Band

Please ask your band director to contact the Assistant Director of Bands, Dave Healey (617.552.2065), if your band is planning on attending. Also, please indicate on the **Visiting Team Questionnaire** that is included with this guide that the band will be coming to Boston College. To gain access to the stadium, the band must enter at the southwest corner of the stadium through **GATE A** and must have a ticket to the game (See map on page 19). Unfortunately, due to time constraints, field access is not permitted for visiting bands.

Please note the following:

- 1) **Tickets for your school's band must be taken from part of your team's overall ticket allotment and will be limited to 50 band members.**
- 2) **Due to the close proximity of the visiting band seating to our fans, electronic amplification is not permitted at any time.**
- 3) **Boston College will not provide parking permits for the band as outlined on page 4.**

Cheerleaders & Mascot

Specific areas will be designated for this group in Alumni Stadium. To gain access to the stadium, the cheerleaders and mascot need to enter the southwest corner of the stadium through **Gate A (Beacon St.)** in uniform (See map on page 19). In addition, Boston College will provide a credential, upon request, for the Cheer Team Coordinator and/or one additional credential for a visiting team mascot escort. **However, Boston College will not provide any additional parking permits for this group.** Parking for cheerleaders/mascots is included in the parking permit allocation outlined on page 4. Please note the ACC restricts the visiting team cheerleading travel party to 12 members.



VISITING TEAM INFORMATION

Credentials, Parking Permits & Tickets

In compliance with Conference policy, the following credentials and parking permits will be sent to your Athletic Director by August 20th 2009:

Credentials:

- Sixty (60) Visiting Team Bench Area (V-Inside the 25-yard lines)
 - No one under the age of 16 years old may receive a credential
- Eight (8) All Access Credentials (AA)
 - Please provide the names to Boston College on the enclosed “**Visiting Team Questionnaire**”
 - This includes 2 passes for your Media Relations staff
- Eight (8) Visiting Team Coaches’ Box (5J)
 - Provides access to the fifth floor press box
- Four (4) Video Personnel (O)

Please note that all individuals issued visiting team bench passes must remain inside the team bench area. All guests with visiting team bench passes outside of this area will be directed back to the bench area by stadium security.

Visiting team administrative staff may enter Alumni Stadium with proper credentials with the visiting team travel party. Working staff may not escort family members or guests into the stadium, they must be ticketed. Visiting Team ticketed family members and guests should enter through the gate location posted on their ticket.

Parking: Located in Conte Loop off of the Beacon St. entrance **(Space is Limited and will be Strictly Enforced)**

Four (4) Bus Parking Permits

NOTE: additional bus parking is NOT allowed for team, band or cheerleaders

One (1) Equipment Truck Parking Permit

One (1) Van Parking Permit

Six (6) Reserved Parking Permits* - sent to Visiting Team Athletic Directors

***NOTE:** The Reserved Parking Permits are for **Passenger Vehicles Only**, and are in a “**No Tailgating**” zone. Any bus, RV, limousine, etc. that arrives at the gate with one of the aforementioned passes will be immediately denied access to the parking area and will be directed to a satellite parking location.

VISITING TEAM INFORMATION

Emergency Situation

Upon notification of a potential emergency situation (bomb threat, hazardous weather or fire emergency) the Boston College Emergency Response Team shall meet at a pre determined location and determine whether the potential situation merits evacuation of the facility.

In the event of an Alumni Stadium/Conte Forum evacuation; Team Personnel and Game Officials will be escorted by their BCPD representative immediately to the Gate A exit and board awaiting visiting team buses. The buses shall be directed and escorted by Boston College Police to a pre-determined, off-site location, Upper Campus Campion Gate or Brighton Campus, to await further instructions by BCPD. An evacuation does not allow time for the individuals listed above to return to the locker rooms prior to boarding the buses.

Locker Room Facilities (Visiting Team)

The visiting team locker room is located in the Conte Forum skate lobby and quadrants A, B, C, D, and O. Two Team Ops Event Staff members and one BCPD officer are posted at access points. Event Staff report 5 hours prior to kick off and remain in place through 90 minutes post game. Two BCPD officers report to the Visiting Team Locker Room 3 hours prior to kick off to check in with the visiting team representative to address any specific concerns for the day. Boston College will provide all Visiting Teams with over 2,500 square feet of locker room space including the following accommodations:

- **60 full size lockers** with two large shower/bathroom facilities at either end of the area
- A separate, private room for coaches/staff equipped with **19 full size lockers**
- An additional auxiliary room equipped with **2 showers, 1 bathroom and 4 full size lockers**

Video Personnel

Alumni Stadium is set-up to accommodate video personnel from two covered locations. The stadium has room for a sideline angle on the 5th floor of the Press box, and an end zone angle, in which your camera is located at the top of **Section KK** in the stadium’s upper south end zone seating area. There is room for 3 personnel and 2 cameras for the visiting team in this location. Individuals who will be working in these areas are required to display the proper credential distributed by Boston College’s game management team. Visiting Athletic Director's Suite

The Visiting Athletic Director's Suite (Box 603) is located on the Northwest side of the stadium on the 6th floor of the Press Box. Boston College will provide a visiting team escort to navigate Alumni Stadium and Conte Forum. Please contact Beth Mahoney (617.552.4680) or via email (mahonebe@bc.edu) to coordinate your athletic director's escort. Below are directions to the Athletic Director's Suite.

From the South Side of the Building – Beacon St. (Visiting Team Entrance/Locker Room)

- Enter under red awning, through single set of glass doors closest to the Conte Forum South Main Entrance, between gates A and B
- Take the elevator to the 3rd floor
- Take a left out of the elevator and follow the hallway across the catwalk
- At the end of the catwalk go through a set of doors. Elevator will be on your left, take it to the 6th floor
- Take a left out of the elevator and go straight through two sets of doors
- Suite 603 is the Visiting Team Athletic Director's Box (3 doors in on the left)

From the North Side of the Building

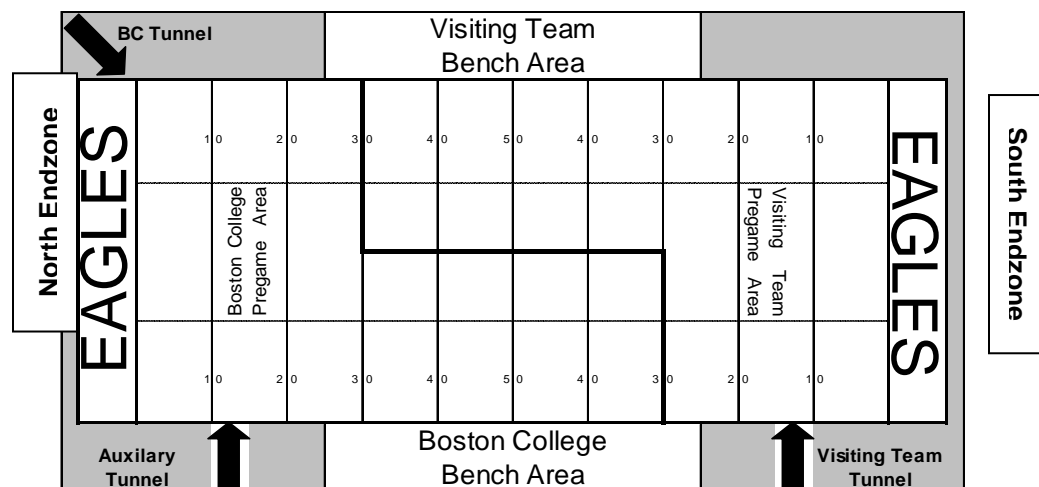
- Enter via the North Entrance located to the far right of Gate D
- Take the elevator to the 6th Floor
- Box 603 is the third door on your LEFT

Visiting Coaches' Box

The Visiting Coaches' box (Box 5J) is located on the West side of the stadium on the 5th floor of the Press Box. In accordance with Conference Policy, Visiting Team coaches will be escorted to and from the coaches' box pre-game, at halftime, and post-game by a member of the Boston College Police Department. Please contact Dan Donovan (617.552.8421) in Boston College's division of Network Services with your team's dry line and telecommunication needs. Elevators are held 3 minutes prior to the end of each half and will be restricted for exclusive use of the coaches.

Visiting Team Bench and Pre-game Warm-up Area

The Visiting Team bench is located on the East/Shea Field side of Alumni Stadium. Your pre-game practice area is shown on the following diagram. The field will be divided into 70-yard/30-yard segments until 45 minutes before game time. At that point, the field will be re-divided into 50-yard/50-yard segments up until the 22-minute mark on the game clock, when the field will clear.

DIRECTIONS FROM GATE A (Visiting Team Locker Room)

1. Take a LEFT onto Beacon St.
2. Take your first LEFT onto St. Thomas More Road.
3. Go straight through the stoplight on Commonwealth Avenue onto Lake Street.
4. Take a RIGHT onto Washington St.
5. Follow Washington St. going straight through two traffic lights.
6. Approaching the third light, you will see the Medical Center in front of you on the right.

EMERGENCY ENTRANCE

1. Go straight at the third light, drive past the Medical Center (on your right).
2. Turn RIGHT at the next light (Warren St.) and follow signs for the Emergency Room.

MAIN ENTRANCE

1. Go straight at the third light, drive past the Medical Center (on your right).
2. Turn RIGHT at the next light (Warren St.) and the main drive will be your first right.

MBTA MAP



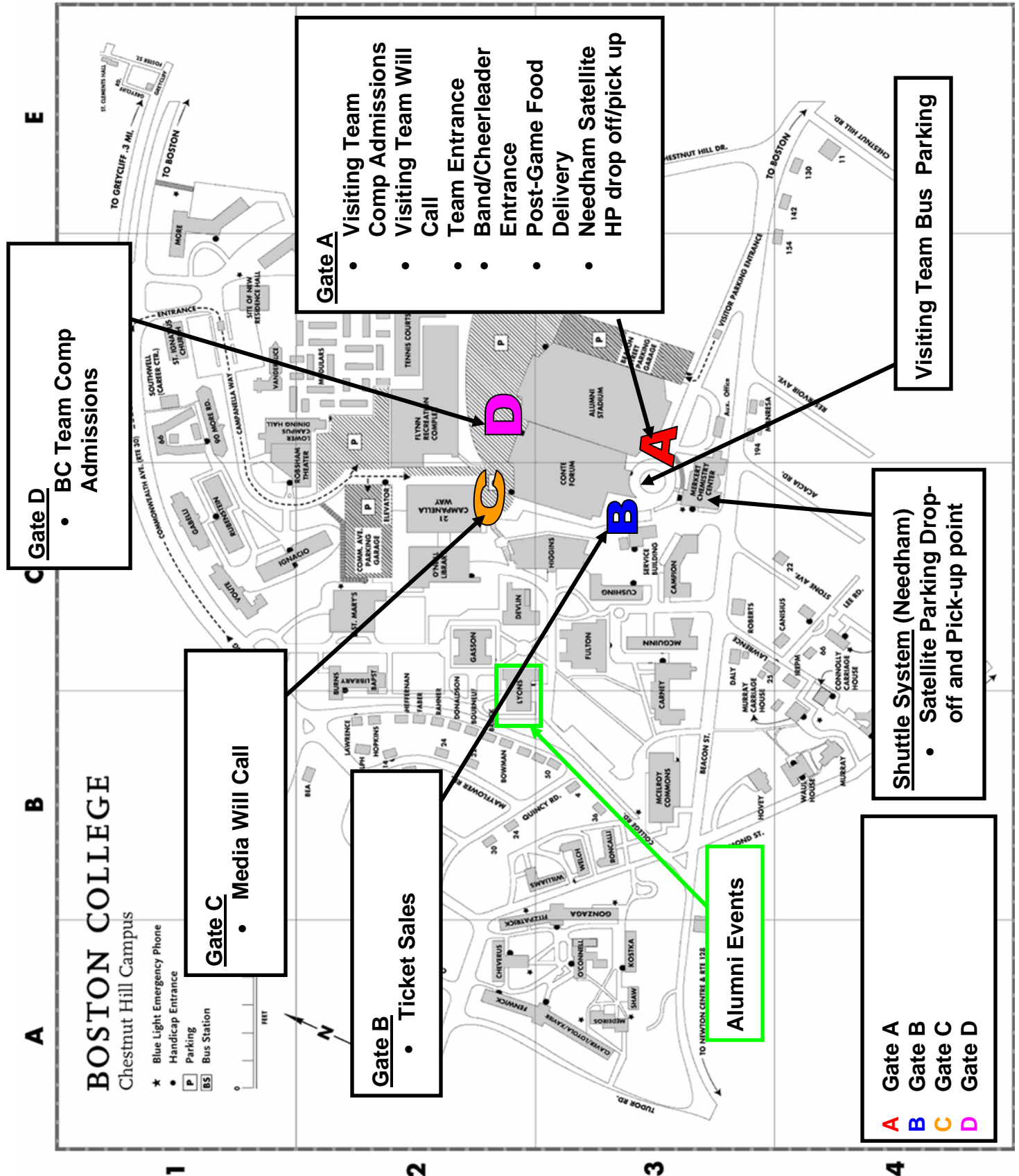
MASSACHUSETTS BAY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY RAPID TRANSIT MAP

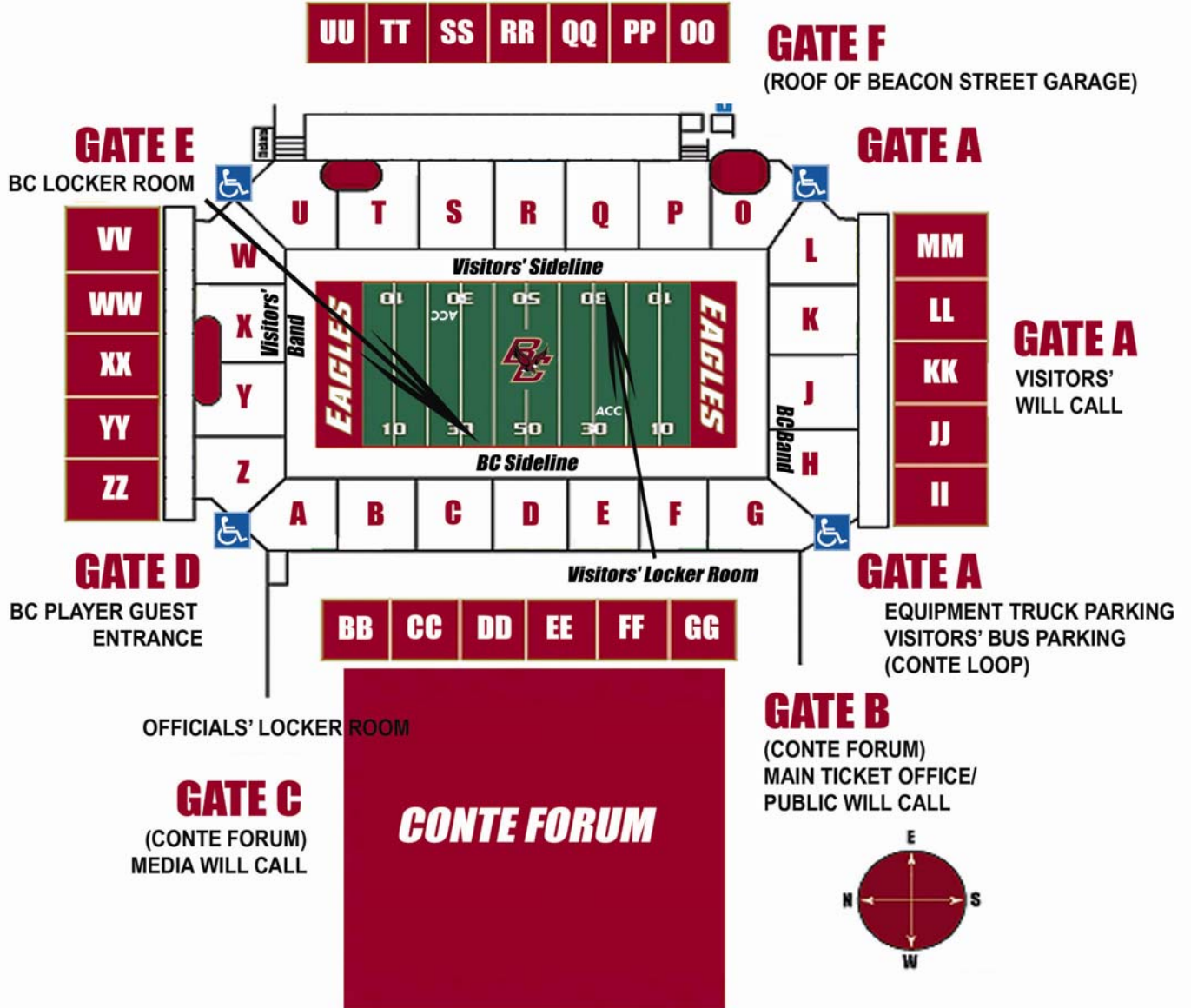


BOSTON COLLEGE CAMPUS MAP

DIRECTIONS TO ALUMNI STADIUM

FROM POINTS NORTH AND SOUTH:

1. Take Interstate 95 (Route 128) to Exit 24 (Route 30).
2. Proceed east on Route 30, also known as Commonwealth Avenue, and follow for about five miles to Boston College.
3. Enter BC at the second entrance on the right, at St. Ignatius Church, and then bear left down St. Thomas More Drive.
4. Follow St. Thomas More Drive until you reach Beacon Street and go right.
5. Traveling on Beacon Street, take your first right and proceed to the Conte Loop area.

FROM POINTS WEST:

1. Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) to Exit 17.
2. At the first set of lights off the exit ramp, take a right onto Centre Street.
3. Follow Centre Street to the fourth set of lights, and turn left onto Commonwealth Avenue.
4. Follow Commonwealth Avenue 1-1/2 miles to Boston College.
5. Enter BC at the second entrance on the right, at St. Ignatius Church, and then bear left down St. Thomas More Drive.
6. Follow St. Thomas More Drive until you reach Beacon Street and go right.
7. Traveling on Beacon Street, take your first right and proceed to the Conte Loop area.

FROM DOWNTOWN BOSTON:

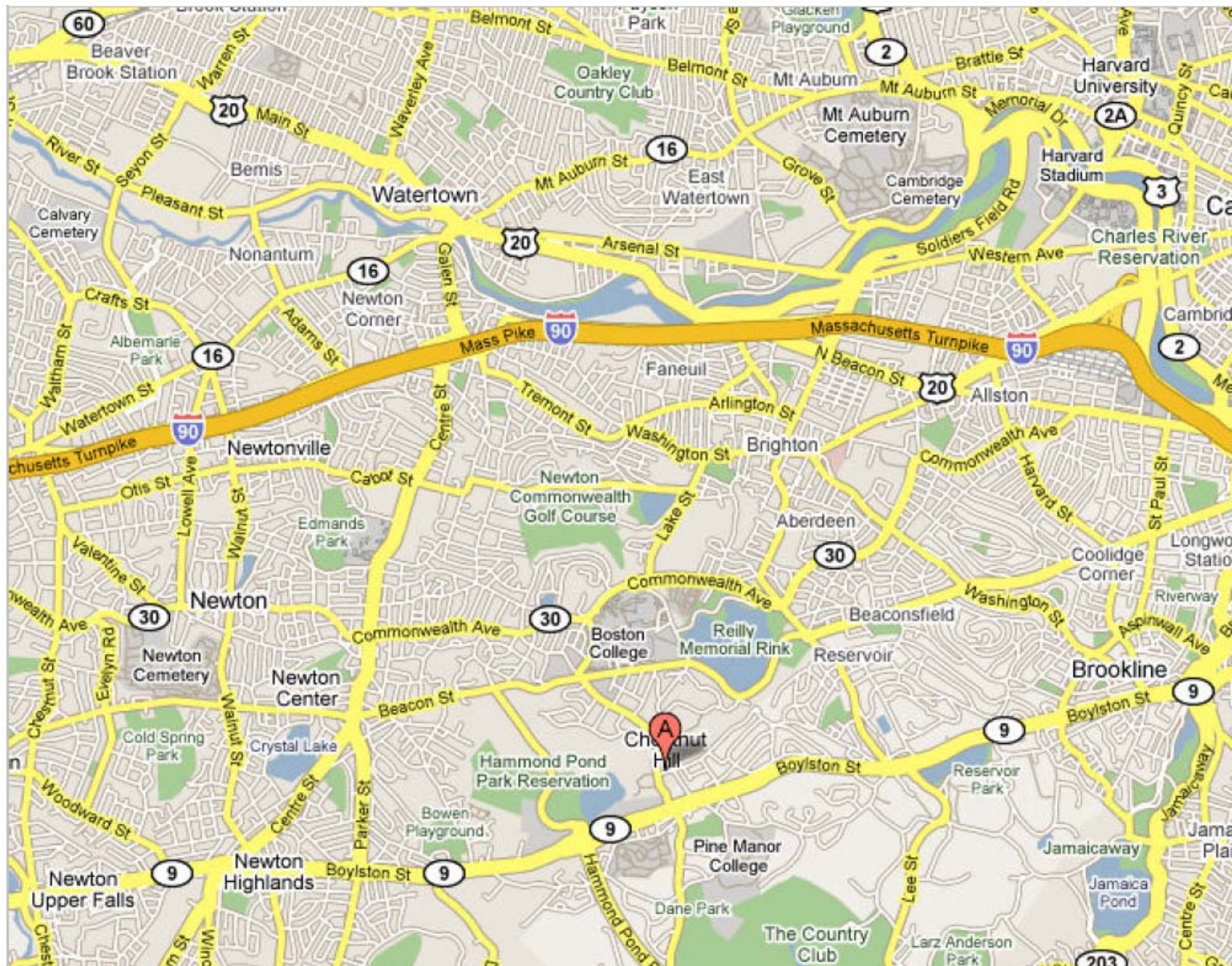
1. Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (Interstate 90) to Exit 17.
2. Take a left over the bridge after passing the Sheraton Tara Hotel.
3. Take the first right onto Centre Street.
4. Follow Centre Street to the fourth set of lights, and turn left onto Commonwealth Avenue.
5. Follow Commonwealth Avenue 1-1/2 miles to Boston College.
6. Enter BC at the second entrance on the right, at St. Ignatius Church, and then bear left down St. Thomas More Drive.
7. Follow St. Thomas More Drive until you reach Beacon Street and go right.
8. Traveling on Beacon Street, take your first right and proceed to the Conte Loop area.

FROM LOGAN AIRPORT:

1. Follow signs to I-90 via the Williams Tunnel (Toll).
2. Take the Massachusetts Turnpike (I-90) to Exit 17.
3. Take a left over the bridge after passing the Sheraton Tara Hotel.
4. Take the first right onto Centre Street.
5. Follow Centre Street to the fourth set of lights, and turn left onto Commonwealth Avenue.
6. Follow Commonwealth Avenue 1-1/2 miles to Boston College.
7. Enter BC at the second entrance on the right, at St. Ignatius Church, and then bear left down St. Thomas More Drive.
8. Follow St. Thomas More Drive until you reach Beacon Street and go right.
9. Traveling on Beacon Street, take your first right and proceed to the Conte Loop area.
