GAME NOTES

- >> Captains: Jonathan Wallace, Carl Lawson, Daniel Carlson
- >> Weather: 65 degrees at kickoff, overcast but clearing
- >> Coin Toss: Auburn wins the toss and elects to receive
- >> Eagle flight: Spirit from flagpole
- >> Attendance: 87,451; Auburn has now played in front of 23 consecutive regular-season sellout crowds both at home and on the road; the last regular season non-sellout was in 2013 at Tennessee. This is the 13th consecutive sellout at Jordan-Hare Stadium

TEAM NOTES

- >> Auburn is now 29-11 vs. Ole Miss
- >> First-time starters: Jovon Robinson, Robert Leff
- >> This is the Auburn defense's fourth consecutive game with an interception; it's Auburn's second game this season with multiple interceptions
- >> Auburn has scored 44 points off turnovers this season

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- >> Ricardo Louis' 47-yard TD catch from Sean White was Louis' third score of the season and ninth career TD. It was White's first career TD pass and Auburn's longest TD pass to a receiver this year.
- >> Louis has at least one reception in 24 consecutive games, back through the 2013 Georgia game, the most since Rod Smith, who caught a pass in 25 consecutive games from 2007-08
- >> Louis has 75 yards receiving or more in three consecutive games; this was his third career 100-yard receiving game
- >> Melvin Ray's 44-yard reception today gives him 22 of 26 career catches for a first down or touchdown
- >> Sean White ranks fourth in Auburn freshman passing yardage (1,063), and fifth in freshman pass completions (74) and freshman pass attempts (125)
- >> White had thrown 94 consecutive passes without an interception, the fourth best string at Auburn since 1999
- >> Jovon Robinson had a career best 91 yards rushing on 18 carries
- >> Tony Stevens' 44-yard catch from Jeremy Johnson was the longest reception of his career

>> Blake Countess' interception was his first at Auburn and the seventh of his college career. He is the sixth different Auburn player with an interception this season.

>> Kris Frost's interception was his second in the last two games and the third of his career

>> Johnathan Ford records double-figure tackles for the sixth time this season and seventh of his career

>> Jonathan Jones ties his career high with nine tackles; Carlton Davis set a career best with nine tackles

>> Auburn kickers have now converted 108 consecutive PAT attempts back to the 2013 Tennessee game. Daniel Carlson has 81 consecutive made PATs in his career.

>> Carlson's 52-yard field goal is his fourth of more than 50 yards this season, most of any FBS kicker. Carlson now has 14 made FG for the season.

>> Carlson's four 50+ yard FG set a new Auburn season record, breaking the old mark of three set by John Riley in 1969; Carlson has tied Neil O'Donoghue (1975-76) for the Auburn career record with five 50+ yard FG

>> Carlson is eighth in Auburn career kick scoring with 177 career points scored, passing John Riley (173 points from 1967-69). He is tied for ninth in career field goals made with 32, along with Jim Von Wyl (1990-91)
