Jay Goble is in his first year as head coach of Baylor's women's golf program after three seasons as the assistant coach at Southeastern Conference power Florida. Goble also previously served as an instructor at the prestigious IMG David Leadbetter Golf Academy in Bradenton, Fla.

Prior to coming to Baylor, Goble helped Florida to a 10th-place (tie) finish at the 2011 NCAA Women's Golf Championships in College Station, Texas. It marked the program's 18th top 10 national finish all-time, its highest since a ninth-place showing in 2008, and allowed the tradition-rich program a return to the national spotlight after missing the NCAA field the previous two seasons. Florida finished among the top 10 at nine of 12 tournaments it competed in during the 2010-11 season, including four top-10 finishes and a victory in its own 17-team SunTrust Gator Women's Golf Invitational.

The 2009-10 UF women's golf team claimed five top-five finishes and only finished outside of the top 10 in two of its 12 tournaments, thanks in part to Goble's coaching. The Gators claimed the team title at the Central District Invitational, marking their first tournament win in over a year, and posted a team stroke average of 75.7.

Goble's tenure at the David Leadbetter Golf Academy proved to be a valuable asset to the Florida program in recruiting, as five members of the Gators' 2010-11 roster attended the Academy. He mentored All-American and All-SEC selection Jessica Yadloczky and All-SEC freshman team member Evan Jensen.

In addition to his UF coaching duties, Goble served as the Junior Golf Academy Director for the Gators' program. In this role, he helped make the junior golf academies among the nation's finest.

Goble, who worked at Leadbetter from 2004 until joining the UF staff on July 1, 2008, has also served as Golf Professional at The Club at Olde Cypress in Naples, Fla., and The Preserve Golf Club in Bradenton, Fla.

A four-year scholarship player at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte from 1996 to 2000, Goble played on numerous professional tours throughout the Southeast United States as well as U.S. Open qualifiers. In 2003, Goble claimed a 72-stroke scoring average in the Southwest Florida chapter of the PGA.

The Charlotte, N.C., native is married to the former Jamie Lowe, and the couple has an infant son, Gannon.

After wrapping up one of the finest careers in Lady Vols golf history, Cantú served as a student assistant at Tennessee for a portion of the 2010-11 season. She was a four-time SEC Academic Honor Roll member and a two-time second-team All-SEC performer.

She capped her career by earning 2009-10 All-SEC and NCAA East All-Region honors as a senior. A member of three NCAA Championship squads at Tennessee, the Monterrey, Mexico, native ranks eighth in UT history in stroke average (76.16) and second in career rounds played (130). PRICE'S "GIVE 'EM FIVE" INTERCOLLEGIATE

Baylor women's golfer **Lene Hafsten-Morch** tied a two-day-old 18-hole school record, shooting a final-round 7-under 65, to win the 2010 Price's "Give 'Em Five" Intercollegiate at NMSU Golf Course.

After owning at least a share of the lead through 36 holes, the Lady Bears (285-295-291=871) finished second at 7-over, five strokes behind host and winner New Mexico State (289-291-286=866). Mississippi State (297-291-295=883) and UTEP (295-292-296=883) tied for third, while North Texas (296-292-300=888) finished fifth. Baylor posted its ninth top-five finish in 11 appearances at the Price's "Give 'Em Five" Intercollegiate.

Hafsten-Morch netted her career-first collegiate victory, finishing the tournament with a school-record 7-under 209 (71-73-65). The Billingstad, Norway, native bested the previous school record of 210 held by four golfers — Josefin Svenningsson (2003 adidas Fall Invitational, 2005 Ptarmigan Ram Fall Classic), Sian Reddick (2005 Ptarmigan Ram Fall Classic) and Anna Rehnholm (2007 Susie Maxwell-Berning Classic).

On the first day, teammate **Jaclyn Jansen** shattered the then-school record with an opening-round 65, breaking the previous mark of 67 held by four golfers — one of which was Hafsten-Morch at the 2008 Ptarmigan Ram Fall Classic. Jansen finished five strokes behind Hafsten-Morch in a three-way tie for second at 2-under 214

The Lady Bears finished the tournament at 39-over 903, two strokes behind 10th-place UTSA. Coastal Carolina won the tournament by one stroke, finishing with a 3-over 867, ahead of No. 14 Tulane (4-over 868) and No. 37 Minnesota (5-over 869).

The Lady Bears finished ahead of No. 31 Ole Miss and No. 47 East Carolina. Kentucky's Ashleigh Albrecht and Minnesota's Teresa Puga shared individual medalist honors as both finished the tournament at 8-under 208.

Chelsey Cothran posted her best finish of the season to that point, tying for 11th place at 1-over 217. Fellow junior **Jaclyn Jansen** was Baylor's other top-25 finisher with a final tally of 5-over 221, good for a 22nd place tie.

BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP

April 22-24, 2011 — Columbia, Mo. (The Club at Old Hawthorne)

Baylor junior golfer **Jaclyn Jansen** posted her fifth career top-10 finish, tying for fifth place on the final day of the 2011 Big 12 Women's Golf Championship.

Baylor finished eighth overall, shooting a three-day score of 36-over-par (301-294-305=900), which set the program 54-hole low at the Big 12 Championship (previous was 914 in 2005). No. 20 Texas held off No. 27 Texas A&M to win the Big 12 title, shooting 8-over 872, while the Aggies finished at 11-over 875. Host Missouri came in third at 16-over 880, followed by No. 15 Iowa State and No. 28 Oklahoma.

Jansen, who entered the day tied for second, shot a final-round 73 to tie with Texas A&M's Sarah Zwartynski. The Effingham, Ill., native was as low as 2-under-par for the day through 13 holes, but she bogeyed three of her final five holes to finish with a 73. The sixth-place finish earned Jansen a selection to the Big 12 All-Tournament Team. Jansen became the 12th Big 12 All-Tournament selection in program history, while her even-par 216 set a Baylor 54-hole low for the Big 12 Championship, besting Hannah Burke's 218 in 2010.

Plagued by double-bogeys each of the first two days, Cothran avoided big numbers on the front nine. She managed four bogeys on the final nine holes to finish the final round with a 78.
