**2006 POSTSEASON NOTES**

**NIT Run:** Michigan wrapped up the 2005-06 season falling to South Carolina, 76-64, in the championship game of the National Invitation Tournament. The Wolverines, who defeated UTEP, Notre Dame, Miami (Fla.) and Old Dominion before taking on the Gamecocks, advanced to the championship game of the NIT for the second time in the last three years. It also marked the 11th time that a Big Ten program competed for the NIT title. Michigan leads all Big Ten teams, advancing to the NIT Championship game three times in school history (1984, 2004 and 2006), winning the 1984 and 2004 crowns.

**Nine Teams in Postseason:** Nine of the 11 Big Ten schools earned postseason berths this season with Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan State, Ohio State and Wisconsin taking part in the 2006 NCAA Championship and Michigan, Minnesota and Penn State competing for the NIT title. The conference officially sent nine programs to the postseason for the first time in league history, although the Big Ten did advance nine teams to postseason play in both 2001 and 1993 before appearances were later vacated by Ohio State and Michigan, respectively. The league's six representatives in the NCAA Championship were officially the most since the 2001 event, when Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Michigan State, Penn State and Wisconsin competed for the national title. The Big Ten sent an official league record of seven teams to the NCAA Championship in 1990.

## BIG TEN NOTES

**Everybody's All-Americans:** Illinois' **Dee Brown** was named a consensus second-team All-American following the 2005-06 season. Brown collected second-team accolades from the *Associated Press*, U.S. Basketball Writers Association (USBWA) and National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC). It marked the second consecutive year that Brown earned All-America honors. Indiana's **Marco Killingsworth**, Iowa's **Jeff Horner**, Michigan State's **Maurice Ager** and **Paul Davis** and Ohio State's **Terence Dials** also collected All-America honorable mention accolades from the AP.

**Wooden Award All-American:** Illinois' **Dee Brown** was named to the 2006 John R. Wooden Award All-America Team for the second consecutive year. The senior point guard joined Duke's J.J. Redick as the only repeat members on this year's Wooden All-America Team.

**Brown Claims Cousy Award:** Illinois' **Dee Brown** was named the winner of the 2006 Bob Cousy Award, becoming the first Big Ten standout to earn this honor. The Cousy Award is presented by the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame in conjunction with The Hartford Financial Services Group, Inc. and is presented annually to the nation's top collegiate point guard. The first recipient was St. Joseph's Jameer Nelson in 2004, followed by North Carolina's Raymond Felton in 2005.

**Playing Smart Basketball:** Iowa's **Greg Brunner** and **Adam Haluska** were named to the 2006 *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-America third team. Iowa is the only Division I program in the nation to have two players selected for Academic All-America honors. To be nominated, student-athletes must be a starter or important reserve and carry a cumulative grade point average of 3.20 or higher. Minnesota's **Adam Boone** joined Brunner and Haluska on the Academic All-District teams.

**On the Big Ten Sidelines:** The Big Ten welcomes new head coach **Kelvin Sampson**, who takes over the Indiana program after spending the last 12 seasons at the helm of Oklahoma. He brings impressive credentials with him to Bloomington, including a 455-257 (.639) overall record and a 279-109 (.719) ledger at OU. Sampson amassed 111 regular season Big 12 victories, the most in league history, while also collecting three conference tournament titles and a share of the 2004-05 regular-season crown. He also led the Sooners to 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, including a showing in the 2002 Final Four. Prior to his stay at Oklahoma, Sampson spent seven years (1987-94) as the head coach and two years as the assistant coach (1985-87) at Washington State and four years (1981-85) as the head coach at Montana Tech.

**In the RPI Rankings:** During the 2005-06 campaign, the RPI Report rated the Big Ten No. 1 in 13 of the final 15 weeks, while Sagarin had the conference ranked as the top league 11 times during that stretch. The Big Ten concluded the 2005-06 season ranked No. 2 in the RPI Report, while finishing third in the Sagarin ratings. It marks the highest finish for the conference since 2000-01 when the league ended the season ranked No. 1 in the RPI Report and No. 2 in the Sagarin ratings.

**Non-Conference Success:** The Big Ten posted the best out-of-league winning percentage in over six years at .767 (115-35). During the 1998-99 season, the conference recorded a non-league mark of 102-26 (.797), which does not include vacated records from Michigan or Minnesota. The Big Ten's .767 winning percentage was an improvement of more than 10 percent over the 2004-05 non-league mark of 109-47 (.669). With 115 wins in 2005-06, the Big Ten also posted the most non-conference victories since the 2000-01 season when the Big Ten tallied a 116-40 (.744) mark.

**Basketball Times Rankings:** The Big Ten led the nation with all 11 teams ranked in the final *Basketball Times* Regular Season Schedule Rankings. The Big East followed with nine teams, while the ACC had 7 teams in the top 35. Indiana finished in second place (157.8) and Michigan State ranked third (155.6). Rounding out the Big Ten contingent were Iowa (14th-145.2), Michigan (15th-144.4), Purdue (16th-144.1), Minnesota (18th-143.2), Penn State (20th-142.8), Wisconsin (23rd-140.9), Illinois (27th-139.0), Ohio State (33rd-136.4) and Northwestern (35th-134.4).

**Iowa Wins Second Big Ten Tournament Crown:** Second-seeded Iowa captured a 67-60 victory over top seed Ohio State to claim the Hawkeyes' second Big Ten Tournament crown in program history. Iowa knocked off Minnesota in the quarterfinals before edging Michigan State in the semifinals to set up a rematch of the 2002 final, won by the Buckeyes in the first Big Ten Tournament held in Indianapolis. **Jeff Horner** would pour in 14 points in the second half to boost Iowa to the victory, its first tourney title since 2001. The Hawkeyes join Illinois and Michigan State as the only two-time winners of the Big Ten Tournament.

**Horner Named Tourney's Most Outstanding Player:** Iowa's **Jeff Horner** was named the 2006 Big Ten Tournament Most Outstanding Player after averaging 18.7 points and 6.0 assists during the three victories, including a double-double of 16 points and 10 assists in the championship game. Horner is the second Hawkeye standout to collect Most Outstanding Player accolades, joining Reggie Evans, who was honored in 2001. Horner was joined by teammate **Greg Brunner** on the All-Tournament team, while Michigan State's **Maurice Ager** and Ohio State's **Jamar Butler** and **J.J. Sullinger** also earned All-Tournament laurels.

**Buckeyes Win Outright Big Ten Title:** Ohio State won the Big Ten title for the first time since the 2001-02 season with a 12-4 record in league action. The Buckeyes captured the title outright with a win over Purdue on the last day of the regular season on March 5, the school's first outright title since 1992. OSU has now won 18 titles for the third-highest total in league annals behind Purdue (21) and Indiana (20).

## BIG TEN NOTES, CONT.

**Early Success For Matta:** In his second season in Columbus, Ohio State head coach **Thad Matta** became the third active coach to win a Big Ten title in his first two seasons in the league. Illinois' **Bruce Weber** claimed outright crowns in both 2004 and 2005, his first two years in Champaign. Wisconsin's **Bo Ryan** also topped the conference in each of his first two years (2002-03).

**Dials Named Player of the Year:** Ohio State's **Terence Dials** collected the conference's highest honor as he was chosen as the Big Ten Player of the Year in voting by both the coaches and the media. He is the first Buckeye to earn Player of the Year accolades since Scoonie Penn was tabbed the media's choice in 1999 and the fourth standout in school history. Two-time All-American Jim Jackson won back-to-back honors for OSU in 1991 and 1992 while Dennis Hopson was the first Buckeye to garner the award in 1987. The 6-9 forward/center ranked third in field goal percentage (.599) and blocked shots (1.00 bpg) in league contests only while rating among the top 10 in rebounding (5th at 8.4 rpg) and scoring (8th at 16.3 ppg).

**Other Individual Honors:** Ohio State's **Thad Matta** was tabbed as the Big Ten Coach of the Year by the media after guiding the Buckeyes to a 12-4 record in Big Ten play. Iowa's **Erek Hansen** becomes the second Hawkeye standout to earn Defensive Player of the Year, joining **Acie Earl** who was honored in 1992. Hansen led the Big Ten in blocked shots for the second time in his four-year career (2.38 bpg) as the senior center also finished first in rejections in 2004. He was joined by Illinois' **Brian Randle**, Michigan State's **Shannon Brown**, Northwestern's **Mohamed Hachad** and Ohio State's **Je'Kel Foster**, who were all named to the league's inaugural All-Defensive Team. Iowa's **Doug Thomas**, who did not record a single start in 30 regular-season games, earns the league's first-ever Sixth Man of the Year honor. The senior forward averaged 4.6 points and 4.6 rebounds while providing a spark off the bench for the Hawkeyes, who finished tied for second in the conference standings. Penn State's **Jamelle Cornley** became the first Nittany Lion in league history to earn Freshman of the Year honors. The 6-6 forward ranked among the top 25 in points (25th at 11.1 ppg) and rebounds per game (12th at 5.9 rpg) in league games only this season. Cornley was joined by four other first-year standouts on the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. The five-man squad also included Illinois' **Jamar Smith**, Northwestern's **Craig Moore**, Purdue's **Chris Lutz** and Wisconsin's **Joe Krabbenhoft**.

**All-Conference Teams:** The 2006 All-Big Ten team was led by senior standouts, as four were featured on both the media's and coaches' first teams. Both All-Big Ten first-team squads included Ohio State's **Terence Dials**, Illinois' **Dee Brown**, Iowa's **Greg Brunner** and Wisconsin's **Alando Tucker**. Illinois senior **James Augustine** was honored by the coaches, while the media named Michigan senior **Daniel Horton** to the top squad. Illinois' **Brown** earned first-team laurels for the second-consecutive year.

**2005-06 Sportsmanship Honorees:** The conference office also announced honorees from each team for the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award. The student-athletes chosen are individuals who have distinguished themselves through sportsmanship and ethical behavior. In addition, the student-athletes must be in good academic standing and have demonstrated good citizenship outside of the sports-competition setting. Honorees for men's basketball are Illinois' **Dee Brown**, Indiana's **Marshall Strickland**, Iowa's **Adam Haluska**, Michigan's **Graham Brown**, Michigan State's **Maurice Ager**, Minnesota's **Adam Boone**, Northwestern's **Michael Jenkins**, Ohio State's **Je'Kel Foster**, Penn State's **Mike Walker**, Purdue's **Bryant Dillon** and Wisconsin's **Alando Tucker**. These 11 student-athletes are now candidates for the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award, as the conference office will honor one male and one female student-athlete from each institution at the end of the school year.

**Horton Claims Big Ten Record:** Michigan senior **Daniel Horton** established a Big Ten record this season, shooting 97.8 percent (89-of-91) from the free throw line in Big Ten games. He eclipsed the old record of 93.5 percent (58-of-62) held by former Hoosier and current Iowa head coach **Steve Alford** set in 1985. Horton also ranked fourth on the Big Ten's single-season free throw percentage list for

all games as he shot 90.1 percent (136-of-151) during the 2005-06 season. Alford still holds the mark for all games with a 92.1 free throw percentage (116-of-126).

**Big Ten Career Leaders:** Several Big Ten seniors closed out their careers on the league's all-time records list. Illinois' **Dee Brown** finished fifth on the league's career assists list with 674. In addition, Brown ranked fifth on the all-time three-point field goals made (299) chart and sixth on the career steals (230) list. Iowa senior **Jeff Horner** also ranked among the league's top 10 in career assists with 612 dishes for seventh place, while listed eighth on the all-time three-pointers chart (262).

## BIG TEN NOTES, CONT.

**Augustine's 1,000-plus Rebounds:** During the 2005-06 season, Illinois' **James Augustine** became the 11th player in Big Ten history to top 1,000 career rebounds. In his four years at Illinois, he tallied 1,023 rebounds, while also adding 1,383 points. The last Big Ten standout to record more than 1,000 all-time boards was Indiana's Alan Henderson, who concluded his four-year career in 1995 with 1,091 rebounds to rank fifth on the conference's career list. Ohio State's Jerry Lucas (1959-62) is the Big Ten's rebounding leader with 1,411 boards.

**Tucker Takes Scoring Title:** With 20.0 points per conference game this season (320 in 16 games), Wisconsin's **Alando Tucker** claimed the league's scoring title in Big Ten only contests. Tucker is the first Badger to finish first in the conference scoring rankings since Don Rehfeldt won back-to-back scoring titles in 1949 and 1950. Tucker was closely followed by Michigan's **Daniel Horton**, who posted 19.8 points per game this league season to finish with 316 points, just four shy of the league lead.

**Other Conference Leaders:** In other conference game only categories, Iowa's **Greg Brunner** finished first in rebounds, while teammate **Erek Hansen** led the league in blocks. Ohio State's **Je'Kel Foster** claimed the conference's steals title, while Illinois' **Dee Brown** and Michigan State's **Drew Neitzel** tied atop the league rankings in assists. Brunner tallied 9.6 caroms per game, while Hansen led the Big Ten with 2.38 blocks per outing. The last Hawkeye to lead the pack in rebounds was Jared Reiner in 2003, while Hansen returns as the league's leader in blocked shots after finishing first in that category in 2004. Foster became the second Buckeye to lead the pack in steals (2.13 pg), joining Scoonie Penn in 1999. Brown and Neitzel tied for the conference lead with 5.56 assists per game. For the fourth consecutive year, the assist title has gone to a Fighting Illini, as Brown's former teammate Deron Williams tallied three consecutive crowns from 2003-2005. Neitzel is the first Spartan to lead the league in assists since Marcus Taylor in 2002.

**Big Ten's Grand Company:** The league's group of 1,000-point scorers more than doubled from the start of the season as 19 standouts finished above that scoring plateau, including three teams with three players. It marks the second consecutive year that the conference has produced more than 15 1,000-point producers. Last year, the Big Ten concluded the season with 17 members of this grand club. Eight Big Ten seniors began the season on the 1,000-point list in Illinois' **Dee Brown** (1,812), Indiana's **Marco Killingsworth** (1,572), Iowa's **Greg Brunner** (1,516) and **Jeff Horner** (1,502), Michigan's **Daniel Horton** (1,614), Michigan State's **Paul Davis** (1,718), Northwestern's **Vedran Vukusic** (1,581) and Ohio State's **Terence Dials** (1,566). 11 more players joined the list this season in Illinois' **James Augustine** (1,383), Indiana's **Marshall Strickland** (1,106), Iowa's **Adam Haluska** (1,225), Michigan's **Dion Harris** (1,130), Michigan State's **Maurice Ager** (1,554) and **Shannon Brown** (1,183), Minnesota's **Vincent Grier** (1,118) and **Maurice Hargrow** (1,021), Ohio State's **Ron Lewis** (1,236) and **J.J. Sullinger** (1,208) and Wisconsin's **Alando Tucker** (1,501). The Big Ten's "Grand Company" list appears above.

**Big Ten Attendance Records:** The Big Ten reached two attendance landmarks this season as the conference broke the two-million mark in all games for the 14th straight season, while also reaching the one-million plateau for league games only for the 29th consecutive season. In 2006, 2,186,322 patrons passed through the turnstiles for 176 games for an average attendance of 12,422. In league contests, 1,191,079 fans flocked to conference arenas for 88 games for an average of 13,535 per outing, the highest since the 2001-02 campaign (13,790). In 2004-05, the conference led the nation in total attendance for the 29th-straight season with 2,255,332 total patrons and led the way with an average attendance of 12,530 per game/session.

**Movin' Up:** Michigan State's head coach **Tom Izzo** is making his mark in the league's coaching records as he continues to climb up the Big Ten's career list for most victories. He concluded the 2005-06 season with 125 triumphs, tying him with Iowa's Tom Davis (1986-99) for 13th place. In his 11 years in East Lansing, the Spartan mentor has tallied an overall mark of 255-109 and a 125-55 record in league action.

**Big Ten Hosting 2007 NCAA First/Second Round:** In 2007, the Big Ten will host the NCAA Men's Basketball Championship First and Second Rounds on Friday and Sunday, March 16 and 18, at the United Center in Chicago. It marks the third time in league history that the conference has played host to the NCAA Tournament as the Big Ten welcomed eight teams to the United Center in both 1998 and 2002. Ohio State will also host first and second rounds (March 16 and 18) next year at the Nationwide Arena in downtown Columbus.

## BIG TEN PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

- Nov. 21** **Marco Killingsworth, IND:** Tallied career highs in points (28), rebounds (13), assists (6) and blocked shots (4); Shot 12-of-18 from the floor and earned his first double-double as a Hoosier in 33 minutes of action.
- Alando Tucker, WIS:** Led the Badgers to a pair of victories after averaging 24 points and 9.0 rebounds per game at the Paradise Jam Tournament; Established a tournament record with a career-high 38 points in a 95-89 double-overtime victory over Eastern Kentucky.
- Nov. 28** **Paul Davis, MSU:** Averaged a double-double with 22.5 points and 12.3 rebounds in four games to lead MSU to a 3-1 record; Tallied 30 points on 12-of-17 shooting against IPFW, finishing just two points shy of his career best, while adding 14 rebounds for his fourth double-double of the season.
- Dec. 5** **James Augustine, ILL:** Recorded his third double-double of the season and 19th of his career with 13 points and 13 rebounds in a win at North Carolina; For the week, averaged a double-double with 18 points and 10 rebounds on a combined 73.3 percent shooting (11-of-15).
- Marco Killingsworth, IND:** Averaged 24 points and 6.5 rebounds per game while leading the Hoosiers to a 1-1 record; Went 15-of-20 from the field to tally a career-high 34 points, while adding 10 rebounds against top-ranked Duke.
- Dec. 12** **Courtney Sims, MICH:** Helped the Wolverines stay undefeated after averaging a double-double with 23.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game; Opened the week, tallying a career-high 33 points on a career-best 13-of-17 shooting (.765) in a 69-49 victory over Delaware State; Also added a season-best 13 rebounds against the Hornets for his sixth career double-double.
- Dec. 19** **Je'Kel Foster, OSU:** Went 6-of-8 from the three-point line (.750), while connecting on 9-of-12 shots from the field (.750) to finish with a career-high 28 points in a 70-67 victory over Iowa State; Was also perfect from the foul line (4-of-4), while recording six rebounds and a pair of steals.
- Dec. 26** **Shannon Brown, MSU:** Scored 26 points and a career-high eight assists, while committing no turnovers in MSU's 98-69 victory at UW-Green Bay; Shot 9-of-13 from the field (.692), making a career-best six three-pointers.
- Jan. 2** **Robert Vaden, IND:** Broke a school record after going a perfect 6-of-6 from three-point range in an 80-56 victory over Ball State; Eclipsed the former mark of 5-of-5 held by Kyle Hornsby (vs. Michigan, Feb. 17, 2002) and Keith Smart (vs. Ohio State, March 5, 1987).
- Jan. 9** **Vedran Vukusic, NU:** Averaged 22.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game, while leading the Wildcats to a 2-0 league record, their best start in Big Ten play since the 1982-83 season; Against Purdue, tied a season high with 28 points on 9-of-13 shooting, while going 8-of-9 from the free throw line.
- Jan. 16** **Paul Davis, MSU:** Averaged 20.5 points and 11 rebounds per game, while leading MSU to a pair of victories over ranked opponents; Scored 18 points and grabbed a game-high 12 rebounds, including 11 defensive boards, to earn his conference-best 10th double-double of the season against Indiana.
- Jan. 23** **Marco Killingsworth, IND:** Tallied consecutive double-double performances while leading the Hoosiers to a 2-0 record; Opened the week with a game-high 23 points and 12 rebounds in win over No. 7/5 Illinois, marking the highest-ranked opponent that the Hoosiers had defeated at home since knocking off then-No. 1 Michigan State, 59-58, on Jan. 7, 2001.
- Jan. 30** **Adam Haluska, IOWA:** Led the Hawkeyes to consecutive wins over ranked opponents; Tallied his first career double-double with 20 points and 10 rebounds, while also going a perfect 9-of-9 from the free throw line; Finished the week averaging 19 points, 8.5 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game.
- Daniel Horton, MICH:** Led the Wolverines to victories over No. 11/12 Michigan State and No. 23/21 Wisconsin, marking the first time in 12 years that Michigan has defeated consecutive ranked opponents; Closed out the week averaging 18.5 points, 4.5 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game, while also tallying a perfect 18-of-18 from the free throw line.
- Feb. 6** **Jeff Horner, IOWA:** Averaged 23 points, five assists and four rebounds, while shooting 60 percent from the field (15-of-25) to lead the Hawkeyes to two victories; Tallied a career-high 32 points and went 7-of-10 from the three-point line against Purdue; Also became Iowa's all-time leader in treys with a total of nine three-point field goals during the week.
- Je'Kel Foster, OSU:** Shot 75 percent from the field (15-of-20) while averaging 21.5 points per game; Scored 25 points against Minnesota, three shy of his career high; Also made seven of eight treys versus the Golden Gophers, setting a career high for three-point field goals made.
- Feb. 13** **Jamar Butler, OSU:** Recorded a career-high 20 points at No. 22/22 Michigan and then set a new career-best with 22 points against No. 10/9 Illinois; Finished the week making 71.4 percent of his shots (15-of-21) and 87.5 percent of his three-point attempts (7-of-8), while averaging 21 points per game to lead the Buckeyes to two conference triumphs over ranked opponents.
- Feb. 20** **Alando Tucker, WIS:** Notched game highs of 27 points and 16 rebounds to lead Wisconsin to a come-from-behind, 78-73 upset of No. 12 Ohio State; Scored 17 of his 27 points in the decisive second half, when UW outscored OSU, 50-36; Claimed his third double-double of the season and shot 55.6 percent from the field (10-of-18), while also going 7-of-11 from the free throw line.
- Feb. 28** **Terence Dials, OSU:** Tallied consecutive double-double performances while helping the Buckeyes to victories over No. 18/16 Michigan State and Michigan; Finished the week averaging 20.5 points and 10.5 rebounds, while connecting on 64 percent of his shots from the field (18-of-28); Became the first Buckeye to record five or more consecutive double-doubles since Brad Sellers posted a streak of nine straight double-dips in 1985-86.
- March 6** **Paul Davis, MSU:** Averaged 24.0 points and 11.5 rebounds while leading the Spartans to a 1-1 record; Against Wisconsin, shot 9-of-12 from the field and 9-of-10 at the foul line, while scoring 27 points and grabbing nine rebounds; Against Illinois, recorded his 14th double-double of the season with 21 points and a season-high 14 boards.

## POSTSEASON NOTES

**History of NCAA Success:** Since the inception of the NCAA Tournament in 1939, the Big Ten has recorded the most appearances of any conference in the Big Dance with 174 (ACC, 160) and has the second-most NCAA Tournament victories with 277 (ACC, 316). The conference has tied the ACC for the most Final Four appearances with 38 and boasts the second-most national titles (10) in college basketball history. The Pac-10 leads the nation with 15 titles.

**Final Four Frenzy:** The Big Ten trails only the ACC (7) in Final Four appearances since 2000 with six league representatives reaching the national semifinals. The Big 12 follows with five appearances over that time span, followed by the SEC (3), Big East (2) and Pac-10 (2). Michigan State leads the Big Ten with three appearances (2000, 2001 and 2005), while Illinois (2005), Indiana (2002) and Wisconsin (2000) have each earned a Final Four spot in that time span.

**Low Seeds Turn Into High Win Totals:** Big Ten teams have made a habit of advancing deep into the tournament despite low seeds. In 2005, fifth-seeded Michigan State was the lowest-seeded team to advance to the Final Four. Three years ago, the Spartans were the lowest seed to reach the 2003 Elite Eight after winning three games despite earning a No. 7 seed. Two other conference teams have advanced to the Final Four in the last seven years despite their low seeds, as fifth-seeded Indiana advanced to the 2002 national championship game and eighth-seeded Wisconsin reached the national semifinals in 2000.

**Coaching Elite:** Over the last nine NCAA Tournaments, Michigan State head coach **Tom Izzo** has led MSU to a 23-8 record and is also one of only nine coaches in NCAA Tournament history to advance to three straight Final Fours, which he accomplished from 1999-2001. In 2005, Izzo directed the Spartans to his fourth Final Four in his first 10 seasons as a college head coach, becoming just the second coach in NCAA history to accomplish this feat. Ohio State head coach Fred Taylor took his Buckeyes to four Final Fours in his first 10 seasons. In addition, Izzo also ranks second behind Duke's Mike Krzyzewski (.782) in NCAA Tournament winning percentage among active coaches at .742.

**Eight-Year Plan:** Over the last eight NCAA Tournaments, the Big Ten ranks second in winning percentage (.638), while finishing third among all conferences in victories (67). See the chart below for the complete NCAA Tournament breakdown for the Big Ten, ACC, Big 12, Big East, Pac-10 and SEC over the last eight seasons.

**Big Ten Tournament Benefits:** Since the inception of the Big Ten Tournament in 1998, the conference has sent seven different teams to the Final Four and has won over 60 percent of its NCAA Tournament games, compiling a record of 73-42 in the national event from 1998 through 2006.

**Breaking Even in NCAA Play:** The Big Ten has produced a mark of .500 or better in eight of the last nine events. Among the six conferences with the most tournament wins over that time span, only the ACC and Big East have posted NCAA records of .500 or better over the last nine years. The Big East has broken even in two of the last six years (2002: 6-6, 2001: 5-5) while the ACC's lowest winning percentage occurred with a 5-4 finish in 2003. The Big 12 (2001, 1999, 1998), Pac-10 (2004, 1999) and SEC (2002, 2001) have all been under .500 at least twice in the last nine seasons.

**Big Ten Teams in the NCAA Tournament:** The Big Ten had 62 teams receive bids to the NCAA Tournament in the '90s. Indiana led all conference teams and received a berth every year of the decade. Overall, the Hoosiers had competed in 18 consecutive tournaments before the 2003-04 season, the third-longest streak in the history of the tournament. The following is a list of Big Ten teams in the NCAA Tournament since 1990, over the last 17 years:

**The Big Dance Constant:** Michigan State is one of only four schools in the nation that has advanced to the NCAA Tournament in each of the last nine years, joining Duke, Kansas and Kentucky. Wisconsin has also advanced to eight consecutive NCAA's. Only eight other schools have accomplished this feat during this time span: Arizona, Duke, Florida, Gonzaga, Michigan State, Kansas, Kentucky and Texas.

**17 No. Seeds:** Big Ten teams have been awarded the top seed 17 times since the field expanded to 64 squads in 1985, ranking second behind only the ACC (19) over that time span. The Big 12 has had 13, followed by the Pac-10 (11) and Big East (10). Michigan State leads all Big Ten squads with four No. 1 seeds, while Illinois and Purdue follow in second with three top seeds each.

**The Next Generation:** The Big Ten's fraternity of coaches saw an infusion of new blood over the last six seasons, as eight coaches jumped into the conference for the first time. Despite the loss of some veteran leaders, league coaches still boasted 47 NCAA Division I Championship and 22 NIT appearances. In addition, the eight new coaches had guided Big Ten teams to an NIT title, one Final Four, nine NCAA Tournament berths, three NIT berths, five league championships and two conference tournament titles in the last six seasons. The following list breaks down the career tournament showings of each coach. Only Michigan State head coach **Tom Izzo** has won an NCAA Championship (2000):
