GAME NOTES

- >> Captains: Jonathan Wallace, Carl Lawson, Montravius Adams
- >> Weather: 61 degrees at kickoff, overcast but clearing
- >> Coin Toss: Auburn wins the toss and elects to receive
- >> Eagle flight: Nova from flagpole
- >> Attendance: 87,451; Auburn has now played in front of 25 consecutive regular-season sellout crowds both at home and on the road; the last regular season non-sellout was in 2013 at Tennessee. This is the 14th consecutive sellout at Jordan-Hare Stadium

TEAM NOTES

- >> First-time starters: Stephen Roberts

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- >> Kerryon Johnson scored his second rushing touchdown of the season with a seven-yard run in the first quarter

- >> Stephen Roberts finished with a career-high seven tackles
- >> Justin Garrett had the second forced fumble of his career in the second quarter (first was vs. Arkansas in 2012)
- >> Cassanova McKinzy recorded his team-leading fifth sack of the season

- >> Auburn kickers have now converted 111 consecutive PAT attempts back to the 2013 Tennessee game. Daniel Carlson has 84 consecutive made PATs in his career.
- >> Carlson now has 20 made FG for the season.
- >> Carlson's 14 consecutive made field goals sets an Auburn record; the previous mark was 12 by Jaret Holmes in 1997
- >> Carlson is seventh in Auburn career kick scoring with 198 career points scored. He is tied for seventh in career field goals made with 38, and eighth in career PAT made with 84.
