## NOTES / CLARIFICATIONS

Wisconsin won a school-record 30 games last season and was ranked in the Associated Press top 10 for 17 weeks, including one week at No. 1 (Feb. 19) ... the Badgers also won a school-record 13 Big Ten games and finished second in the conference to national title runner-up Ohio State ... UW earned a No. 2 seed in the 2007 NCAA Tournament, the highest in school history ... it was Wisconsin's ninth consecutive NCAA tournament bid (one of just nine teams in the country with a streak that long) ... the Badgers fell to UNLV in the second round of the tournament ... for the third time in the last four years, UW advanced to the Big Ten tournament final in 2007 ... last year, senior forward Alando Tucker broke the school's career and single-season scoring marks, was named Big Ten Player of the Year, a consensus first-team All-American and the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award winner ... head coach Bo Ryan received the 2007 Clair Bee Award and Adolph Rupp Cup as National Coach of the Year ... senior Brian Butch missed the last six games of 2006-07 with an elbow injury but participated in the 2007 Pan-Am Games tryouts during the summer and is healthy heading into this season ... Butch and classmate Michael Flowers have combined to play more than 3500 minutes in their careers ... Butch needs 301 points to become the 32nd Badger (and sixth in the last six years) to score 1,000 points in a career ... despite losing three starters from last year, UW returns 59.9 percent of its minutes, 70.1 percent of its rebounds, 62.3 percent of its assists and 48.6 percent of its scoring ... the Badgers have seven players on their roster that have scored at least 10 points in a game during their UW career ... five returnees averaged at least 15.0 minutes per game last season
