GAME NOTES

- >> Captains: Jonathan Wallace, Carl Lawson, Justin Garrett, Devonte Danzey
- >> Weather: 65 degrees at kickoff, sunny
- >> Coin Toss: Auburn wins the toss and will receive
- >> Eagle flight: Spirit from SW corner
- >> Attendance: 87,451; Auburn has now played in front of 26 consecutive regular-season sellout crowds both at home and on the road; the last regular season non-sellout was in 2013 at Tennessee. This is the 15th consecutive sellout at Jordan-Hare Stadium

TEAM NOTES

- >> First-time players for Auburn: Tucker Brown, Daniel Pond, Logan Rice, Lawyer Tillman, Tucker Tuberville,
- >> Auburn scored on its opening drive for the third consecutive game
- >> Auburn has scored 68 points off turnovers this season; the Tigers are +5 in turnover margin for the year
- >> Auburn has 13 interceptions this season and has intercepted at least one pass in eight of 11 games. This is the fourth multiple-interception game this season for Auburn.
- >> The Tigers set a season high with four different rushers scoring at least one TD, the most since the 2013 SEC championship game vs. Missouri
- >> This is Auburn's highest scoring total of the season

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- >> Jovon Robinson's 13-yard first-quarter TD rush was his second score of the season, and his career long for a scoring play
- >> Jeremy Johnson's two TD runs give him five rushing scores of the season and six in his career
- >> Peyton Barber's first quarter TD rush was his 13th rushing score of the season
- >> Melvin Ray's 14-yard first-quarter reception gives him 25 of 29 career catches for either a first down or a score
- >> Ricardo Louis' 15-yard TD catch from Jeremy Johnson in the second quarter was his third TD catch of the season and eighth of his career. Louis' 56-yard catch from Johnson in the third quarter was Auburn's longest pass play of the season.
- >> Tony Stevens' 5-yard TD catch from Jeremy Johnson was Stevens' first score of the season and second of his career

>> Roc Thomas' 56-yard TD run was a career long for Thomas and Auburn's longest TD run of the season by a running back. It's Thomas' second 50+-yard score of the season; his other was a 51-yard TD catch from Johnson vs. Jacksonville State. This was his third career rushing TD and fourth career score

>> Johnathan Ford's 48-yard interception return for a touchdown was his second interception of the season and fifth pick of his career. It was his first interception score and second career score at Auburn. The Tigers' last interception return for a touchdown was Jermaine Whitehead vs. Arkansas in the 2014 season opener.

>> Ford now has 104 tackles for the season, the most by an Auburn defender since Dontarrious Thomas in 2001. The last Auburn players to record 100 tackles in a season were Daren Bates (104) and Neiko Thorpe (102) in 2011.

>> Jonathan Jones' 29-yard interception was his first of the season and the seventh of his career

>> Tré Williams' fumble recovery was the first of his career

>> JaViere Mitchell records his first career sack

>> Gimel President records his second sack of the season and third of his career

>> Auburn kickers have now converted 117 consecutive PAT attempts back to the 2013 Tennessee game. Daniel Carlson has 90 consecutive made PATs in his career. Carlson's streak is now the fourth longest in Auburn history, passing Cody Parkey (89 consecutive from 2011-13)

>> Carlson is seventh in Auburn career kick scoring with 204 career points scored. He is tied for seventh in career field goals made with 38, and eighth in career PAT made with 90
