

Baylor Football Tailgating Guidelines

- Any person damaging University property will be responsible for cost of repair
- Delineating perimeters, “staking grounds,” for tailgate site is prohibited
- Tents and canopies or tailgating amenities (furniture, generators, grills or satellite dishes) may not obstruct sideways, drive lanes or pedestrian walkways
- Dispose of all trash in trash receptacles and hot coals in hot coal barrels located in tailgating areas- please do not place hot coals on the ground
- Use of motorized recreational vehicles (4 wheelers, golf carts, gators, scooters, etc.) are prohibited
- The person(s) purchasing the tailgating spot are responsible for the conduct of their guests
- All animals must be kept on a leash; animals are prohibited inside the stadium
- Commercial activity or solicitations are not allowed on property; vendor spaces are available on game day through Baylor IMG College, 254.710.3271
- The University is not responsible or liable for accidents, damage, loss or theft of materials, items, or personal property left in tailgating area
- All University policies and procedures apply
