**NOTE:** All prospective student-athletes (High School, 2-year, 4-year, Domestic and Foreign) entering an NCAA Division I or II institution for the first time on or after August 1, 2007 must complete.

## **DIVISION I REQUIREMENTS to be a QUALIFIER**

- Graduate from High School
- Complete 16 core courses:
  - 4 years of English
  - 3 years of mathematics (Algebra or higher)
  - 2 years of natural/physical science (1 year of lab if offered by H.S.)
  - 1 year of additional courses English, mathematics or natural/physical science
  - 2 years of social science
- 4 years of additional courses (from any area above, foreign language or non-doctrinal religion/philosophy)

## **GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA) & TEST SCORE REQUIREMENTS**

- Division I has a sliding scale for both test scores and GPA's.
- Only your core courses are calculated in the GPA.
- Be sure your H.S. completes the 48-H on all approved core courses.
- SAT scores are calculated by the critical reading and math sections.
- ACT scores are calculated by the sum of all four sections (English, Math, Reading and Science).
- Have all scores sent to the NCAA Eligibility Center by the testing agency. Test scores that are placed on the transcript will not be accepted. Eligibility Center Code 9999.
