2008 SEASON IN REVIEW

Michigan finished the 2008 baseball season as conference champions for the third consecutive year, also earning the Big Ten Tournament title and its fourth straight bid into the NCAA Championship. In the process, the Wolverines set a record for wins in a Big Ten season with a 26-5 mark during the conference slate.

Michigan boasted a No. 17 national ranking and a 45-12 overall record at the end of conference tournament play, earning the right to host an NCAA Regional for the first time since 1986. The bid also marked the first time since 2001 that a Big Ten school served as a regional host and just the fourth time overall since the NCAA began naming regionals after host schools in 1999.

The Wolverines opened regional action with a 7-5 win over Kentucky before dropping a narrow, 4-3 decision to regional No. 1 seed Arizona. Michigan's season was then cut short with a 16-12 loss to Kentucky.

The NCAA bid was the 21st in Michigan's history, while the tournament title was the squad's eighth, and the regular-season championship was the team's 35th. Michigan leads the Big Ten in regular-season titles and is tied with Ohio State and Minnesota for most tournament crowns. Only Minnesota (28) has more NCAA Championship appearances than the Wolverines.

Michigan also took home three major conference awards in 2008, as head coach **Rich Maloney** was named Big Ten Coach of the Year, while senior **Nate Recknagel** was named the conference's Player of the Year and junior **Zach Putnam** was named Pitcher of the Year. Northwestern hurler **Eric Jokisch** was named Big Ten Freshman of the Year.

Big Ten teams and individuals also broke several conference records this season. Team records broken this conference season include hits (**Indiana**, 368), doubles (**Purdue**, 73), walks (**Penn State**, 141), stolen bases (**Iowa**, 75), assists (**Indiana**, 379) and double plays (**Indiana**, 40). Individual season records broken this conference season include runs (**Kyle Hudson**, ILL, 40), RBI (**Josh Phegley**, IND, 45) and stolen bases (**Caleb Curry**, IOWA, 26), while **Josh Lindblom** of Purdue tied the single-season saves mark (9) and **Landon Nakata** of Penn State tied the record for assists (108).

2008 MLB DRAFT

Twenty-six Big Ten baseball players were selected in Major League Baseball's first-year player draft, held June 5-6. Seven student-athletes were taken on Day 1 of the event, marking the highest total of Big Ten players taken in the top six rounds in the past decade.

Purdue reliever **Josh Lindblom** was the conference's first draft selection, tabbed in the second round by the Los Angeles Dodgers as the 61st overall pick. Also taken on the first day of the draft were fourth-rounders **Kyle Hudson** of Illinois (116th overall to Baltimore Orioles), **Drew O'Neil** of Penn State (120th overall to Chicago White Sox) and **Ryne White** of Purdue (138th overall to Arizona Diamondbacks). Rounding out Day 1 of the draft were Michigan's **Jason Christian** (5th round to Oakland Athletics) and **Zach Putnam** (5th round to Cleveland Indians) and Ohio State's **J.B. Shuck** (6th round to Houston Astros).

The 26 overall selections marks the most for the Big Ten since 2005, when 27 players were drafted. Michigan and Purdue, who finished first and second, respectively, in the conference standings, led all Big Ten schools with five draft choices each.

Seventeen members of the 2008 All-Big Ten baseball teams were selected in this year's draft, including nine members of the first team in Illinois' **Hudson**, Indiana's **Andrew Means**, Michigan's **Nate Recknagel**, Christian and Putnam, Minnesota's **Nate Hanson** and **Matt Nohelty**, Penn State's **O'Neil** and Purdue's **Matt Bischoff**.

Also drafted were the Big Ten's Player and Pitcher of the Year in Recknagel and Putnam, respectively, and the conference tournament's Most Outstanding Player, Michigan's **Michael Powers**.

BIG TEN POSTSEASON AWARDS

On the day before the 2008 Big Ten Baseball Tournament, the conference office announced the 2008 All-Big Ten baseball teams and individual award winners. From Big Ten Champion Michigan, senior **Nate Recknagel** was honored as Player of the Year, junior **Zach Putnam** was named Pitcher of the Year and **Rich Maloney** was recognized as Coach of the Year. Rounding out the individual awards, Northwestern pitcher **Eric Jokisch** was named Freshman of the Year. This marks the first time since 2002 and the fourth time overall that the Player, Pitcher and Coach of the Year all hailed from the same institution.

A unanimous selection to the All-Big Ten first team at first base, Recknagel broke Michigan's single-season home runs record earlier this season, currently with a Big Ten-best 23 long balls in the 2008 campaign. In conference play, he recorded 10 dingers, tying him for the Big Ten's lead. He also ranked in the conference's top five in slugging percentage (.676), RBI (34) and total bases (73) during Big Ten games. In overall competition Recknagel led the conference in slugging percentage (.787) and total bases (155) and posted an on-base percentage of .471 with 54 runs scored and 68 RBI.

Putnam, who is also a first-team honoree at designated hitter and a unanimous selection for first-team All-Big Ten pitcher, closed out the conference season ranking second in ERA (2.20) opponents' batting average (.211) strikeouts (46) and wins (6), making him the only pitcher to rank in the top three in each of those categories. The junior recorded a 6-0 record in Big Ten play and was 7-0 overall in 2008. Earlier this season, the right-hander became the first player since 1993 to be named Big Ten Pitcher of the Week and Player of the Week in the same season. On offense, Putnam batted .326 with eight home runs, 24 RBI and a .663 slugging percentage during conference action.

Maloney earns his second consecutive Coach of the Year honor after leading Michigan to a record-breaking season in which his team set a new standard for wins in a Big Ten season with a 26-5 mark. Under Maloney's tutelage, the Wolverines maintained a spot in the national rankings and are currently rated No. 17 by Baseball America. The sixth-year mentor led his squad to its third consecutive Big Ten title and the program's 35th overall. Maloney has guided his team to a Big Ten Tournament appearance in each of his six seasons at the helm and is poised to lead the Maize and Blue to the NCAA Tournament for the fourth straight year.

Jokisch emerged as the ace of Northwestern's staff, combining to post a Big Ten-best seven wins in eight conference starts this season. The left-hander led the Wildcats with a 4.84 ERA and registered two complete games, including a complete-game shutout over conference champion Michigan on May 16. Jokisch's shutout marked the first time the Wolverines had been blanked all season and the first time in 64 games that the squad had not scored a run at home. Jokisch was also voted a member of the All-Big Ten second team as a starting pitcher.

The All-Big Ten first team features four unanimous selections, including Recknagel and Putnam. Illinois outfielder **Kyle Hudson** was a unanimous choice after finishing first in the Big Ten in runs scored (40), second in stolen bases (25) and third in on-base percentage (.522) during conference games. He also ranked in the Big Ten's top 10 in batting average (.407), hits (44) and doubles (9). His 25 swipes make him one of just two players in history to record 20 or more steals in a Big Ten season. Also a unanimous decision, Indiana catcher **Josh Phegley** finished the conference slate first in slugging percentage (.776), RBI (45) and total bases (90) and tied for the lead in home runs (10). He also ranked in the top five in average (.431), on-base percentage (.500), runs scored (38) and hits (50).

Joining Recknagel, Putnam, Hudson and Phegley on the first team are Purdue second baseman **Ben Wolgamot**, Michigan shortstop **Jason Christian**, Minnesota third baseman **Nate Hanson**, Indiana outfielder **Andrew Means**, Minnesota outfielder **Matt Nohelly**, Indiana pitcher **Matt Bashore**, Michigan hurler **Chris Fetter**, Purdue starter **Matt Bischoff** and Penn State reliever **Drew O'Neil**.

The 2008 All-Big Ten teams featured two multiple honorees as Putnam was named a first-team designated hitter and starting pitcher for the second year in a row. In 2007, Putnam became the first player in conference history to be named to the first team at two different positions. Also this year, Ohio State's **J.B. Shuck** was named to the All-Big Ten third team as a starting pitcher and an outfielder.

ACADEMIC ALL-BIG TEN

The Big Ten Conference recognized 87 of its baseball players with spots on the Academic All-Conference team. To be eligible for Academic All-Big Ten selection, student-athletes must be letterwinners in at least their second academic year at their institution and carry a cumulative grade-point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
