The 1999 Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year boasted a defense that finished second in the Conference in total defense as well as the Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year in the A-10 in RB Curtis Keaton and DE Chris Morant.

Sean McDonnell, New Hampshire, 2005

McDonnell led New Hampshire to a share of its first A-10 title since 1994 and its first-ever No. 1 ranking. The Wildcats ended the regular season with a 10-1 record and entered the playoffs as the No. 1 overall seed. UNH won seven of its eight A-10 contests and averaged a league-best 43.0 points per game in Conference play. Eleven UNH players earned All-Atlantic 10 honors, including three who garnered first-team All-America acclaim.

COLLEGE FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME

The first class of College Football Hall of Fame inductees was selected in 1951. That inaugural class included 54 legends and pioneers of the game like Walter Camp, Jim Thorpe, Red Grange, Amos Alonzo Stagg and Knute Rockne. Today more than 900 players and coaches from NCAA Division I-A, I-AA, II, III and the NAIA are enshrined in the Hall, which is located in South Bend, IN. Below is a listing of the Atlantic 10 inductees into the College Football Hall of Fame:

Tubby Raymond, Delaware

One of nine coaches in college football history to win 300 games, and only the fourth to earn all the victories at one school, Tubby Raymond was enshrined in the College Football Hall of Fame in August of 2003. Under Raymond, Delaware finished the 1971 and 1972 seasons as wire service national champions of Division II and claimed the I-AA national title in 1979. The Blue Hens won six Conference titles under Raymond, who is second in league annals with 89 Atlantic 10 victories. In 36 seasons in Newark, Raymond compiled a mark of 300-119-3.

Dave Nelson, Maine, Delaware

Nelson had a career record of 105-48-6 in two seasons at Maine (1949-50) and 15 years at Delaware (1951-65). He played halfback at Michigan (1939-41) and in his senior year won the school's Big 10 medal for academic and athletic achievement. Nelson served as Delaware's director of athletics and dean of the Physical Education School before becoming commissioner of the Yankee Conference from 1989-91. Enshrined into the College Football Hall of Fame in 1987, Nelson died following a heart attack on November 30, 1991.
