MEN'S GOLF CHIP SHOTS

THE ROAD TO THE NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS

Baylor will make its 12th-straight NCAA Regional appearance when the Bears head to the 13-team NCAA Stillwater Regional at Karsten Creek Golf Club in Stillwater, Okla., May 14-16. Baylor, the No. 8 seed in the Regional, will face Oklahoma State, Arkansas, TCU, LSU, Chattanooga, Pepperdine, Michigan State, Northwestern, Tulsa, Denver, Wichita State and Oral Roberts.

LOOKING FOR NUMBER FIVE

While Baylor is making its 14th NCAA Regional appearance in school history, the Bears are also looking to make just the program's fifth NCAA Championships. Baylor's last NCAA Championships appearance came in 2002, when the Bears finished 19th overall. Before that, Baylor made three NCAA Championships appearances in the 1960s, finishing as high as ninth overall in 1960.

ALLCORN'S IMPRESSIVE RUN AT BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP FALLS SHORT, FINISHES SECOND OVERALL

Senior **Bill Allcorn** led the field through 54 holes and, at one point, was the only golfer under par. However, Allcorn shot a final-round even-par 70, while Oklahoma State's Morgan Hoffmann cared a 4-under 66 to win Big 12 Championship individual medalist honors.

SCHOOL-RECORD SIX GOLFERS NAMED ACADEMIC ALL-BIG 12

A school-record six Baylor men's golfers were named to the 2009 Academic All-Big 12 Men's Golf Team April 21. Baylor's six Academic All-Big 12 selections led the league on the men's side. Seniors **Bill Allcorn**, **Matt Crosby**, **Carmine Mediate** and sophomore **Cody Paladino** represented Baylor on the first team; Allcorn is the first golfer in BU history to be named Academic All-Big 12 all four years. Redshirt freshman **Lorenzo Scotto** and senior **Ben Wright** were named to the second team.

SEEING 6s

Sophomore **Cody Paladino** fired back-to-back rounds of 66 to help the Bears to a fourth-place finish at the Jerry Pate National Intercollegiate in Oct.

BEARS CLAIM SHOAL CREEK TITLE

Clinging to an eight-stroke lead at the start of the final round, Baylor was able to fend off a furious rally by Ole Miss to claim the 2008 Shoal Creek Intercollegiate team title Sept. 23. Baylor shot 11-over par as a team in the final round to finish 16-over for the tournament, two strokes ahead of No. 30 Ole Miss. Baylor held off five preseason Top 30 teams to win their second consecutive season-opening tournament. Returning All-Big 12 performer **Colton Williams** posted the Bears' highest individual finish tied for ninth at 4-over 220.

Competing in third NCAA Regional, best finish: t121st at 2007 NCAA Central Regional ■ Finished 2nd at Big 12 Championship, earning All-Tournament honors ■ Has five top-10 and three top-5 finishes to his credit this season ■ Carded career-low 54-hole score of 209 at Big 12 Championship ■ One of only two Bears to play all 35 rounds this season ■ Leads team with 73.11 stroke average and 1.69 score vs. par ■ Lowest round was 67 in final round at Ron Smith Invitational ■ Four-time Academic All-Big 12 selection.

Competing in first NCAA Regional ■ Played in five tournaments in first season at Baylor ■ Sophomore transfer from Arkansas carded a season-low round of 69 at Aggie Invitational and finished t36th overall at 7-over 151 - his highest finish this season ■ Started in Baylor's lineup in season-opening tournament at Shoal Creek; finished t44th at 16-over 232 ■ Posted a 77.07 stroke average in 15 rounds.

Competing in first NCAA Regional ■ Freshman has been a solid addition to Baylor's lineup, playing in all 12 tournaments ■ Posted four top-15 finishes (two top-10) in five fall tournaments, including a 6th-place showing at Baylor Intercollegiate ■ Second on team in stroke average (73.26) and score vs. par (1.83) ■ Averaged an impressive 71.64 during fall campaign ■ Finished t7th at 2-under 214 with Allcorn at Ron Smith in March.

Competing in second NCAA Regional ■ Finished 127th last season ■ Has played in 11 of Baylor's 12 tournaments this season ■ Tied for team lead with 13 rounds of par or better ■ Carded back-to-back career-low rounds of 66 at Jerry Pate Intercollegiate in October ■ Has posted four top-10 finishes this season, including t6th at Jerry Pate (-3 207) ■ Carded team-best four rounds in 60s (2 66s, 3 69s) ■ 2009 First-team Academic All-Big 12 pick.

Competing in second NCAA Regional ■ Finished t102nd last season ■ Baylor's top individual at the 2008 Big 12 Championship, earning All-Big 12 honors ■ Posted back-to-back top-10 finishes to open season, including a 2nd place showing at Hartford ■ Knee injury slowed him in the spring ■ Ranks third on team with 73.57 stroke average.

BEARS BATTLE CONDITIONS TO WIN AT HARTFORD

Baylor claimed its second tournament title in as many weeks after running away with the Hartford Hawks Invitational by a 10-stroke margin Sept. 30. It marked the second time the Bears won back-to-back tournaments under head coach **Greg Priest** (spring 2006). A day after carding a 4-under 284 as a team, Baylor shot a 6-under 282 to finish as the tournament's only team under par. **Colton Williams** fired back-to-back 70s to finish second overall at 4-under 140. **Bill Allcorn** finished tied for third at 3-under 141.

HOLDING A PAIR OF ACES

Junior **Colton Williams** and sophomore **Cody Paladino** have each carded a hole-in-one this season. Williams aced the par-3 No. 4 hole at Royal Oaks Country Club during the second round of the Baylor Intercollegiate in October. In March, Paladino aced the No. 2 hole at the University of Texas Golf Club during the first round of the Morris Williams Intercollegiate.

LAST TIME AT NCAA REGIONALS [2008]

COLUMBUS, Ohio - The Baylor men's golf team shot 323 in the final round to place 25th overall at the NCAA Central Regional on the Scarlet Course on the campus of Ohio State University. The Bears finished the tournament at 87-over par, and 38 shots back of the tenth and final qualifying position.

Wake Forest won the team championship, shooting 27-over par for the tournament to win by 10 strokes over Oklahoma State. Kevin Tway of Oklahoma State won the individual competition, finishing the three-day tournament at 1-over par.

Wes Williams led the way for the Bears in his final collegiate tournament. The senior shot 83 on the final day to finish at 20-over par in a tie for 96th overall. **Colton Williams** carded a 78 on Saturday to finish in a tie for 102nd at 21-over par.

Jeff Gerlich shot 84 on Saturday to finish at 23-over par in a tie for 115th overall. **Cody Paladino** shot his second-consecutive 81 in the third round to finish in a tie for 127th overall at 27-over par. **Bill Allcorn** finished the tournament at 28-over par after a third-round 81 on Saturday.

LAST TIME AT NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS [2002]

COLUMBUS, Ohio - Baylor's men's golf team shot even-par Saturday to finish 24-over and 19th at its first national championship appearance in the 2002 NCAA Men's Golf Championships at The Ohio State University Scarlet Course in Columbus, Ohio.

Sophomore **Adam Meyer** finished at one-over par and 27th among the 156 individuals competing at the finals to lead the Bears, ranked 20th in the nation prior to the tournament.

Led by junior **Jamie McLeary's** two-under 69 Saturday, the Bears shot a final-round 284 to climb six spots in the rankings. Baylor's even-par 284 was the fifth-lowest team total in the final round.

Meyer, a Waco native, hit five birdies in Saturday's final round and carded a one-under 70. His four round 285 placed him in a tie for 27th nationally.

Freshman **Ryan Baca** birdied two of the final four holes Saturday to total one-under and climb 26 spots in the final standings and finish in a tie for 51st. McLeary earned his 69 after shooting three birdies and one bogie in the final round. The Scotland native finished tied at 63rd at seven-over in the championships.

LAST TIME OUT [BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP]

HUTCHINSON, Kan. - For the second day in a row, Baylor senior **Bill Allcorn** shot an even-par 70 Wednesday, but he was unable to hold on to lead, finishing second overall at the 2009 Big 12 Men's Championship at Prairie Dunes.

Allcorn took an early two-stroke lead at Prairie Dunes after a birdie on the No. 6 hole. However, Oklahoma State's Morgan Hoffmann made a final-round surge, shooting 4-under on the day to win the individual conference title - three shots ahead of the second-place Allcorn. Allcorn finished at 1-under 279 for the tournament, posting Baylor's best individual performance at the Big 12 Championship since **Worth Williams** took home the title in 2001.

For his top-10 finish, Allcorn was named to the Big 12 All-Tournament Team. He becomes the eighth Baylor golfer to earn All-Tournament recognition and the program's 10th Big 12 All-Tournament honor.

For the second-straight season, Baylor finished fifth overall with a final tally of 54-over 1174, four shots behind fourth-place Kansas State (50-over 1170). Oklahoma State claimed the Big 12 title for the third consecutive season, finishing at 29-over 1149. Colorado came in second at 43-over 1163, followed by Texas A&M at 47-over 1167 in third place.
