Game One vs. **ALABAMA STATE**

September 06, 2008 at Daytona Beach, FL

Daytona Beach, Fla. - Daytona Beach, Fla. - The Wildcats 2008 home opener was a success with a 28-7 victory over Alabama State (0-2) of the SWAC. B-CU dominated the stats outgaining the Hornets 370 (225 yards rushing, 145 passing) to 171 in total offense.

SUMLAR KEYS B-CU OFFENSE – WILDCATS LEAD 14-7 AT HALFTIME

Sophomore running back Brian Sumlar led the offense with 114 yards rushing on 22 carries and two touchdowns. X-Receiver Joe Singleton (Sr.) caught seven passes for 94 yards and one touchdown (a 19-yard pass from Sr. QB McKinson Souverain, in the second quarter).

QBs Souverain (8-4-0, 51 passing yards and 43 yards rushing on 7 attempts) and Jr. Matthew Johnson (12-9-0, 94 passing yards and 29 yards rushing) split time running B-CU's "Wyattbone" offense.

DEFENSE PITCHES SECOND HALF SHUTOUT – SUMLAR 2 TD RUNS IN SECOND HALF

The B-CU defense picked off three ASU passes and limited the Hornets to only ten first downs and 46 rushing yards in the contest played before sunny skies and low-to-mid 90 degree temps in Central Florida.

The Wildcats led 14-7 at halftime, and two Brian Sumlar touchdown runs, one in the third quarter and one fourth quarter jaunt to seal the victory before 8,172 fans at Municipal Stadium. In the ball game. The Wildcats outgained Alabama state 370-171 with 225 yards on the ground for the winners.

Game Two at **SOUTH CAROLINA STATE**

September 13, 2008 at Charleston, SC

Charleston, S.C. - South Carolina State (2-1, 1-0) beat Bethune-Cookman (1-1, 0-1) 28-19, in the 2008 MEAC football opener for both teams.

All-MEAC RB William Ford rushed for 175 yards and two touchdowns to key the Bulldogs offense (275 yards rushing, 486 total yards) in the win.

ANTONIO COX LONG INTERCEPTION RETURN FOR TD – TIES UP HALFTIME SCORE AT 7-7

In a game that the B-CU offense struggled in the first 30 minutes,, 'Cats DB Antonio Cox returned an interception 93 yards for a touchdown late in the second quarter to tie the score 7-7, at halftime.

WILDCATS USE THREE QB'S – JOHNSON'S TD STRIKE TIES GAME AT 14-14

Matthew Johnson started at QB for the Wildcats with McKinson Souverain a game time decision and not able to start for B-CU. Johnson threw for two touchdowns and totaled 155 yards in offense. Souverain played briefly when Johnson was injured during the game and third QB Devin Bradley also played two series for the Wildcats.

South Carolina State went ahead 14-7 in the third quarter before Johnson's 31 yard touchdown pass to Jean-Gardy Fanor (So. WR) cut the deficit to 14-13, Freshman PK Matt McCutcheon missed the extra point.

MEAC CHAMPION SCSU CLOSES STRONG- HOLDS OFF 'CATS FOR 28-19 WIN

SCSU scored two straight TDs to go up 28-13 in the fourth quarter and Johnson's 21 yard TD pass to Joe Singleton closed the scoring (28-19) with 3:20 remaining. B-CU missed a two-point conversion attempt and the Bulldogs recovered an on-side kick and ran out the clock.

Game Three vs SAVANNAH STATE

September 20, 2008 at Daytona Beach, FL

Daytona Beach, Fla. Freshman quarterback Maurice Francois (Palm Bay, Fla./Bayside HS), playing in his first collegiate game for B-CU, led a dominant Wildcat offense with the team gaining 412 yards on the ground in a 34-9 win over Savannah State University Saturday at Municipal Stadium.

FRANCOIS' FIRST COLLEGIATE START A DANDY

Francois rushed 20 times for 121 yards and led the Wildcats on two long scoring drives in the first half to put B-CU ahead 14-3 at halftime. With top two QBs McKinson Souverain and Matthew Johnson not at full strength, B-CU coach Alvin Wyatt turned to Francois for the start. Soph. RB Brian Sumlar rushed for 91 yards and two TDs, Soph. RB Androse Bell ran 13 times for 90 yards and a score, and Phillip Kirkland (60 yards and a TD) and Fred McCaskill (34 yards and a touchdown) all contributed to the season-high 412 yards rushing attack.

B-CU DEFENSE BOTTLES UP TIGERS - NO OFFENSIVE TDS ALLOWED IN WIN

B-CU's defense held Savannah State (2-2) to only 43 yards rushing on 24 carries and 210 yards of total offense in the non-conference victory. DB Brent Davis had an interception and registered 5 tackles for the Wildcats (2-1, 0-1, MEAC). Sr. Safety Travis Roland led the defense with 8 tackles (4 solo) and had two tackles for losses.

Bethune-Cookman scored two touchdowns in the third quarter to open up a 27-3 margin after three quarters in a game played with first half rains and cloudy skies throughout.

B-CU dominated the time of possession controlling the ball with 76 offensive plays to 46 for the Tigers of SSU and a 38:18 to 21:42 margin in the contest. The Wildcats passed the ball only 6 times, completing one pass for -2 yards.

Game Four vs **NORFOLK STATE**

September 27, 2008 at Daytona Beach, FL

Daytona Beach, Fla. - Bethune-Cookman University (3-1, 1-1, MEAC) beat Norfolk State University (2-3, 1-1, MEAC) 33-17, Saturday at Municipal Stadium with freshman QB Maurice Francois rushing for 179 yards and one touchdown on 16 carries to lead the B-CU offense.

FRANCOIS STARS AGAIN – MEAC ROOKIE AND PLAYER OF THE WEEK PERFORMANCE

Francois came into the game late in the first quarter in relief of starting QB McKinson Souverain, and for the second straight game - he keyed the "Wyattbone" offense to big yardage. B-CU rushed for 300 yards in the win (The Wildcats rushed for 412 yards last week vs. Savannah State).

"I went in thinking, if I do get a chance to play, I will do my best to help us win," said Francois. "I was ready from the first play and when he (Coach Wyatt) put me in - I was ready to play. It's a MEAC game, a conference game and we had to win this game. We had to play our game, play our way. I am making it hard (on the other QBs) to get the position back," said Francois following the win vs. Norfolk State. "Our O-line worked hard and I was just reading it, hitting the whole."

B-CU trailed 14-13 at halftime and a Brian Sumlar touchdown run in the third quarter gave the Wildcats the lead for good at 19-14 with 8 minutes remaining in the third. Matt McCutcheon's extra point was blocked (two B-CU extra points were blocked in the contest).

712 RUSHING YARDS TOTAL IN THE LAST TWO GAMES FOR WILDCATS

Bethune-Cookman Head Coach Alvin Wyatt praised his freshman quarterback, "He (Francois) was exceptional. He was ready to go. He made the correct checks and he hung in there tough," said Wyatt.

Coach Wyatt also said the defense which limited Norfolk State to 17 points - was instrumental too in the win. "Today, we shut them down when we had to. The defensive stop on the first possession of the second half was huge," said Wyatt. "That got the defense propelled in the right direction."

DEFENSE HOLDS SPARTANS OUT OF THE END ZONE AND THREE SECOND HALF POINTS

Defensive backs Travis Roland (47 yards) and Antonio Cox (35 yards) each had long interception returns to stop NSU drives in the second half. Kendrick Odom led B-CU with nine tackles and Roland contributed seven stops.

Sophomore RB Sumlar had three touchdown runs and 64 yards rushing on 16 carries to compliment Francois' efforts on offense. B-CU passed the ball only three times completing one pass. (Souverain to Jean Gardy-Fanor for 16 yards)

October 4, 2008 at Baltimore, MD

BIG PLAYS KEY 'CATS 31-27 ROAD WIN AT MORGAN STATE

In a wild MEAC game at Hughes Stadium, Bethune-Cookman (4-1, 2-1 MEAC) held on for a 31-27 road win at Morgan State (2-3, 1-1 MEAC). B-CU's defense held the Bears on a final minute drive to preserve the victory. The game was highlighted by a number of big plays by both teams. There was no scoring in the fourth quarter.

THIRD QUARTER SCORING SPREE ENDS WITH B-CU LEADING 31-27

Jr. WR Phillip Kirkland raced 82 yards for a touchdown after catching a short crossing pattern pass from Maurice Francois to give the Wildcats a 31-21 lead with 5:55 to play in the third quarter.

Sr. DB Travis Roland stripped the football from MSU's QB Carleton Jackson and ran 25 yards with the fumble for a touchdown to give B-CU a 24-13 lead in the third quarter.

MSU cut the margin to 24-21 with a touchdown pass and a two-point conversion pass by Jackson with 7:03 remaining in the third quarter.

WILDCATS LEAD 14-0 EARLY

Jr. CB Antwane Cox' interception set up B-CU's first scoring drive in the opening quarter, a 52 yard-7 play drive, capped by Brian Sumlar's 9 yard TD run.

A Wildcat defensive stop keyed by a sack from So. DL Mike London and a 17 yard punt return by Sr. RB Corey Council set up B-CU's second scoring drive in the first quarter. Bethune-Cookman went ahead 14-0 on Council's 24 yard TD run with 4 minutes left in the quarter. The score was 14-0 at the end of the first quarter. Freshman QB Maurice Francois led the Wildcats to 68 rushing yards in the first 15 minutes.

An early second quarter Wildcat defensive stop inside the red zone kept B-CU's lead at 14-0. Jr. S Antonio Cox broke up a fourth down Morgan State pass in the end zone to keep the margin at two touchdowns.

Morgan State utilized a 25 yard punt return to set up its first touchdown drive with the Bears moving 35 yards in three plays to get within 14-7 at the 10 minute mark of the second quarter.

B-CU's freshman PK Matt McCutcheon, kicked his first collegiate field goal, a 30-yarder to give the Wildcats a 17-7 lead with five minutes remaining in the first half. The six minute scoring drive was highlighted by 71 yards rushing on 10 carries with QBs Francois and senior McKinson Souverain both taking snaps.

DAYTONA BEACH, Fla. - Delaware State got out to a fast start with 26 first half points and held on to beat Bethune-Cookman 26-20, Saturday at Municipal Stadium. DSU Sr. QB Vason Winton accounted for 249 yards of total offense (147 passing, 102 rushing) and three touchdowns in the MEAC road win.

Bethune-Cookman (4-2, 2-2, MEAC) had its three-game winning streak snapped by the Hornets before 9,136 fans attending the 2008 Homecoming game. B-CU trailed at halftime 26-13 and the two teams were scoreless in the third quarter.

WILDCATS USE THREE QB'S - FRANCOIS INJURED

So. QB Matthew Johnson (B-CU's third quarterback who played Saturday) threw a 43 yard touchdown pass to Jr. WR Jeff Pope with 2:42 remaining in the game to put the Wildcats within 26-20.

A Bethune-Cookman's on-side kick was recovered by Delaware State (2-3, 2-1, MEAC) and the Hornets ran out the clock for the victory.

The Wildcats, the top ranked rushing team in the MEAC averaging over 250 yards a game, were limited to 141 yards rushing on 39 carries with So. RB Brian Sumlar leading the B-CU rushers with 65 yards on 14 carries

Freshman QB Maurice Francois was held to 38 yards rushing on 9 rushes and he passed for 82 yards hitting on five of nine passes. Sr. QB McKinson Souverain ran for 23 yards and passed for another 48 yards (8-4-1) as B-CU used three QBs in the game and it is to be determined about Francois' injury (shoulder) suffered in the second half.

October 24, 2008 at Winston-Salem, NC

FIRST QUARTER-RAMS JUMP OUT TO 6-0 LEAD AFTER ONE QUARTER

Starting QB McKinson Souverain led the Wildcats on their opening drive of the game going 55 yards (30 yards rushing by RB Brian Sumlar) before being stopped on downs at the Winston-Salem State 32 yard line.

WSSU marched down the field after stopping the Wildcats and scored on a one yard touchdown run with the drive totaling 68 yards. The Rams missed the extra point.

SECOND QUARTER-SCORELESS SECOND QUARTER - WSSU LEADS 6-0 AT HALFTIME

Souverain fumbled at the Ram 40 yard line and the WSSU drive was stopped by Travis Roland's forced fumble and fumble recovery five plays later at mid-field.

BCU's Antonio Cox blocked a Rams' 42-yard FG attempt with 1:37 remaining in the half. Both teams struggled offensively in the second quarter. The Wildcats used two QBs with Matthew Johnson and Souverain both playing in the second 15 minutes.

THIRD QUARTER-SUMLAR'S 41 YARD TD RUN TO OPEN THE SECOND HALF TIES GAME AT 6-6

Sophomore RB Brian Sumlar tied the game with a touchdown run, capping a 65 yard B-CU drive to open the second half - Matt McCutcheon missed the extra point.

The Wildcat defense stopped WSSU on three straight drives and the remainder of the third quarter was played with teams exchanging punts. The quarter ended with Corey Council's 12 yard punt return putting the 'Cats in good scoring position to the WSSU 42 yard line.

FOURTH QUARTER - 21 FOURTH QUARTER POINTS PUTS GAME AWAY WILDCAT DEFENSE, SPECIAL TEAMS AND SOUVERAIN'S THREE TD RUNS KEY 4TH QUARTER SPREE

McKinson Souverain's 6-yard touchdown run with 13:22 to play and McCutcheon's extra point put the Wildcats ahead to stay 13-6.

Stephen Bertholot's blocked punt set up the 'Cats next scoring drive of eight yards with Souverain scoring on a two yard run with 9:57 left in the game.

Another defensive stop and a 15 yard punt return by Corey Council led to another Souverain TD run with 4:37 to play to put B-CU up 27-6. Souverain finished the game with 79 yards rushing on 17 carries and Sumlar led all rushers in the game with 96 yards on 13 attempts. B-CU totaled 249 yards rushing and registered 337 yards in total offense. WSSU was held to 187 yards (112 rushing, 75 passing) and the Rams dropped to 1-6 overall in 2008.

Travis Roland led the B-CU defense with 9 tackles (8 solo, 3 QBs sacks and four tackles for losses). The senior defensive leader also forced a fumble and recovered a fumble and broke up one pass as the Wildcats held WSSU scoreless in the second half and to only 47 yards of offense in the game.

WILDCATS BEAT NORTH CAROLINA A & T 24-14, UP RECORD TO 6-2, 3-2 MEAC

The Aggies of NC A & T gave the Wildcats all they could handle - leading 7-0 early, and closing to only three points down (17-14) entering the fourth quarter. B-CU put together two solid drives eating up the clock for most of the fourth quarter to preserve the hard-fought home conference win 24-14.

Sr. QB McKinson Souverain rushed for two touchdowns, including a spectacular 27 yard TD run down the sidelines in the third quarter to give the "Cats a 17-7 lead with 11:52 left in quarter. Souverain led the team with 120 yards rushing on 27 carries and he passed for another 140 yards (12-7-1) -totaling 260 yards of total offense in the victory. Sophomore RB Brian Sumlar rushed 22 times for 97 yards with the MEAC's top rushing team executing the "Wyattbone" offense, for a team total of 222 yards in the contest.

B-CU DEFENSE LIMITS AGGIES TO 163 YARDS OF TOTAL OFFENSE

The Wildcats defense was stingy again for most of the game limiting NC A & T (3-6, 1-5) to 103 yards rushing and only 60 yards passing (163 total yards). The Aggies second scoring drive to make the score 17-14 late in the third quarter, was only three yards after a B-CU fumble and a Aggie 15-yard fumble recovery to the three yard line. Last week at Winston-Salem State, and also in the second half of the Oct. 11 Delaware State game, the B-CU defense registered back-to-back second half shutouts. Travis Roland and Josh Smiley had 10 tackles each to lead the defense who had nine tackles for losses (-33 yards) and three QB sacks (-19 yards).

THE WILDCATS BEAT HAMPTON 17-6 - COACH WYATT SETS THE B-CU ALL-TIME WINS MARK WITH 84.

The Wildcat defense was tested early when Corey Council fumbled on the opening kickoff return giving the Pirates the ball on the B-CU 25. Travis Roland's QB sack ended the first drive of the game and Hampton punted.

Senior QB McKinson Souverain hit Jeff Pope on a 53-yard pass play to get the Wildcats out from their own end zone midway through the first quarter. The Pirates drove the ball seventy yards and kicked a 20-yard field goal with 19 seconds remaining to lead 3-0 at the end of the first quarter. Roland again made the key defensive stop with a two yard tackle for loss with the ball on the B-CU one yard line

Seven plays later, Matt McCutcheon kicked a 36 yard field goal with 9:16 to play, B-CU upped its lead to 17-6.

Two QB sacks by Jr. DL Dexter Jackson in the second half keyed the defense who totaled 6 sacks in the ball game for 56 yards in losses.

SENIORS AND B-CU GO OUT WITH 14-12 HOME WIN OVER HOWARD UNIVERSITY

The B-CU football team upped its record to 8-2 overall and 5-2 in the MEAC with a tough 14-12 win over Howard University (1-9, 0-7, MEAC) Saturday at Municipal Stadium.

Twelve Wildcat seniors ended their home careers with the win and three seniors made game-winning plays in the victory. Senior safety Travis Roland blocked an extra point attempt, preserving a 7-6 fourth quarter margin. And he also totaled eight tackles, one sack and two tackles for losses against the Bison.

Senior quarterback McKinson Souverain led the team in rushing with 70 yards and scored a fourth quarter touchdown (54 yard run) to put the Wildcats up 14-6 with 7:19 to play

COUNCIL PUNT RETURN TOUCHDOWN ONLY SCORE OF THE FIRST HALF

B-CU's all-MEAC return specialist - senior Corey Council scooted 55 yards with a punt return for the first half's only score as the Wildcats' 7-0 margin held up into the fourth quarter. It was Council's third career return TD and he has totaled nearly 2,000 yards in returns over his brilliant four-year career at Bethune-Cookman University.

TWO-POINT CONVERSION STOP SEALS WIN IN FINAL MINUTE

The 'Cats defense (quarterback pressure by Brent Davis and Travis Roland) stopped Howard quarterback Floyd Haigler on the critical two-point conversion pass with 1:00 minute remaining after the Bison scored to make the score 14-12 in the final stanza. Haigler had to throw the ball to the back of the end zone and the pass was way off target. Haigler passed the ball 49 times in the game and completed 30 for 197 yards to lead the Bison offense. Bethune-Cookman's defense limited Howard to 34 yard rushing on 30 attempts.

RATTLERS LEAD 10-0 AFTER FIRST 15 MINUTES

FAMU's Trevor Scott kicked a 37 yard field goal to cap the first drive of the game and give the Rattlers a 3-0 lead with 12:16 to play in the first quarter.

Corey Council's 65 yard kickoff return down to the FAMU 21 set up B-CU's first scoring opportunity. A 6 yard McKinson Souverain TD run was called back on a chopped block penalty call. Matthew McCutcheon's 42 yard field goal was wide right with 7:54 remaining in the first quarter.

FAMU went ahead 10-0 on RB Phillip Sylvester's 3 yard TD run capping off a five-play, 74-yard drive.

B-CU's Phillip Kirkland fumbled to start the second Wildcat possession on the FAMU 27. The 'Cats defense held with DB Arkee Smith breaking up a fourth and 15 pass Rattlers' pass play inside the 20.

FAMU out-gained the Wildcats 153 to 11 in the first 15 minutes, led by QB Curtis Pulley's 74-yard rushing and 28 yards passing.

TEAMS COMBINE FOR 49 POINTS SCORED IN SECOND QUARTER

Pulley's 21 yard touchdown run early in the second quarter capped a nine-play, 65-yard drive to give FAMU a 17-0 lead with 14:18 to play in the half.

Backup QB Matthew Johnson's tipped pass was intercepted by FAMU on the B-CU 27 yard line setting up another Sylvester scoring run to make the count 24-0 with 9:58 left in the first half.

A 51-yard touchdown scramble by QB Pulley gave FAMU a 31-0 lead with 6:51 left in the second quarter.

B-CU QB Matthew Johnson had two scrambling runs totaling 41 yards and was injured on the second run down to the FAMU three-yard line. Souverain came in and scored from three yards out to make the score 31-7.

Brendan Odom scooped up a FAMU fumble and returned it to the five yard line setting up the next B-CU score - another Souverain three-yard run with 4:40 to play. McCutcheon missed the extra point to make the score 31-13.

FAMU's LeRoy Vann returned the ensuing kickoff 83 yards for a touchdown (his 6th kick return for TD in 2008 - 3 KO and 3 punts) giving the Rattlers a 38-13 lead.

The wild second quarter scoring spree continued with Souverain scrambling for a 30-yard run to mid-field then threw a 35-yard strike to WR Jeff Pope down to the FAMU 15. RB Andrese Bell scored on a three-yard TD run with 2:23 to play, then Bell converted the two-point conversion run to make the score 38-21.

Vann's fumble on the kickoff and B-CU's Reggie Sandilands' recovery gave the 'Cats possession on the FAMU 45 - but Souverain's poor pitch and fumble gave FAMU the ball back on the B-CU 40 in the final two minutes. The Bethune-Cookman defense held to end the half.

B-CU CLOSES TO 38-28 ON SOUVERAIN TOUCHDOWN RUN

McKinson Souverain ran 27 yards for a touchdown on the 'Cats first possession of the second half to cut the margin to 38-28. The scoring drive, 3-plays, 71 yards took only 38 seconds and it included runs of 22 yards by Corey Council and 24 yards by Phillip Kirkland - both on wide pitch plays from Souverain.

FAMU came right back with its own scoring drive - QB Pulley running for 35 yards in the drive and throwing a seven yard TD pass to WR Javares Knight with 10:40 to play in the third quarter - FAMU 45, B-CU 28.

The Rattlers' Trevor Scott kicked a 31 yard field goal to give FAMU a 20-point lead, 48-28 with 7:57 left in the third. The drive was set-up following a Souverain fumble near mid field.

FAMU was driving for another touchdown as the third quarter ended, FAMU leading 48-28 with the ball on the B-CU nine yard line.

FAMU - 58-35 WINNERS OUT-SCORING 'CATS 10-7 IN LAST QUARTER

Rattlers' placekicker Trevor Scott kicked his third field goal of the contest to make the score 51-28, with 14:52 to play in the game.

Following a B-CU Souverain fumble, the Rattlers scored again with Pulley hitting Isaac West with a 20-yard touchdown pass with 13:48 left - FAMU 58, B-CU 28.

Rattler Game MVP - Jr. QB Curtis Pulley for FAMU rushed for 171 yards and two touchdowns and he also threw for two scores and accounted for over 300 yards in total offense.

Phillip Kirkland's 40 yard touchdown pass from Souverain in the final minutes closed the scoring with B-CU's 69 yard drive in three plays with 1:19 remaining.
