Overall Statistics in the Conference

- Ranked in the top 3 out of the 11 schools in 4 categories (Hitting %, Assists, Kills, and Blocks), including leading the conference in blocks.
- Ranked fourth in digs per set.
- Senior Chelle Ticeson led the conference in hitting percentage with an average of .424 against MEAC opponents.
- Kaiyana Johnson averaged 1.0 blocks per set against MEAC opponents, second in the conference
- Chelle Ticeson -Awarded All-Conference 2nd Team second consecutive season

Kaiyana Johnson – Top Returner -All-Tournament Team at the MEAC Championships – Second volleyball player for B-CU with this accomplishment – Honors came in consecutive seasons (Ticeson-2008, Johnson-2009)

- Led the Wildcats in blocks with 73 total blocks, and was top three on the team in four categories
- Finished the season with 179 kills, a .276 hitting percentage, 38 digs, and 222 points.
