Iowa senior Brian deBuhr played one of the best tournaments of his career this past week, as he tied for fourth at the Furman Invitational. The finish, which marked his career best, was also deBuhr's first top 10 of the season. The Hawkeye posted a career low round of 70 to open the tournament and followed with rounds of 74 and 73 to finish 1-over-par for the event. He led the Hawkeyes to seventh place at the Furman Invite.

Niall Turner, Minnesota

At this past week's National Invitation Tournament, Minnesota was led by junior Niall Turner who tied for 16th at 1-under-par 215.
