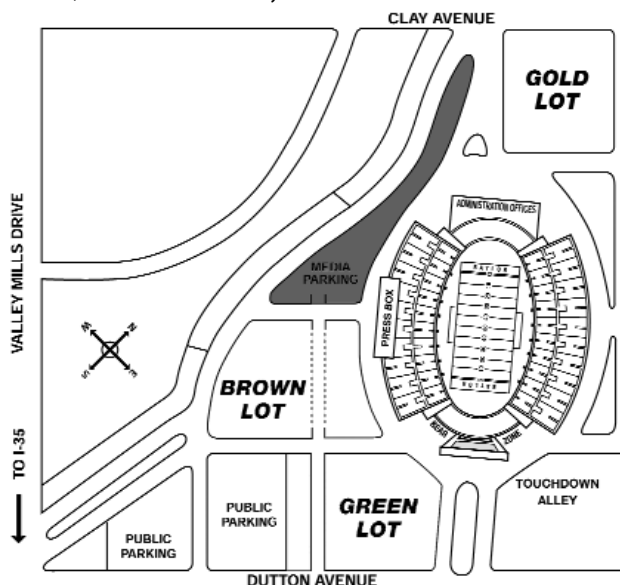

### DIRECTIONS TO FLOYD CASEY STADIUM

Floyd Casey Stadium is located off Valley Mills Drive, between Dutton and Clay avenues.

- **FROM NORTH (Southbound on I-35):** Exit "Valley Mills Drive" [Exit #333A] and turn West (right) onto Valley Mills. Stadium is approximately one mile ahead on right.
- **FROM SOUTH (Northbound on I-35):** Exit "Valley Mills Drive" [Exit #333A] and take Traffic Circle (270 degrees) onto Valley Mills. Stadium is approximately one mile ahead on right.
- **FROM WEST (Eastbound on Hwy. 84):** At Franklin/Waco Drive split stay right on Franklin, turn right onto 32nd Street. Three blocks ahead to Clay.
- **FROM EAST (Westbound on Hwy. 84):** Turn South (left) onto I-35 and follow directions above.
- **FROM NORTHWEST (Southeastbound on Hwy. 6):** Turn East (left) onto Hwy. 84, follow directions above.
- **FROM SOUTHEAST (Northwestbound on Hwy. 6):** Merge onto Spur 434, turn South (left) on Bus. 77/LaSalle to Traffic Circle. Exit off Traffic Circle onto Valley Mills. Stadium is approximately one mile ahead on right.

## MEDIA INFORMATION

### DAVE CAMPBELL MEDIA CENTER

The Dave Campbell Media Center, located on the fifth level of the Floyd Casey Stadium skybox complex, opens three hours prior to game time. The working press box and TV booth are located in the center of the fifth floor, while the radio and coaches booths are at the far ends.

Meals will be served two hours before kickoff. Media credentials are required for admittance to the press box and for meals.

Game notes, programs and media guides are provided prior to the game. Play-by-play, stats and quotes are provided during and after the game.

Several "0-plus" telephone lines are available on a first-come, first-served basis in the working media area and complimentary wireless Internet is also available. On game day, Baylor telecommunications representatives will be on hand to handle any last-minute problems.

### SIDELINES

Baylor follows guidelines set forth by the NCAA Public Relations Committee, the NCAA Football Rules Committee, the American Football Coaches Association and the National Press Photographers Association. Photographers are not permitted to shoot between the 25-yard lines and must have credentials visible at all times.

In an effort to insure the best possible working conditions for media photographers, uniformed security personnel will be patrolling the sidelines. Anyone holding a media pass who is not actively involved in coverage of the game will be escorted from the sideline. Similar procedures will be in effect in the press box.

### WEEKLY PRESS LUNCHEON

Head coach Art Briles and requested football student-athletes meet with the media each Tuesday preceding a game in Floyd Casey Stadium's Galloway Suite (third floor of the North end zone building). Lunch is served at noon, followed by interviews.

Requests for specific interviews with student-athletes or assistant coaches should be made to the Media Relations Office by **4 p.m. Sunday** preceding the media luncheon.

### ADDITIONAL INTERVIEWS

In addition to Tuesday's media luncheon, Baylor student-athletes (Tue., Wed.) and coaches (Tue., Wed., Thu.) will be available for in-person or phone interviews before practice. Requests should be directed to **Heath Nielsen**.

**All interview requests must be coordinated through the Athletic Media Relations Office with at least one day advance notice.** Student-athlete's phone numbers will not be given out.

Coaches and student-athletes are not available for interviews the day before a game or on game day.

### SUNDAY AVAILABILITY

Baylor head coach Art Briles will hold a media briefing in his office each Sunday at 2:15 p.m. CT during the season.

Media members wishing to participate via phone may do so by contacting a member of the Baylor Athletic Media Relations staff. Excerpts and Sunday notes will be available on Baylor's official website, [www.BaylorBears.com](http://www.BaylorBears.com), by 6 p.m. CT each week.

### POSTGAME INTERVIEWS

The Baylor locker room is located below the north end zone at Floyd Casey Stadium. The visiting locker room is located beneath the east stands.

Baylor coach Art Briles and requested players will be available in the team meeting room approximately 10 minutes following the game. Baylor's locker room will remain closed following games.

**Baylor University is committed to a policy of equal access for both male and female reporters and photographers.**

The visiting SID will establish visiting locker room admittance policies.

### BIG 12 TELECONFERENCE

In conjunction with the Big 12 Conference, Baylor head coach Art Briles will participate in the league's weekly teleconference. The teleconferences will be conducted each Monday from Aug. 25 until Dec. 1 from 10 a.m. until noon CT. Briles' scheduled time is 11 a.m. to 11:10 a.m. CT each Monday.

Media representatives wishing to participate in the teleconference should contact the league communications staff for further details. A replay of the briefing will be available after 4 p.m. CT.



### PRACTICE COVERAGE

All Baylor football practices are open to the media and public. As a general rule, video and still photographers may shoot the entire pre-practice (stretching period) and the first 20 minutes of actual practice time. At no time should photographers shoot from the end zone.

Following each session, head coach Art Briles will conduct a group interview with the media. A member of the AMR staff will be on hand at every practice to assist the media.

### MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Working media and photographer credentials for Baylor's 2008 home games against Wake Forest, Northwestern State, Washington State, Oklahoma, Iowa State, Missouri and Texas A&M will be handled by Associate AD for External Affairs Nick Joos.

**Requests should be made in writing** by sports editors or sports directors of accredited media outlets on company letterhead. Requests should be made as early as possible and should be **limited to working media only. Requests made within seven days of the game may not be considered.**

Credentials will be mailed to the requesting individual or organization if time permits or sent to the visiting school's sports information director for distribution. Credentials can also be picked up in the Media Relations Office located at Floyd Casey Stadium or on game day at media will call in the elevator lobby of the Floyd Casey Stadium press box.

Media parking at Floyd Casey Stadium is available on a limited basis on the west side of the stadium. Requests for parking passes should be made well in advance to the Media Relations Office.

### UNAUTHORIZED USE OF MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Credentials will be issued to working media only. Media credentials are not transferable and use by anyone other than members of the working media is unauthorized. Media credentials used in an unauthorized manner will be revoked immediately. News organizations allowing unauthorized individuals to use credentials will have their credentials revoked for the remainder of the year.

### WEBSITES & NEW MEDIA

Web-based media sponsoring "message boards" or "chat rooms" that allow posting of anonymous information or rumors are **ineligible** for credentials or access to media functions. If a news-gathering medium has an online site that sponsors anonymous forums, they may continue to request credentials under their traditional medium (newspaper, magazine, radio or television) but will not be granted additional passes or access for online staff.

Any online service that places emphasis on the recruitment of potential student-athletes will not qualify for credentials.

Credentials will not be granted to any online agency operating sites that are in any way affiliated with gambling, or to "freelance" or "fan-based" sites that are not affiliated with a legitimate news gathering organization.

Live, real-time updates of Baylor home games are the property of Baylor University and unauthorized transmission of such is not permitted.

## RADIO/TV INFORMATION

### BAYLOR ISP SPORTS NETWORK

Bears fans will once again be able to follow every minute of Baylor football this season on the Baylor-ISP Radio Network thanks to its experienced crew of professionals who broadcast the action worldwide.

The "Voice of the Bears," **John Morris** (Baylor, 1980) enters his 22nd year broadcasting Baylor football and men's basketball in 2008-09. An assistant AD and member of the ISP team, Morris produces the daily "State Farm Baylor SportsBeat," daily Big 12 reports and co-hosts the award-winning "Inside Baylor Sports" television show. The Kentucky native also hosts "The Central National Bank Art Briles Show" in the fall, the "State Farm Baylor Hour" January through May and a daily 60-minute program, "The John Morris Show," on Waco's 1660 ESPN Radio. This is Morris' 14th year as signature voice of Baylor athletics since succeeding the legendary Frank Fallon. In 2002, he was presented the Frank Fallon Sportsmanship Award.

Three-time Academic All-American **J.J. Joe** returns for his fifth season as color analyst. The Bears' leading passer for four consecutive seasons from 1990-1993, Joe graduated as Baylor's career passing and total offense leader and is one of the school's most decorated student-athletes as a three-time Academic All-American. He serves as a partner and the Chief Financial Officer for Beverly Sue Global Services. Joe was inducted into the Baylor Athletic Hall of Fame in 2006.

**Ricky Thompson** returns for his ninth season providing sideline color and analysis. Thompson is a former SWC long jump champion and was the Bears' leading receiver in 1975 before embarking on a seven-year NFL career. He is also a member of the Baylor Athletic Hall of Fame and serves as President of Waco's First National Bank of Central Texas.

The multi-talented **Craig Harper** is in his 22nd year as executive producer of the football broadcast crew. Harper is the award-winning Director of Engineering for the Belo Corporation in Dallas.

Baylor University and ISP Sports are in the fourth year of a seven-year agreement that provides the company, recognized as the national leader in collegiate sports marketing, with exclusive multi-media rights for the school's highly successful 18-sport intercollegiate athletics program. In the agreement's first three years, the Baylor ISP partnership has generated record sales revenues.

She joined the Baylor team after completing her Master of Sport Administration at Belmont University in Nashville, Tenn., and serving as an intern with the Vanderbilt/ISP Sports Network.

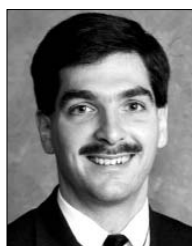

## BIG 12 CONFERENCE

The Big 12 Conference has established a consistent level of national success on the field and in the classroom as it enters its 13th season in 2008-09.

Since it began play in 1996-97, the Conference can boast 31 team crowns and over 385 individual NCAA Championships. The success continued during 2007-08 as Kansas captured the Big 12's first national title in men's basketball, while the league added 31 individual crowns.

Over the past four seasons a total of 12 NCAA trophies have been hoisted by Big 12 institutions, with at least one national crown won in all but one year for the Conference, including each of the past 11 seasons.

The Big 12 leads all conferences with five appearances in Bowl Championship Series title games. League squads have played for the football national championship five times in the last nine years with berths in 14 BCS games overall, including two in 2007. The Big 12 led all conferences with four teams ranked in the Top 10 in the final national polls a season ago. In addition, an all-time high eight league players earned consensus All-America recognition in 2007, more than any other conference.

In basketball, nine men's and women's teams have advanced to their respective Final Fours in the past seven seasons as the Big 12 continues its place among the elite intercollegiate athletic conferences. The six men's Final Four participants since 2002 is more than any conference. Numerous national honors have been won by basketball student-athletes during the league's history, with Michael Beasley (Kansas State), D.J. Augustin (Texas) and Courtney Paris (Oklahoma) the most recent to garner accolades as consensus All-America in 2007-08.

The Big 12 and its member institutions are committed to a competitive environment where sportsmanship and fair play take center stage. Whether on the field, in the classroom, or within the community the student-athletes, administrators, coaches and game officials of the Big 12 support the highest ideals in sportsmanship.

Big 12 student-athletes also do well in garnering national academic recognition. Sarah Pavan (Nebraska) was named Academic All-America of the Year in volleyball the past two seasons by ESPN The Magazine and College Sports Information Directors of America with a 4.0 grade-point average in Biochemistry. She also won the national academic honor presented for all sports in 2006-07 and was named recipient of the prestigious 2006-07 Honda-Broderick Award as Collegiate Woman Athlete of the Year. She is the first athlete since the Big 12 was formed to earn the accolade. In addition to his athletic accomplishments, Augustin was an Academic All-America First Team choice. In its history, the conference can boast of over 300 academic honorees, averaging more than 25 each season.

The Big 12 can boast of other stories that combine on and off the field success. Patience Knight (Texas Tech) was the recipient of the Honda Inspiration Award in 2008, given to an outstanding female college athlete who overcomes adversity to excel in her sport. She was diagnosed with a cancerous tumor in 2007, but rebounded to win All-America honors at the 2008 NCAA Indoor Track & Field Championships.

Competitive excellence, scholarship and sportsmanship are all equal components of the Big 12 philosophy. All-Big 12 teams and Academic All-Big 12 squads are recognized for each sport at the end of their respective seasons.

At the end of each academic year, the Conference honors its top male and female student-athletes with the Big 12 Athlete of the Year and Big 12 Sportsman of the Year awards.

Institutions can also nominate student-athletes for the prestigious Dr. Prentice Gautt Postgraduate Scholarships at the end of each academic year. A total of 201 scholars have received over \$1.2 million in postgraduate financial aid through the first 12 years of the program.

The Big 12 sponsors 21 sports. Men's squads include baseball, basketball, cross country, football, golf, indoor track & field, outdoor track & field, swimming & diving, tennis and wrestling. Women's teams are fielded in basketball, cross country, golf, gymnastics, indoor track & field, outdoor track & field, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis and volleyball.

The conference is made up of 12 institutions that have shared many traditional rivalries throughout their histories. Member schools include - Baylor, Colorado, Iowa State, Kansas, Kansas State, Missouri, Nebraska, Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Texas, Texas A&M and Texas Tech.

The institutions created a league that encompasses seven states, over 45 million people and television households in 18 of the top 100 markets within its geographic footprint.

The conference conducts championships for 20 of its 21 sports. Each championship helps to determine teams and/or individuals that will represent the Conference in national postseason competition. The winner of the

Big 12 football championship game earns the league's berth into the prestigious Bowl Championship Series.

In the last several years the Big 12 has increased its bowl agreements and expanded television opportunities for all sports through contracts with ABC/ESPN, FSN and CBS College Sports. Most recently, the league renewed and expanded its multi-year arrangement with ABC/ESPN, Inc. The new contract begins in 2008-09.

In its first 12 years, the Conference has distributed more than \$1 billion to its 12 member institutions.

The Big 12 staff administers to over 4,600 student-athletes in 21 sports. The conference is headquartered in Irving, Texas.



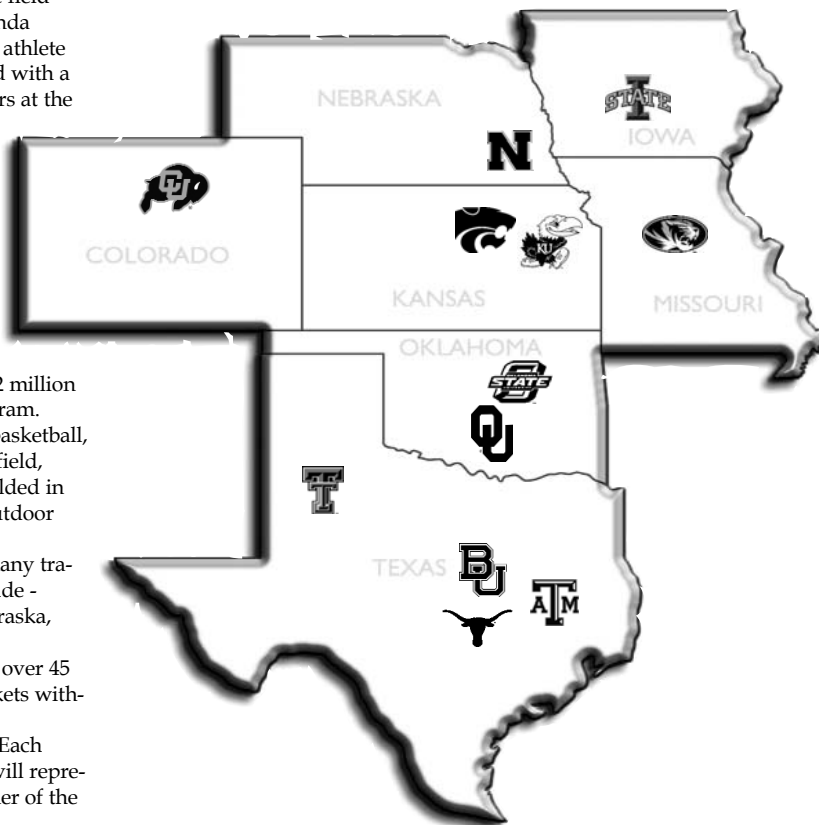
