TEAM QUICK NOTES

*Baylor is making its 19th all-time NCAA Regional appearance and first since 2012.

*Baylor finished fourth in Big 12 play in 2017, marking its best league finish since winning the title in 2012.

*Baylor is one of three Power Five schools to earn a bowl game/NCAA postseason appearance in football, men's basketball, women's basketball, baseball and softball (Florida State, Kentucky).

*Baylor has already played Texas A&M once this year and won 6-3 on a Tucker Cascadden walk-off grand slam on March 5 at Minute Maid Park. BU also took two of three from Houston in Waco on March 10-12. BU has played Iowa once: won 12-7 in Waco on March 21, 1995. BU has only played one of the three teams in postseason, topping Houston 7-1 in the opening game of the 2001 Houston Regional.

*Baylor and Oklahoma are the only two teams to have qualified for all 21 Big 12 Championships.

*Baylor has won 15 of its last 24 games and 10 of its last 15 after going through a stretch of losing eight of 10 games from March 24-April 8.

*Baylor is 14-10 away from Baylor Ballpark this season (12-7 on road, 2-3 in neutral sites).

*Baylor has hit 35 home runs in its last 28 games after hitting 14 homers in its first 26 games.

*Baylor has 49 home runs this season through 55 games, which are 15 more than its season output of 34 in 53 games in 2016. BU has 40 or more homers for the first time since 2012 (46) and 45 or more for the first time since 2010 (57).

*Baylor is 7-8 against ranked teams in 2017. BU is 5-7 in 2017 and 8-11 under Steve Rodriguez against Baseball America ranked teams and 202-299-1 all-time, including a 37-47 mark since 2011. BU is 2-5 this season (lost to No. 4 LSU, 2-1 at No. 6 Texas Tech, 2-1 at No. 6 TCU) and 92-152 all-time against Baseball America top 10 teams.

*In the 2017 Shriners Hospitals for Children College Classic in Houston at Minute Maid Park, Baylor went 2-1 and led the field of six teams (all ranked) in pitching, allowing a tournament-low seven runs (six earned) on 25 hits and eight walks with 27 strikeouts in 26 innings for a 2.08 ERA -- the field included No. 1 TCU, No. 4 LSU, No. 9 Ole Miss, No. 10 Texas Tech and No. 11 Texas A&M. RHP Nick Lewis and SS Tucker Cascadden were named to the all-tournament team.

*Jr. preseason All-American/NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List member closer Troy Montemayor has 10 saves (20th in NCAA, 3rd in Big 12) in 2017. He converted his first eight career save attempts last season, and after blowing a save in his ninth attempt, had converted 12 straight and now 17 of last the 18. He's 26-for-28 in converting save attempts in his career. He ranks second on Baylor's career saves list (26), tied for fifth on the single-season list (12) and is the second BU player to have two 10-save seasons ever (Zane Carlson 2000 (15), 2003 (11)).

*Baylor has two players with 10 or more home runs (Shea Langeliers (10), Aaron Dodson (10)) for the first time since 2010 (Max Muncy (11), Logan Vick (10)).

*Langeliers has set the Baylor freshman record for most homers by a catcher and is one homer shy of tying the overall BU freshman homer record held by Max Muncy with 11 in 2010.

*Baylor has won 34 or more games for the first time since 2012 (49-17) and 12th time in the last 20 seasons.

*Baylor's 34-21 record through 55 games is its best since a 43-12 start in 2012.

*Steve Rodriguez was named 2017 Big 12 Coach of the Year, marking the third time he's earned a conference coach of the year honor and gave BU its 11th such honor.

*JUCO RHP Montana Parsons was named 2017 Co-Big 12 Newcomer of the Year, giving Baylor its third such honor and second in the Big 12.

*Baylor led the league with 15 Big 12 awards in 2017 -- Coach of the Year (Rodriguez), Newcomer of the Year (Parsons), All-Big 12 first team (Aaron Dodson, Troy Montemayor), All-Big 12 second team (Shea Langeliers, Matt Menard, Parsons), All-Big 12 honorable mention (Tucker Cascadden, Richard Cunningham, Kameron Esthay, T.J. Raguse, Davis Wendzel) and Big 12 All-Freshman (Langeliers, Wendzel). BU's 11 All-Big 12 choices tied a program record.

*Baylor led the league with a program-record 15 Academic All-Big 12 choices for its sixth straight season with at least 10 or more honorees. BU leads all Big 12 schools in all-time first team selections with 143, which are 47 more than any other team in the league -- Richard Cunningham (first team), Levi Gilcrease (first team), Joe Heineman (first team), Kyle Hill (first team), Cameron Miller (first team), Kyle Ott (first team), Alex Phillips (first team), T.J. Raguse (first team), Tucker Cascadden (second team), Aaron Dodson (second team), Kameron Esthay (second team), Nick Lewis (second team), Steven McLean (second team), Matt Menard (second team), Troy Montemayor (second team).

*Langeliers was named Big 12 Newcomer of the Week on May 22, marking the second straight week earning the honor. He's the first Baylor player to garner the accolade twice in a season and first two receive a Big 12 weekly accolade in back-to-back weeks since Josh Ludy on April 16 and April 23 in 2012.

*Baylor tied a school record with a nine-run comeback vs. KSU on May 18 as the Bears also did so on May 26, 2001 at Rice (trailed 9-0 and won 11-10).

*Baylor had its sixth shutout at UTSA, marking the first time with six or more in a season since 2000 (6).

*Baylor won six of its 14 three-game series in 2017 and three of its last five.

*Baylor has finished its home schedule with a .500 record or better (19-11 in 2017) in all 18 seasons at Baylor Ballpark (since 1999) and is 416-193 all-time at the park.

*Freshman C Shea Langeliers & Junior RHP Troy Montemayor were named Big 12 Newcomer and Co-Pitcher of the Week, respectively, on May 15.

*Baylor posted its first road sweep of the season at Oklahoma State and first since April 13-15, 2012 at Kansas State.

*Baylor won two straight Big 12 road series for the first time since 2012 on April 5-7 at Missouri & April 13-15 at KSU.

*Baylor's 15-2 start through 17 games was tied for its best in program history (started 15-2 in 1990 and 1961).

Steve Rodriguez is in his second year at Baylor following a successful first season in 2016 that saw the Bears achieve several feats that had not been accomplished in a few years. Rodriguez, who enjoyed a successful playing and coaching career at Pepperdine University, was introduced as Baylor University's 19th head baseball coach on June 12, 2015, and earned his first Baylor win on Feb. 20, 2016 in a 9-5 decision over Washington at Baylor Ballpark. The Bears used a seven-run, two-out rally in the sixth inning with seven straight batters reaching base safely to grab the victory.

Noteworthy accomplishments from the 2016 campaign include extending BU's run of qualifying for every Big 12 Championship event (20) since joining the league in 1996, winning 10 or more (10) games in league play for the first time since 2013, taking two of three from No. 10 TCU for the program's first Big 12 series win over the Horned Frogs, hitting 30 or more home runs as a team for the first time since 2012, continuing BU's streak of finishing with a .500 record or better at Baylor Ballpark in every season in the park (18 seasons since 1999), extending the Bears' streak of having 20 or more wins (24) in a season to 45 (since 1972) and posting the program's first five-game winning streak since 2013.

Among honors under Rodriguez, the Bears had 10 or more (11) Academic All-Big 12 selections for the fifth straight season, multiple (6) All-Big 12 selections for the 20th straight season (every year as a league member) and their first ABCA All-Region selection (RHP Troy Montemayor, first team) since 2012.

An All-America second baseman on Pepperdine's 1992 NCAA College World Series championship team, Rodriguez has spent the last 12 seasons as head coach at his alma mater, leading the Waves to a 401-300* (.572) record, including a 178-109 (.620) mark in West Coast Conference play, with eight NCAA Tournament appearances, five WCC regular-season titles, three WCC Championship Series crowns and a pair of WCC Tournament titles to his credit. He ranks as the second-winningest coach in program history, his 701 games coached are a school-record and he also earned a pair of WCC Coach of the Year awards.

In 2015, Pepperdine went 32-29 overall, 17-10 in the WCC and captured the WCC Tournament title for the second straight season to earn its eighth NCAA Tournament bid under Rodriguez. The Waves eliminated Clemson and Arizona State in Fullerton Regional action before falling to eventual College World Series entrant Cal-State Fullerton in the NCAA Regional final.

Rodriguez earned 2014 WCC Coach of the Year honors after leading the Waves to a 43-18 overall record (18-9 WCC), the program's most wins since 1999 and the seventh-most in program history, and a sweep of the WCC regular-season and tournament titles. Pepperdine went on to win the San Luis Obispo Regional with a 3-0 record to advance to its first-ever NCAA Super Regional (since the round was instituted in 1999), dropping a heart-breaking three-game series at nationally seeded TCU. Following the 2014 season, he served as an assistant coach with USA Baseball's Collegiate National Team.

Introduced as Pepperdine's 16th head coach on June 18, 2003, Rodriguez guided the Waves to NCAA Tournament appearances in each of his first five seasons as skipper (2004-08), averaging more than 37 wins per season in the process and winning at least 30 games every year, while capturing a pair of outright WCC crowns (2004 and 2005) and a share of the 2006 league title. Pepperdine also won three consecutive WCC Championship Series from 2004-06, advancing to the NCAA Regional final each season, and hosting its first-ever NCAA Regional in 2006.

The Waves were picked to finish fifth in the 2012 WCC preseason coaches poll, but beat San Diego in the final game of the regular season to clinch the league title and would go on to finish second at the NCAA Stanford Regional. For his efforts, Rodriguez was honored with his first WCC Coach of the Year award.

Rodriguez recruited and coached seven All-Americans at Pepperdine, including 2012 WCC Player of the Year Joe Sever, 2012 Brooks Wallace Award winner Zach Vincej and first-team All-American Aaron Brown, and his players earned 85 All-WCC honors. Four of his former players have reached the major leagues - Chase d'Arnaud, Barry Enright, Eric Thames and Danny Worth -- and his players were drafted by MLB clubs 43 times. The Waves tied a school record with nine players taken in the 2007 MLB Draft and had at least two players selected in 10 drafts.

In addition to enriching Pepperdine's proud history on the diamond, Rodriguez and his staff were also tireless fundraisers for the program. Those efforts have paid off with the installation of new stadium seats (2004), a new, state-of-the-art scoreboard (2007), a new backstop (2008), a new padded outfield wall (2009) and new turf in the batting cages (2011). Prior to becoming just the third Pepperdine player to later become the program's head coach, Rodriguez served as a Waves' assistant coach for four seasons, during which time Pepperdine compiled an overall record of 145-98 (.597), including an 88-32 (.733) mark in WCC play. The Waves captured the 2001 WCC title and made NCAA Tournament appearances in 2001 and 2003.

A fifth-round draft pick of the Boston Red Sox in 1992, Rodriguez played professionally for seven seasons with the Red Sox, Detroit Tigers, Los Angeles Dodgers and Montreal Expos organizations. He reached the majors with both Boston and Detroit in 1995.

A two-time All-American, he was named the 1992 WCC Player of the Year as the Waves posted a 48-11 mark and captured the program's first-ever College World Series title. Rodriguez was named to the All-CWS team and was part of two memorable plays in Omaha: a grand slam that helped defeat Texas in the semifinal round and a late-inning defensive gem in the Waves' 3-2 win over Cal State Fullerton in the championship game. During his three seasons (1990-92) at Pepperdine, the Waves posted a 126-51-5 (.706) record, including a 72-26 (.735) mark in league play, with league titles and NCAA Tournament trips in 1991 and 1992.

Rodriguez' career batting average of .367 ranks second on the Waves' all-time list, and despite playing just three seasons of collegiate baseball, he is tied for third on the school's all-time career runs scored chart (187) and is fourth in hits (271). A first-team All-WCC selection in 1991 and 1992, Rodriguez made a big splash as a sophomore in 1991 when he batted .419, the third-highest single-season average in school history. His 104 base hits that season set a Pepperdine single-season record that still stands and he still ranks among the top 10 in five different single-season categories. In 2001, Rodriguez was named one of the WCC's Top 50 athletes of all time, and was selected to the conference's 40th Anniversary baseball team in 2007. On Oct. 16, 2016, Rodriguez was inducted into the Pepperdine University Department of Athletics Hall of Fame.

The two-time member of Team USA played in the 1991 Pan American Games and earned "Player of the Series" honors against Mexico and Cuba. He was also named "Player of the Series" against Korea while a member of Team USA in 1992.

Following his professional playing career, Rodriguez enrolled in classes at Riverside Community College and Chapman University before returning to Pepperdine, where he received a bachelor's degree in public relations in December of 2001. He earned a master's degree in educational technology from Pepperdine in 2003.

Rodriguez and his wife, Kimberlee, have a daughter, Julia, who is a sophomore at Baylor, and a son, Nolan. In October 2007, he was honored by the City of Malibu with the Jake Kuredjian Award for his service to the community. In January 2010, Rodriguez won the Top Chef Award at the Baseball Coaches Cooking Challenge hosted by the ESPN Zone in Anaheim, Calif., and successfully defended his title in 2011.
