Ashley Obrest Head Coach

After graduating from Boston College in 2007, Obrest served as the assistant coach at Concordia University Chicago for one season. Following a one-year stint as the assistant coach at Concordia, Obrest then moved on to Colgate University where she served as the assistant coach for two years before being promoted to the head coach in July 2010. The 2011 season saw the Elmwood Park, Ill. native set a school record for most wins by a first year head coach (27) and led the Raiders to a regular season Patriot League title with a 16-3 conference mark.



Erica Hanrahan Assistant Coach

Hanrahan pitched for Saint Peter's College in New Jersey and after graduation became a graduate assistant at her alma Mater, responsible for pitching and outfield instruction. She coached the Elmwood Park High School varsity team for the past 10 seasons. She led the team to record-breaking seasons, including tallying the top three win totals in school history. The Tigers also advanced to the Elite 8 in the state playoffs twice and won two sectional and six regional championships. Hanrahan was named Sectional Coach of the Year in 2009 and 2011.
