2005 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships University Aquatic Center, University of Minnesota, March 24-26

THE CHAMPIONSHIPS: The 2005 NCAA Men's Swimming and Diving Championships get underway at noon on Thursday, March 24 at the University Aquatic Center on the campus of the University of Minnesota.

THE BIG TEN: The field is set and includes 55 student-athletes representing nine Big Ten squads. The League held seven ranked spots in the final College Swimming Coaches Association dual meet rankings for the 2004-05 season as Michigan (5), Minnesota (6), Indiana (13), Northwestern (14), Purdue (15), Wisconsin (18) and Ohio State (25) all made the Top 25. The Hoosiers and Golden Gophers each qualified 13 student-athletes, the most among Conference schools.

SCHOOL NOTES: Indiana qualified all five relays for this year's NCAA Championships, marking the first time in school history any IU squad has accomplished this feat. Peter Vanderkaay of Michigan, a two-time individual NCAA champion in the 400-meter freestyle and the 1,500-meter freestyle in 2004, enters the 2005 Championships with three top-two seedings. Vanderkaay holds the nation's fastest time in the 500-yard freestyle, clocking in at 4:12.34. He is also the No. 2 seed in both the 200-yard freestyle and the 1,650-yard freestyle. Additionally, the Wolverines will compete in four relays and look to add to their list of relay champions as the 800-meter freestyle relay took first at the last year's Championships, setting an NCAA and U.S. Open record with a time of 7:01.42. Michigan State's Ian Clutten will be the lone representative for the Spartans as he is seeded 11th in the 100-yard breaststroke and 25th in the 200-yard breaststroke. Nine out of the 13 qualifiers for Minnesota will be making a return trip to the NCAAs, as the Gophers look to bring their streak of top 10 team finishes to six. Northwestern's six student-athletes will compete in 14 individual events and four relays, with several Wildcats having good shots at NU's first NCAA Championship since 1958. The Buckeyes will be sending three divers to Minneapolis, tied for the most with Indiana, while Robert Kauscher will compete in both the 100- and 200-yard breaststroke events. Penn State will be represented by two divers as Adam Pierce and Marc Gastaldo will compete on both the 1-meter and 3-meter diving boards. Purdue's Louis Paul is seeded second in the 200-yard individual medley and has the potential to be the Boilermakers top point scorer as he will also compete in the 100- and 200-yard backstroke events. Wisconsin will have two competitors in both the 200-yard individual medley and the 200-yard backstroke events as Adam Mania and Timothy Liebhold are set to compete in those and other events.
