NOTABLES

• **SUCCESS AGAINST BAYLOR UNDER BARNES ...** Texas has posted a 26-4 record against Baylor during the Rick Barnes era entering Saturday's contest. The Horns are 12-1 under Barnes against the Bears in games played in Waco.

• **DEFENSE WINS ...** In its three Big 12 victories this year, Texas has held its opponents to an average of 51.7 points per game on a combined 37.4% FG shooting (58-of-155). UT limited Iowa State to a season-low 55 points on 33.3% FG shooting (20-of-60) in Tuesday's win.

• **TOUGH STRETCH CONTINUES ...** With upcoming back-to-back AP Top 10 opponents in No. 6 Baylor (Saturday) and No. 2 Missouri (Monday), Texas will have faced five AP Top 25 opponents (four in the AP Top 10) in a six-game stretch for the first time in school history.

Series vs. Baylor

Texas has faced Baylor more times (236 entering Saturday) than any other opponent. In fact, UT's opening four games in the school's first year of basketball (1906) came against the Bears (Texas won all four). The only time Texas and Baylor did not meet since 1906 was in 1908, when the Longhorns did not field a team. **The Horns have won 51 of the last 62 meetings between the two schools dating back to the 1982-83 season.**

Success Against Baylor in Waco

Texas holds a 64-46 advantage all-time against Baylor in games played in Waco entering Saturday's contest. **The Horns are 12-1 against the Bears in Waco during the Rick Barnes era.** Seven of the 12 wins have come by double-digit margins.

Lone Star State Success

Since Rick Barnes arrived in Austin, the Longhorns have emerged as the dominant college basketball program in the state of Texas. **The Horns have posted a 117-15 (.886) record against in-state foes during the Barnes era entering Saturday's contest,** including marks of 26-4 against Baylor, 22-7 against Texas A&M and 25-3 against Texas Tech.

Iowa State Game Notes

- Texas improved to 9-1 against Iowa State in games played in Austin.
- The Horns improved to 12-1 in home games this year.
- UT held the Cyclones to team season lows in points (55) and FG percentage (.333, 20-of-60). Texas improved to 10-0 this year when holding its opponent below 40% FG shooting.
- Texas posted a +7 (41-34) rebound margin. The Horns have outrebounded 14 of their first 20 opponents this season.
- **Myck Kabongo** (13 points) reached double figures in scoring for the 11th time this year and fourth time in Big 12 play.
- **Julien Lewis** (12 points) reached double figures in scoring for the eighth time this year and second time in Big 12 play. Lewis set a career high in rebounds (seven).
- **J'Covan Brown** (12 points) reached double figures in scoring for the 18th time this year and 51st time in his career (89 games).
- **Clint Chapman** (three blocks) recorded at least three blocked shots for the fifth time this season.

A Check of the Polls

Texas is not ranked in the latest Associated Press poll (Jan. 23) or the latest ESPN/USA Today Coaches poll (Jan. 23). UT was not ranked in either of the preseason polls, **marking the first time since the 2000-01 season that Texas has not appeared in either of the two major preseason rankings.** During the Rick Barnes

Did You Know ?

Facts on the Texas Basketball program

- Texas is one of just nine schools to have advanced to at least the "Sweet 16" of the NCAA Tournament in five of the last 10 years, joining Duke, Kansas, Connecticut, Arizona, Kentucky, Michigan State, North Carolina and Pittsburgh.
- Texas is one of just six programs to have advanced to each of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments, joining Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State and Wisconsin.
- Texas is the only school in the country that can claim two different National Player of the Year winners in the last nine years (T.J. Ford in 2003; Kevin Durant in 2007).
- Texas has produced three different consensus first-team All-Americans over the last nine seasons, tied with Duke and Kansas for the top total in the country during this stretch (Ford in 2003; Durant in 2007; D.J. Augustin in 2008).

era, the Horns have spent 175 weeks in The AP Top 25, including 84 in the Top 10.

A Consistent Dancer

Texas is one of just six schools to have advanced to each of the last 13 NCAA Tournaments (1999-2011). Joining the Horns in this group are: Duke, Gonzaga, Kansas, Michigan State and Wisconsin. UT ranks in a tie for fourth nationally for the longest current NCAA Tournament appearance streak.

13-in-a-Row

With their bid last year to the 2011 NCAA Tournament, the Horns extended their school-record streak of consecutive NCAA trips to 13. **Texas has advanced to the Big Dance in each of Rick Barnes' previous 13 seasons in Austin.** Prior to the Barnes era, UT's mark for consecutive NCAA Tournament bids was four (twice).

In "Sweet" Company

Texas has advanced to at least the NCAA "Sweet 16" a total of five times in the last 10 years (2002, 2003, 2004, 2006 and 2008). **The Longhorns are one of just nine schools to accomplish this feat,** joining Duke (8), Kansas (7), Connecticut (6), Arizona (5), Kentucky (5), Michigan State (5), North Carolina (5) and Pittsburgh (5).

An "Elite" Program

Texas has reached the NCAA "Elite Eight" twice in the last six years and three times in the last nine seasons. During the Barnes era, the Horns have made trips to the regional final in 2003 (beat Michigan State to advance to the Final Four), 2006 (lost to LSU in overtime) and 2008 (lost to Memphis).

Twelve Straight 20-Win Seasons

With a 28-8 record in 2010-11, the Longhorns reached the 20-win mark for the 12th straight year. Texas has reached the 30-win plateau twice in the previous six years (31-7 record in 2007-08, 30-7 mark in 2005-06). UT's current streak of 12 straight 20-win campaigns is a school record. Prior to the current streak, the previous school mark for most consecutive 20-win seasons was four (1988-89 to 1991-92). **The Horns have reached the 20-win plateau in all but one of Rick Barnes' seasons in Austin.** The Horns posted a 19-13 mark in 1998-99 and won the Big 12 Conference title.

Consistent Success in the Big 12

Texas has reached the 10-win mark in Big 12 Conference play a total of 10 times in the previous 13 seasons under Rick Barnes (all those years were 16-game league schedules). Texas posted 9-7 conference marks in 2004-05, 2008-09 and 2009-10. The Horns have recorded at least nine league wins in each of Barnes' 13 seasons in Austin. UT has recorded at least 13 conference victories in six of Barnes' first 13 seasons in Austin (13-3 in 1998-99, 1999-2000, 2002-03, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11).

13 Wins in Big 12 Play ... Again

Texas tied its school record for Big 12 wins in a year (13) during the 2010-11 season. The Horns have reached the 13-win mark a total of six times since the inception of the league in 1996-97 (1998-99, 1999-2000, 2002-03, 2005-06, 2007-08 and 2010-11).

Success Against Elite Programs Under Barnes

Texas has been successful against several elite programs during the Rick Barnes era. UT improved to 3-0 under Barnes against UCLA following the victory in Los Angeles (Dec. 3). The Horns are 4-3 vs. Michigan State and 3-1 vs. North Carolina in the Barnes era. In addition, UT has posted a 4-3 mark in home games against Kansas under Barnes.

Beating the Best

UT's win at No. 2 Kansas last year (Jan. 22) equaled the highest-ranked (AP) opponent the Longhorns have defeated in school history. **Six of Texas' nine all-time wins against AP Top Three teams have come during the Rick Barnes era.**

Success Against the AP Top 25

During his 14 seasons in Austin, Rick Barnes has registered a school-record 56 career victories against AP Top 25 opponents (previous mark: 10-44 by Tom Penders, 1989-98). Barnes has guided the Horns to a 56-68 (.452) record against ranked teams (0-4 this year). Barnes has posted 86 career victories against AP Top 25 foes.

Improvement on the Boards

The Longhorns have been a much improved rebounding team over the last 13 contests (8-5 record). **Texas has recorded a +6.8 rebound margin (38.8-31.9) during the stretch.**

□ The Horns registered a +24 rebound margin (52-28) against Nicholls State (Dec. 13), including a 24-9 edge on the offensive glass.

□ Texas posted a +25 rebound margin (48-23) against Temple (Dec. 17), including a 17-3 edge on the offensive glass.

□ UT recorded a +10 rebound margin (36-26) against No. 9/9 Missouri (Jan. 14), including a 16-8 edge on the offensive glass.

□ Texas registered a +7 rebound margin (42-35) against No. 7/7 Kansas (Jan. 21).

□ UT recorded a +7 rebound margin (41-34) against Iowa State (Jan. 24).

Defense Wins

Solid defense has been a trademark of the Texas program under Rick Barnes. This year, UT has allowed an average of 64.9 ppg on 39.2% FG shooting. Texas also has limited its first 20 opponents to 211 assists against 277 turnovers. **Since Barnes arrived in Austin, the Horns have held 225 of their 465 opponents to under 40% FG shooting.** Texas sports a 206-19 (.916) mark in the Barnes era when accomplishing the feat (10-0 this year).

Success from the Stripe

Texas has been solid from the free throw line through its first 20 contests. **The Horns have converted 72.7% (352-of-484) of their free throw attempts this season.** The highest FT percentage team at Texas in the Rick Barnes era came during the 2006-07 season (73.6%). The last time the Horns shot better than 75 percent from the stripe was during the 1977-78 season (76.0%).

□ Texas has converted 74.7% (121-of-162) from the stripe during its first seven Big 12 contests this year.

□ UT hit 90.5% (19-of-21) from the free throw line at No. 25/nr Kansas State (Jan. 18). The Horns converted 14-of-14 free throws in the first half at Kansas State. This marked the most free throws made without a miss in a half during a Big 12 Conference game in school history.

□ Texas converted a season-high 94.1% (16-of-17) from the free throw line against No. 7/7 Kansas (Jan. 21).

What Can Brown Do For You?

Junior guard **J'Covan Brown** has played in 89 career games (29 starts). **A Preseason All-Big 12 Team selection, Brown leads the team in scoring (19.1 ppg), steals (26) and minutes (34.0 mpg) and ranks second in assists (4.0 apg).** He has converted 41.0% (129-of-315) of his field goal attempts, including a 48-of-128 (.375) mark from three-point range. Brown has recorded 30-plus points twice this year, topped the 20-point mark 10 times and reached double figures in scoring in 18 of the first 20 games.

□ He posted a game-high 22 points (9-of-15 FG, 4-of-8 threes) at UCLA (Dec. 3).

□ Brown tallied a team-high 23 points (10-of-21 FG) against Temple (Dec. 17).

□ He recorded a game-high 23 points (7-of-16 FG, 6-of-6 FT) against Rice (Dec. 31).

□ Brown tallied a game-high 24 points, seven assists against two turnovers, six rebounds and three steals in 37 minutes against No. 7/7 Kansas (Jan. 21).

Brown Reaches 1,000-Point Milestone

With his made three-pointer at the 16:15 mark of the second half during the loss at No. 9/9 Missouri (Jan. 14), **J'Covan Brown became the 33rd player in UT history to reach the 1,000-point milestone.** Brown enters Saturday's contest with 1,075 points in 89 career games (12.1 ppg).

Brown's Big Day at Missouri

J'Covan Brown had one of the best offensive performances in his UT career during the loss at No. 9/9 Missouri (Jan. 14). Brown tallied 34 points while converting 10-of-16 field goals, including 6-of-7 threes, and 8-of-8 free throws in 38 minutes.

□ The 34 points marked the most by a visiting player in Mizzou Arena history.

□ **Brown** was just one point shy of his career high (35 vs. Rhode Island on Nov. 15, 2011). He set a career high in three-

Behind the Scenes with the Horns

□ **Sterling Gibbs** has an older brother, Ashton, who is a senior guard at the University of Pittsburgh. Gibbs' father, Temple, played football at Temple University.

□ **J'Covan Brown** has a one-year old daughter, Jordyn Brown (born July 26, 2010). Brown also is the cousin of former Texas Basketball standout B.J. Tyler (1992-94). Tyler earned third-team All-America honors from The Associated Press, Basketball Weekly and UPI as a senior in 1994 and was the MVP of the 1994 Southwest Conference Postseason Tournament. Tyler was the No. 20 pick in the 1994 NBA Draft by the Philadelphia 76ers.

□ **Clint Chapman's** father, Kenny Chapman, is a senior firefighting pilot for Erickson Air-Crane. Mr. Chapman has been deployed throughout the U.S. and the world to fight forest fires. The Chapman family actually lived in Australia twice for three-month stretches during the winter when Clint was nine and 10 years old.

□ **Myck Kabongo** is the second-youngest among six children. He was born in Lumbaschi, Congo. Kabongo spent his first three years in Congo Republic and then lived in Capetown, South Africa from age 3 to 6. His family moved to Toronto when Kabongo was six years old.

□ **Julien Lewis** wears jersey number 0 because he wanted to make a fresh start at the collegiate level. His parents gave him the name 'Julien' to honor his maternal grandmother, Julian Woodard. Julien was given his nickname "Juice" by a close hometown friend when he was 12 years old.

□ **Sheldon McClellan** is the cousin of Jawan McClellan, a former McDonald's All-American from Houston's Milby HS who played his college basketball at Arizona (2005-08).

□ **Dean Melchionni** is the son of Gary Melchionni. His father was an All-ACC performer at Duke (1970-73) and a second-round pick of the Phoenix Suns in the 1973 NBA Draft. Dean's brother, Lee, was a four-year letterwinner at Duke (2003-06). Dean's uncle, Bill Melchionni, played college basketball at Villanova and starred in the NBA with the Philadelphia 76ers and New Jersey Nets. Bill's jersey number was retired by both Villanova and the Nets.

□ **Alexis Wangmene's** legal guardians are R.C. and Beth Buford. R.C., who is the general manager of the San Antonio Spurs, discovered Wangmene in 2004 during the NBA's Basketball without Borders trip to South Africa, when Wangmene was 15. Wangmene's native tongue is French, the language spoken in Cameroon. He learned English in six months during his sophomore year at San Antonio Central Catholic High School. Wangmene attended the same prep school (Blair Academy in Blairstown, N.J.) as former Texas player Royal Ivey. Wangmene wears jersey No. 20 to honor his father (Teophile Mang-Ikri), who wore the same number when he played in Cameroon.

□ **Brown** became the first UT player to record at least 30 points in a Big 12 Conference road game since **D.J. Augustin** posted 30 points at Texas Tech on March 1, 2008.

Two-Time Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week

J'Covan Brown has earned Phillips 66 Big 12 Player of the Week honors twice already this season.

□ Brown picked up his first weekly honor on Nov. 14, posting 28 points (10-of-19 FG), eight assists against one turnover and four rebounds against Boston University (Nov. 13).

□ Brown earned his second weekly honor on Nov. 21, averaging 30.0 points, 7.5 assists, 6.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game in UT's games against Rhode Island and Oregon State. He recorded a career-high 35 points (10-of-22 FG, 5-of-10 threes, 10-of-12 FT), six assists without a turnover and six rebounds against Rhode

Island (Nov. 15). Brown then tallied 25 points (8-of-14 FG, 5-of-8 threes), nine assists, six boards and three steals in a career-high 44 minutes during the OT loss to Oregon State (Nov. 19).

Brown's Success at the Stripe

J'Covan Brown has established himself as one of the top free throw shooters in UT history.

□ Brown currently ranks third on the school's all-time career FT percentage list, as he has converted 264-of-305 (.866) from the stripe in his career.

□ He has hit 76-of-89 (.854) free throws this season, including 36-of-38 (.947) in Big 12 Conference play.

□ Brown had his streak of 28 consecutive free throws made (tied for second longest in UT history) snapped on his first attempt in Tuesday's game against Iowa State.

□ **In his last eight games, Brown has converted 42-of-44 (.955) free throws.**

Alexis Wangmene and **Clint Chapman** are both in their fifth year in the Texas program. Wangmene was granted a medical redshirt year in 2008-09 (right knee injury), while Chapman elected to red-shirt last season (2010-11). This past December, Wangmene earned his bachelor's degree in French, while Chapman earned his bachelor's degree in Corporate Communication.

Chapman Showing Improvement

Clint Chapman has played in 103 career games (nine starts). He leads the team in rebounding (5.8 rpg) and blocks (35) while averaging 6.9 points in 21.8 minutes per contest this season.

□ **Through the first seven Big 12 games, Chapman has averaged 10.4 points (second on team), a team-best 6.6 rebounds and 1.6 blocks in 28.3 minutes per contest.** He has converted 25-of-45 (.556) field goals and 23-of-28 (.821) free throws.

□ Bond posted his first collegiate double-double against Nicholls State (Dec. 13) and set career highs in points (18), field goals made (9-of-12), rebounds (12), assists (two) and minutes (24). Eight of his 12 boards came on the offensive glass.

□ He tallied 12 points (6-of-7 FG), eight rebounds (four offensive) and one steal in 22 minutes against Temple (Dec. 17).

Three-Point Streak

The last time Texas did not convert a three-pointer in a contest came on Dec. 18, 1990, in an 87-84 overtime victory at UC-Santa Barbara. The Horns were 0-of-2 from beyond the arc on that day.

The Longhorns enter Saturday's game having hit at least one 3-pointer in 708 consecutive games. In fact, UT has converted at least one three in 837 of 843 games since the trey was introduced prior to the 1986-87 season. The Horns have failed to attempt at least one 3-pointer just one time in school history (Feb. 24, 1988; at TCU, 69-55 win).

Success in the Classroom

Texas had four players earn a spot on the 2011 Academic All-Big 12 Men's Basketball Team (Dogus Balbay, **J'Covan Brown** and Gary Johnson on the first team and Jordan Hamilton on the second team). **This marked the fourth straight year that the Longhorns had the most Academic All-Big 12 honors in the sport of men's basketball.** UT had six players earn the accolade in both 2008 and 2009 and five players claim a spot in 2010.

Four high school hoop standouts signed National Letters of Intent during the fall signing period to play basketball next season at The University of Texas. **Javan Felix (New Orleans, La.)**, **Prince Ibeh (Garland, Texas)**, **Connor Lammert (San Antonio, Texas)** and **Ioannis Papapetrou (Melbourne, Fla.)** will join the Horns for the 2012-13 season.

□ **Felix** (jah-VAHN fil-LEEKs), a point guard at St. Augustine HS who plays under coach Clifford Barthe, is ranked as the No. 70 prospect in the nation and the No. 9 point guard nationally by ESPN. Felix (5-11, 190), the 2011 Louisiana 5A Player of the Year, averaged 13.5 points, five assists and three steals per game while leading St. Augustine to a 31-6 mark and the Louisiana 5A state title.

□ **Ibeh** (E-bay), a forward/center from Naaman Forest HS who plays under coach Jeff Clarkson, is ranked as the No. 54 prospect in the nation and the No. 10 center nationally by Rivals.com. Ibeh (6-11, 230) averaged 6.5 points, 9.3 rebounds and 5.2 blocks per game as a junior.

□ **Lammert** (Lamm-irt), a forward from Churchill HS who plays under coach Tim Woods, averaged 10 points, six rebounds, two blocks and two assists per game while leading Churchill to a 31-6 mark as a junior. Last season, Barnes earned his 500th career victory and became the 12th active Men's Basketball Division I coach to reach the 500-win milestone (counting victories only while at Division I schools).
