



2008 BAYLOR INTERCOLLEGIATE

Hosted by Baylor University | Royal Oaks Country Club (Dallas, Texas)
Monday, October 27-Tuesday, October 28, 2008

Baylor University will host the 2008 Baylor Intercollegiate Oct. 27-28 in Dallas. The first-year event will be held at the Royal Oaks Country Club. The 54-hole format will begin with rounds one and two on Monday followed by the final 18 holes on Tuesday. Live scoring will be available at **Golfstat.com** and results will posted on **BaylorBears.com** and e-mailed to the SID of each participating school at the end of the day.

The 12-team field includes: Arkansas, Baylor, BYU, College of Charleston, Houston, Kansas, Lamar, New Mexico, Oklahoma, SMU, Saint Mary's and Texas A&M. In the latest *Golf World*/NIKE Golf Top 25 Coaches' Poll, Arkansas is No. 14, followed by Baylor at No. 17.

BAYLOR NOTES

- Baylor won back-to-back tournaments to open the season in September. The Bears shot 16-over 880 to claim the Shoal Creek Intercollegiate in Birmingham, Ala. The following week, the Bears scorched the Hartford Hawks Invitational field, shooting 10-under 566 in two rounds for their second win.
- Baylor's win streak ended Tuesday when the Bears finished fourth at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate in Alabama. The Bears finished behind No. 8 Alabama, No. 20 Auburn and SMU, while finishing ahead of No. 21 UNLV.
- The Bears have shot under-par as a team in their last two tournaments.
- Redshirt freshman **Lorenzo Scottto** leads the team with a 71.20 stroke average through five rounds. **Colton Williams** is second with 71.63, followed by **Cody Paladino** at 71.88.
- Williams is the only Bear to have 100 percent of his rounds count towards the team's score this season.
- Last week, Williams ranked 33rd overall in *Golfweek's* individual rankings, while the Baylor Bears ranked 5th.
- Paladino leads the team with four sub-par rounds, including a pair of 66 scores.
- As a team, Baylor is averaging 285.6 strokes per round.
- The Baylor men's golf team cracked the latest edition of the *Golf World*/NIKE Golf Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll, debuting at No. 17 on Oct. 16. Baylor is one of seven schools to make their Top 25 debut this week.
- The Bears, making their first appearance in *Golf World*/NIKE Poll since the 2006-07 season, received 212 votes - two behind No. 16 UNLV. BU finished two strokes ahead of the UNLV Rebels earlier this week at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate in Birmingham, Ala.
