GAME NOTES

- >> Captains: Jonathan Wallace, Carl Lawson, Blake Countess
- >> Weather: 73 degrees at kickoff, sunny; it's the warmest kickoff temperature for an Iron Bowl since 2001, when the temperature was 75 degrees
- >> Coin Toss: Alabama wins the toss and defers; Auburn will receive
- >> Eagle flight: Nova from flagpole
- >> Attendance: 87,451; Auburn has now played in front of 27 consecutive regular-season sellout crowds both at home and on the road; the last regular season non-sellout was in 2013 at Tennessee. This is the 16th consecutive sellout at Jordan-Hare Stadium

TEAM NOTES

- >> First-time starters for Auburn: Jason Smith

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- >> Jeremy Johnson's 77-yard touchdown pass to Jason Smith was the longest completion of Johnson's career, and his ninth TD pass of the season and 18th of his career. It was Smith's first TD reception at Auburn. The play ties for the 19<sup>th</sup>-longest completion all-time at Auburn and was Auburn's longest offensive play this season
- >> Ricardo Louis is now 11<sup>th</sup> all-time at Auburn with 97 receptions and 15<sup>th</sup> with 1,322 receiving yards
- >> Jason Smith set a career high with 82 receiving yards
- >> Peyton Barber is just 16 yards shy of gaining 1,000 rushing yards for the season
  
- >> Johnathan Ford now has 113 tackles for the season, the most by an Auburn defender since Dontarrious Thomas in 2001 (121). The last Auburn players to record 100 tackles in a season were Daren Bates (104) and Neiko Thorpe (102) in 2011.
- >> Jonathan Jones had a career high with 11 tackles
  
- >> Auburn kickers have now converted 118 consecutive PAT attempts back to the 2013 Tennessee game. Daniel Carlson has 93 consecutive made PATs in his career. Carlson's streak is the fourth longest in Auburn history
- >> Carlson is seventh in Auburn career kick scoring with 211 career points scored.

He is sixth in career field goals made with 40 (passing Cody Parkey; 39 from 2010-13), and eighth in career PAT made with 93. Carlson is just the ninth Auburn player to score more than 100 points in a season

>> Carlson's Auburn record consecutive field goal streak ended at 16 made. The Lou Groza Award finalist is 22-26 in field goals made this season

>> Carlson's 22 field goals made this season tie him with Scott Etheridge (1992) for the Auburn single-season record
