

FLOYD CASEY STADIUM



BAGS – Small bags and purses are permitted but may be no larger than 12" x 10" x 6". No large bags or backpacks will be allowed inside the stadium. All items brought into the stadium are subject to search.

Bear Club – Premium seating area at FCS, for further information contact the Bear Foundation at 254-710-2582.

Bear Heights – Premium seating area at FCS, for further information contact the Bear Foundation at 254-710-2582.

Bear Place – Premium seating area at FCS, for further information contact the Bear Foundation at 254-710-2582.

Bear Zone – Bear Foundation pre-game function area located at the south end of FCS.

Cameras and Video Equipment – Cameras are permitted within Floyd Casey Stadium, however long professional style lenses are not allowed. Also flash photography is strictly prohibited. Video cameras are not allowed inside the stadium.

Concessions – Are available on both the east and west concourses.

Emergency Announcements – Are not made during the game. In the event of an emergency, please notify security personnel in the concourse areas.

First Aid Stations – Located under Sections V and G.

Floyd Casey Stadium Name – Became known as Floyd Casey Stadium at halftime of the Baylor-Arkansas game on November 5, 1988. The stadium was previously known as Baylor Stadium since 1950.

Galloway Suites – Located in the north end zone of FCS – home to VIP premium seating and pregame Bear Foundation functions.

Gates Open – Two hours prior to kick-off.

Grant Teaff Plaza – Honors BU's legendary Hall of Fame coach and can be found on the outside of the east and west concourse.

Group Sales – Are available for four of six home games this year (excludes Texas and Nebraska). Individual ticket pricing for groups of 15 or more is \$20.00 per person. For further information, contact the Baylor Athletic Marketing Office at 254-710-8110.

Guest Relations – Contact an usher or security personnel in the stadium or go to the main ticket office in the north end zone.

Handicapped Parking – Is available surrounding Floyd Casey Stadium. Patrons with a state issued hang tag may access the parking on a first-come-first-served basis.

Handicapped Seating – Is available at FCS – please contact the ticket office for further information at 254-710-1000.

Homecoming – Will be October 24th versus Oklahoma State.

Lost and Found – Any lost items should be delivered to the North End Zone Ticket Office.

Mathew Dove Letterwinners Plaza – Located outside on the east side of the stadium. Pays tribute to all letterwinners who have ever worn the Green and Gold.

Merchandise, Novelties and Apparel – May be purchased in Bear Essentials on the west side concourse, in Touchdown Alley prior to the game or throughout the stadium at Baylor Bookstore kiosks.

Parents' Weekend – Will be on September 19th versus Connecticut.

Parking – To request preferred parking areas adjacent to FCS, please call the Bear Foundation at 254-710-2582. All other parking on game day is \$10.00.

Re-Entry – With game ticket and pass-out check, is allowed only through Gates 1, 6 and 9.

RV Parking – Is available for \$25.00 per game and is located at the Hart-Patterson Track Complex.

Shuttles – Are run from two locations on campus (Bill Daniel Student Center and the Ferrell Center) to Touchdown Alley beginning two hours prior to kick-off.

Snickers Touchdown Alley – Opens three hours prior to kickoff and is located outside of the south end zone adjacent to Dutton Street. The fun-filled family area includes: a live pre-game radio show, music, food/drinks, inflatable games, face painting, photo opportunities, and much, much more. Touchdown Alley closes 30 minutes prior to kick-off.

Stadium Policy – No ice chest or coolers, outside food or drink, amplified noise makers, umbrellas, signs for political purposes, firearms or other weapons shall be permitted. The stadium is also a non-smoking venue.

Strollers – Are not allowed at Floyd Casey Stadium.

Student Parking – Baylor student parking is available adjacent to Touchdown Alley. Additional student parking is located in lot L. All vehicles must have a valid Baylor parking sticker and the driver must present a valid Baylor ID. Both areas are first-come-first-served.

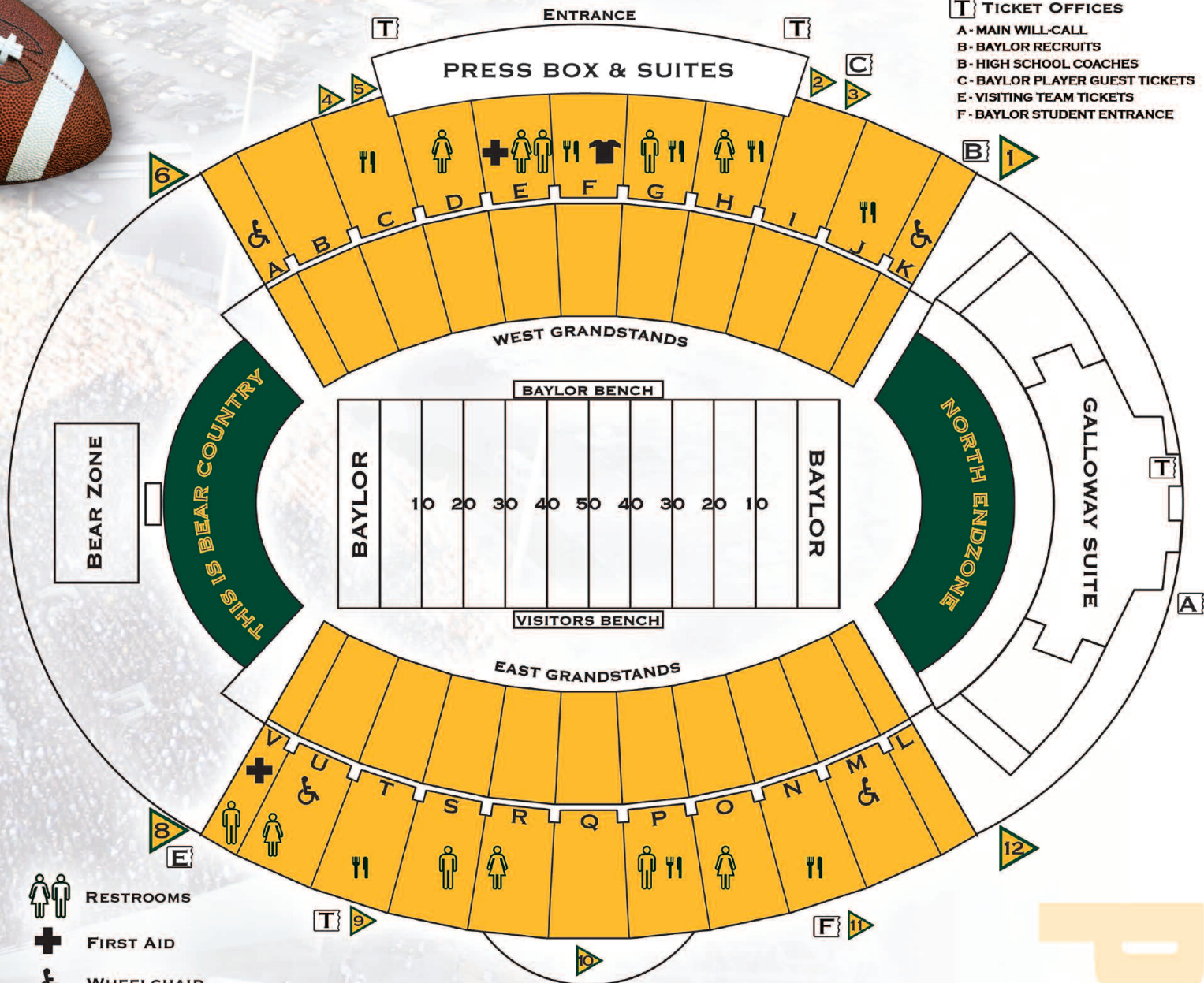

VIP Seating – Premium seating area in the Galloway Suites, for further information contact the Bear Foundation at 254-710-2582.

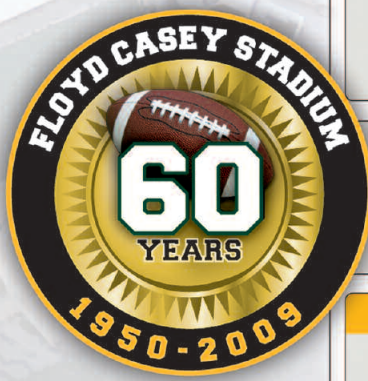
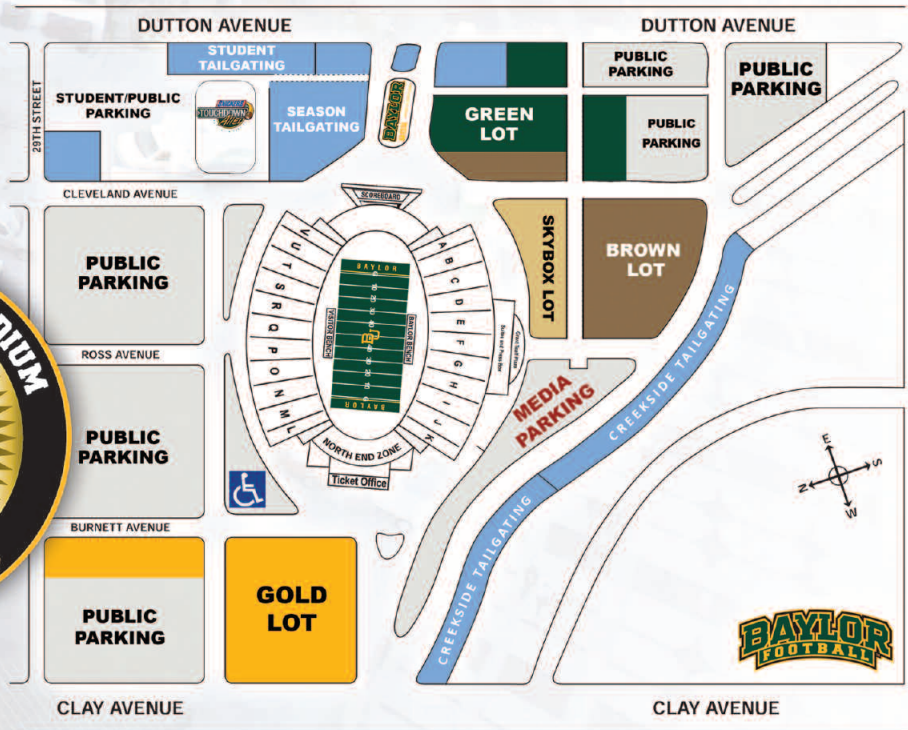
