## » QUICK HITTERS

- Auburn welcomes Summit League preseason pick Oral Roberts to Plainsman Park for the final weekend series before SEC play. The series is the first-ever meeting between the two programs.
- Over the last six games, Auburn starting pitchers have posted a 2.12 ERA, held opponents to a .197 batting average, and posted 35 strikeouts in 34.0 innings pitched. In those six games, the starters have a 1-2 record.
- Junior Niko Buentello has 13 RBI in his first 13 career games (1st SEC/3rd NCAA). Buentello's 22 RBI in his first 12 games were the most since Auburn's Brian Fletcher had 26 RBI in his first 12 games in 2010.
- Junior outfielder Anfernee Grier has set a career high with 11 steals on the season (2nd SEC/4th NCAA). Grier has recorded a hit in all 13 games to start the season.
- Grier currently holds a 14-game hit streak, while Joshua Palacios has reached base in all 13 games this season. Grier has opened his two previous collegiate seasons with double-digit hitting streaks of 11 games (2014) and 15 games (2015).
- Auburn leads the SEC with 29 stolen bases in 13 games. The Tigers didn't steal their 29th base last season until game 40 on April 17. Auburn's total of 29 stolen bases ranks third nationally.
- Auburn has scored double-digit runs four times in 13 games this season, matching its total of double-digit run games from the 2015 season (62 games).
- The Tigers have four one-run losses in 2016. Six of their last nine losses dating back to last season's NCAA Regional have all been by one run. Conversely, all of Auburn's six wins in 2016 are by at least five runs.

**Butch Thompson was named Auburn's head baseball coach, Auburn Director of Athletics Jay Jacobs announced on October 22, 2015. Thompson, who spent three seasons as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Auburn from 2006-08, returns to the Plains after seven seasons at Mississippi State as both associate head coach and pitching coach.**

Widely regarded as one of the premier pitching coaches in the country, Thompson was named the 2014 Baseball America and American Baseball Coaches Association National Assistant Coach of the Year while at Mississippi State.

In 23 years of coaching at the collegiate level, including 13 in the Southeastern Conference, Thompson has coached seven College World Series participants, including a national runner-up finish, won nine conference championships and made 14 postseason appearances. He has also served as an assistant under three National Coach of the Year recipients.

In seven seasons at MSU, Thompson made four NCAA regional trips, two Super Regionals, won the SEC Tournament and advanced to the College World Series finishing as NCAA runner-up in 2013. In three of the last four seasons, the Bulldogs' staff ERA finished no higher than 3.06. Thompson's 2013 pitching staff was one of two nationally to finish in the top 15 in ERA, strikeouts per nine innings and hits allowed per nine innings.

Additionally, Mississippi State was 168-4 under Thompson the last four seasons when holding a lead after eight innings.

Thompson is considered one of the top recruiters in the country. Since 2003, he has secured nine recruiting classes that were ranked in the top 10 by either Baseball America or Perfect Game. His classes signed from 2006-08 at Auburn each ranked in the top 18 nationally including the No. 5 class nationally in 2008 which included All-American and SEC Player of the Year Hunter Morris.

Player development has been equally important for Thompson, who has turned 23 student-athletes who went undrafted out of high school into Major League Baseball draft picks.

A native of Amory, Miss., Thompson has coached 22 Division I All-Americans and 29 all-conference honors. In 2014, former Mississippi State pitcher Kendall Graveman became the ninth player Thompson tutored to pitch in the big leagues.

Thompson had three pitchers drafted in the first 11 rounds of the 2014 MLB Draft, and in 2013 five of his pitchers were drafted including three in the top 10 rounds.

In addition to his experience at Auburn and Mississippi State, Thompson also spent five seasons at Georgia from 2002-05, including a trip to the College World Series in 2004.

Thompson launched his coaching career as pitching coach and top assistant at Huntingdon College (Montgomery, Ala.) in 1993, before returning to his alma mater in Birmingham, where he helped lead the Panthers to back-to-back Southern States Conference championships and in 1995 coached BSC to its first NAIA World Series berth.



Thompson left BSC briefly to serve as head coach at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham in 1997. While at JSCC, he was honored as the Regional Tournament Coach of the Year, the ABCA Alabama Junior College Coach of the Year and the Southeast Region Coach of the Year after guiding JSCC to a 39-21 mark, the AJCAA Region 22 State Championship and a third-place finish in the NJCAA Division II World Series.

He returned to Birmingham-Southern as top assistant the following season, beginning a four-year run during the most successful span in BSC baseball history. The Panthers won 196 games and four TranSouth Conference championships and made three-consecutive appearances in the NAIA World Series. BSC's 2001 team posted a school-best 55-11 mark and captured the NAIA National Championship.

In 2002, Thompson joined the SEC baseball coaching fraternity, beginning a four-year term as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator. Georgia's 2003 recruiting class was ranked 10th nationally, while capturing the SEC title in 2004 en route to advancing to the NCAA College World Series.

Thompson, honored as the 2006 Fellowship of Christian Athletes SEC Coach of the Year, has shared his expertise as a featured speaker at numerous baseball coaching clinics throughout the United States.

Thompson prepped at Amory (Miss.) High School and later starred as a pitcher at Itawamba (Miss.) Community College from 1989-90. On Oct. 25, 2014, Thompson was inducted into the ICC Athletic Hall of Fame.

He earned a bachelor's degree in history at BSC in 1992 and completed a master's degree in sports administration at UAB in 1996. He is married to the former Robin Ashe of Birmingham, Ala., and they are the parents of three daughters --- Anna, Olivia and Madelyn Gail.

**NEWS & NOTES**

**UP NEXT**

» Auburn wraps the midweek home-and-home series with No. 9 Georgia Tech when the Tigers visit the Flats on Tuesday, March 15 at 5 p.m. CT. The game will be broadcast on ESPN3. The Jackets defeated Auburn 4-1 on March 8 at Plainsman Park.

**SCOUTING THE OPPOSITION**

» Oral Roberts has posted a 6-5 record early in the season including a series win over a ranked Dallas Baptist program and taking 3-of-4 from Little Rock. The Golden Eagles also knocked off Wichita State. Sophomore catcher Matt Whatley leads the team with a .400 batting average in 11 games, while sophomore infielder Nick Roark has a team-high three homers and 11 RBI.

**MIDWEEK "MITCH"**

» Auburn sophomore LHP Andrew Mitchell has made starts in the first three midweek opportunities of the season and has made them count. The New Orleans native is 2-0 with a 0.56 ERA over those three appearances.  
 » Mitchell has pitched 16 innings with just on run allowed. He has struck out 16 while holding opponents to just a .127 batting average.

**ROTATION RESHUFFLE IN PENSACOLA**

» Auburn used a different pitching rotation for the weekend tournament in Pensacola with senior RHP Justin Camp starting Friday, freshman RHP Casey Mize making his first career start on Saturday and All-SEC RHP Cole Lipscomb taking his turn on Sunday. The reshuffled rotation had very positive results.  
 » All three pitchers turned in quality starts with the trio combining to toss 20.0 innings with 20 strikeouts and holding three opponents to a .225 batting average. Mize and Lipscomb both had eight strikeouts, while Lipscomb allowed just two hits. The trio posted a combined ERA of 3.15 for the weekend.

**BREAK OUT THE BATS**

» Despite the hiccup on Tuesday, Auburn had enjoyed a strong start to 2016 at the plate in home games. The Tigers are batting .315 in 10 games played in the friendly confines of Plainsman Park.  
 » Overall, Auburn ranks ninth in the SEC with 133 hits through 13 games overall. The Tigers are also third in the SEC and 14th nationally with 31 doubles.  
 » Auburn's team speed has been on display to the tune of 29 stolen bases - the top total in the SEC ahead of second place Vanderbilt (28).

**BUENTELLO BYTES**

» Niko Buentello, who hit a 3-run home run in the sixth inning of game two and a 3-run home run in the first inning of game three, is the first Auburn player to homer in consecutive games since Ryan Tella homered at Tennessee and vs. Kennesaw State on March 23 and 25, 2014.  
 » Buentello's 10 RBIs in Auburn's 3-game series against Sacramento State are the most RBIs by an Auburn player in the first three games of a season since Josh Donaldson had 11 RBIs in a 3-game series against Hofstra to begin the 2007 season.

- » His 10 RBIs are the most in a 3-game series overall since Blake Austin drove in 10 runs against Tennessee from April 27-29, 2012.
- » Buentello followed up with a four RBI in the midweek win over Florida A&M on 2/24. The junior recorded four-straight multi-RBI games to begin his Auburn career.
- » Buentello's 22 RBI through his first 12 games are the third most by an Auburn player since 2000 joining Brian Fletcher's 26 RBI in the first 12 games of 2010 and Gabe Gross' 27 RBI in the first 12 games of the 2000 season.
- » Buentello has 23 RBI in his first 13 career games. His 23 RBI rank first in the SEC and third nationally. His three home runs in 2016 are fourth in the SEC and equal the Auburn individual player high for 2015.

**ALL-SEC FIRST TEAMER ANFERNEE GRIER**

- » Anfernee Grier was named to the preseason All-SEC first team by the league's coaches. He is the first AU player to receive the honor since the team's inception in 2015.
- » Grier, who returns for his junior season in 2016, led the team in 2015 with a .323 batting average and 22 doubles, the most for an Auburn player since Karl Amonite had 25 in 2005. The Phenix City native was also selected to play for the USA Baseball Collegiate team.
- » Grier has a penchant for fast starts, the junior opened the 2015 season with a 15-game hitting streak and had an 11-game hitting streak to start 2014. Grier has a hit in all 13 games to start 2016.
- » Grier has made 83 consecutive starts dating back to May 6, 2014 against Bethune-Cookman. He started all 62 games in 2015. It is the most consecutive starts for an Auburn player since Ryan Tella started 115 consecutive games from 2012-13.
- » The speedy outfielder is 11-for-13 in stolen bases, a total that is second in the SEC and fourth nationally. His 11 stolen bases are a new career high.
- » **As of 3/9, Grier second in the SEC in runs (19, also third nationally), second in stolen**

**bases (11) and fifth in walks (12) while and fourth in batting average (.460).**

**DOUBLES AND DABS**

- » Led by junior Niko Buentello and senior Cody Nulph, Auburn has piled up extra base hits in the first 13 games with 43 overall, specifically 31 doubles that rank third in the SEC and 14th nationally.
- » Nulph has eight doubles ranking him second in the SEC and second nationally. Buentello and Anfernee Grier both have seven XBH, while Jordan Ebert and Joshua Palacios both have six.

**P-LO PARTY**

- » Junior outfielder Joshua Palacios made a strong debut in both the field and at the plate in his first series at Auburn. The Brooklyn, N.Y. native made a pair of outfield assists from left in his first three games,
- » Palacios also homered and doubled while picking up five hits on the weekend and was 3-for-3 on stolen bases.
- » The Brooklyn native is hitting .302 this season with one homer, one triple, four doubles, six RBI, six steals and 10 runs scored.

**THOMPSON TAKES OVER**

- » New Auburn head coach Butch Thompson was hired in October. He becomes a Division I head coach for the first time following a successful seven-season stint at Mississippi State. He also previously coached in the SEC at Auburn and Georgia.
- » Thompson's only previous head coaching experience came in 1997 at Jefferson State Community College in Birmingham where he guided the Pioneers to a 39-12 record.

**SENIOR JORDAN EBERT**

- » Jordan Ebert has started 158 games in his career, including starts at second base, designated hitter and in both left and right field.
- » As a sophomore in 2014, Ebert led the SEC

in hitting for most of the season. He finished with the second-best average in the league at .353.

- » Ebert received his undergraduate degree in physical education in December 2015 and is currently pursuing a Master's degree.
- » The Foley, Ala. native had a career-high five hits on 2/26 against Southern with a career-best three doubles.
- » Ebert is batting .368 in 2016 with five doubles, one home run and 12 RBI.

**JUSTIN CAMP, THE STARTER**

- » After recording eight saves in 2015 as Auburn's closer, senior Justin Camp returns to the rotation in 2016.
- » In his first start of the season, Camp turned in his first quality start since March 11, 2014 vs. Kennesaw State. It was his first start overall since April 15, 2014.
- » Against Sac State, Camp tossed six innings with six strikeouts and just two runs allowed in a no decision. He took it a step further against Southern with 8.0 innings of two hit, shutout ball and a career-high 9 Ks.

**LIPSCOMB LEADS NEW-LOOK STAFF**

- » Auburn's starting rotation feature only one pitcher that made a start in 2015 - junior RHP Cole Lipscomb. Lipscomb is back for 2016 after being named to the All-SEC team in 2015. Lipscomb posted an 8-2 record with a 2.52 ERA in 16 appearances (12 starts).
- » Senior Justin Camp (eight career starts, none in 2015) is a rotation candidate as well as four talented junior college arms. Juniors Ben Braymer, Tavo Rodriguez and Gabe Klobosits could all be starting candidates as well as sophomore Andrew Mitchell. Freshmen Casey Mize and Daniel Sprinkle will also be in contention.

**THOMPSON AND DAVIS TO MISS 2016**

- » Auburn junior pitchers Keegan Thompson and Kevin Davis will both miss the 2016 season due to injury.

**GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: SAMFORD STADIUM-HITCHCOCK FIELD AT PLAINSMAN PARK**

» Auburn's baseball home for the past 64 seasons, Samford Stadium-Hitchcock Field at Plainsman Park seats 4,096, including 3,227 chairback seats. Auburn's baseball field has been called a renaissance of Camden Yard proportions since receiving a \$4.2 million facelift in 1998.



» The NCAA granted Auburn a roster waiver and neither player will be on the 35-man active roster for the season. Both are expected to return for 2017.

**VETERAN SEC COACHING STAFF**

» Auburn's coaching staff led by head coach Butch Thompson, despite being new on the Plains, is not new to the Southeastern Conference. In total, the staff features 39 years of SEC experience.

» Thompson has spent 14 years in the league, while assistant Doug Sisson spent a pair of seasons at Georgia. Assistant Brad Bohannon has 12 years at Kentucky and volunteer Greg Drye spent the previous 11 seasons at Mississippi State.

**HIGH QUALITY LIPSCOMB**

» Cole Lipscomb, who finished third in the SEC last season with a 2.53 ERA, had seven straight quality starts from April 10 through May 19 and had a total of nine quality starts in his 12 starts in 2015.

» During his stretch of seven straight quality starts, Lipscomb tossed 49.2 innings and allowed 14 runs (12 earned) on 40 hits and 13 walks and 40 Ks.

» Lipscomb's 91 strikeouts in 2015 were the most by an Auburn pitcher since Chris Bootcheck had 101 in 2000

**DRAFT SUCCESS**

» Following the 2015 season pitchers Rocky McCord (Baltimore) and Trey Wingenter (San Diego) were selected in the MLB First Year Player Draft. Auburn has now had at least one player selected in the MLB Draft in 41 consecutive seasons, which ties for the second-longest active streak in the Southeastern Conference.

» The Tigers are tied with Arkansas and trail only Georgia. Auburn has had multiple players selected in 10 consecutive seasons (since 2006).

**TANDEM RANKS AMONG TOP JUNIORS**

» Both junior outfielder Anfernee Grier and junior right-hander Keegan Thompson are getting a lot of draft buzz for 2016. Grier ranked as the No. 42 prospect by D1Baseball and No. 62 by both Baseball America and Perfect Game. Thompson was ranked No. 48 by D1, No. 49 by Baseball America and No. 69 by Perfect Game.

**NATIONAL ASSISTANTS OF THE YEAR**

» The Auburn coaching staff is fortunate to feature the two most recent Baseball America. Head coach Butch Thompson received the award in 2014 at

Mississippi State, while assistant coach Brad Bohannon was the 2015 recipient for his efforts at Kentucky.

» Auburn joins Virginia as the only staff to feature multiple winners of the award. Virginia head coach Brian O'Connor won the award while an assistant at Notre Dame in 2001, and assistant Kevin McMullen was the 2009 winner.

**TIGERS ON TV**

» Auburn baseball will have 51 games broadcast in 2016, up from 46 a season ago. Ten of those games will air as part of the SEC television package with ESPN and the SEC Network.

» Auburn's March 8 matchup with Georgia Tech at Plainsman Park will be the SEC Network's first baseball broadcast of 2016.

» The Capital City Classic between the Tigers and rival Alabama at Montgomery's Riverwalk Stadium will be broadcast nationally on the SEC Network for the first time on March 29.

» Auburn will also have 38 games available on SECN+/WatchESPN.

**GRAD TRANSFER**

» Right-hander Marc Frazier (Newnan, Ga.) joins the Auburn program as a graduate transfer for the 2016 season. Frazier spent two seasons at Nicholls State in Thibodeaux, La. where he pitched in 32 games with 2.87 ERA.

» Frazier also spent two seasons, including a redshirt year at Chipola (Fla.) College. He was drafted in 2012 by the San Francisco Giants.

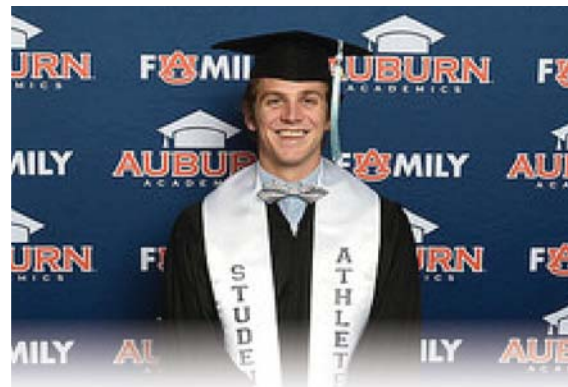
**M-V-P, M-V-P, M-V-P**

» Former Auburn standout Josh Donaldson was named American League Most Valuable Player in November.

» Donaldson, a first-time winner, is the second former Tiger to win an MVP award. Hall of Famer Frank Thomas won back-to-back AL MVP awards in 1993 and 1994 with the Chicago White Sox.

» Auburn is the only SEC program and one of just six programs nationally to produce at least two different alumni that have won either an American League or National League MVP award.

» Additionally, with Cam Newton taking home NFL MVP honors, Auburn is the only university to have two former athletes earn major sports MVP awards in the same season and do it on two occasions [Thomas (AL) and Charles Barkley (NBA) in 1994].

**THE GRADUATES**

» Two Auburn players already hold degrees. Jordan Ebert (Foley, Ala.) graduated in December 2015 with a degree in physical education, while Marc Frazier holds a degree in business from Nicholls State University. Both are currently pursuing graduate degrees.

**SEC HONOR ROLL**

» There were 13 Auburn representatives on the SEC Academic Honor Roll for the 2015 season, including current team members Kevin Davis, Anfernee Grier, Cole Lipscomb, Blake Logan, Sam Mason, Cody Nulph, JJ Shaffer, Keegan Thompson and Izaac Yarbrough. Team members had a 3.0 GPA for the previous school year or a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher.

**ACADEMIC TOP TIGERS**

» The Academic Top Tiger program recognizes Auburn student-athletes who post a 3.0 GPA or higher in either semester of a school year. The 2014-15 list recognized 18 members of the baseball team, including Steven Baranca, Kevin Davis, Jordan Ebert, Melvin Gray, Anfernee Grier, Cole Lipscomb, Blake Logan, Sam Mason, Cody Nulph, JJ Shaffer, Keegan Thompson and Izaac Yarbrough from the current squad.

**ACADEMIC ALL-AMERICA**

» Junior right-handed pitcher Cole Lipscomb was named a 2015 CoSIDA Academic All-American. The Prattville, Ala. native holds a 3.76 grade point average in finance.

**DRAFT DENIAL**

» Auburn has eight players on its roster that chose to attend Auburn rather than signing a professional contract.

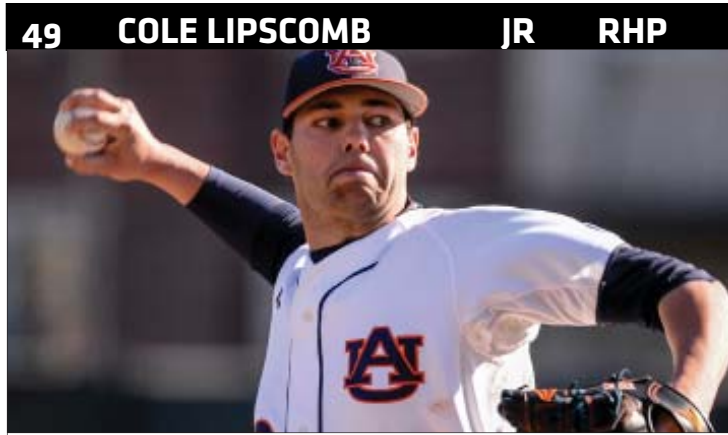
