### 2008 OUTDOOR TRACK & FIELD NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS



The Penn State women's squad posted its best-ever NCAA finish and the best of any Big Ten team at the 2008 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field Championships, June 12-14, in Des Moines, Iowa, taking fourth with 39 team points. The Wolverine women claimed the seventh spot with 29 points, extending their streak to four straight top-10 showings at the NCAA Championships. On the men's side, Wisconsin grabbed the top conference finish, placing tied for 21st with a 12-point total.

The Big Ten took home four individual NCAA Championships. Nittany Lion senior Shana Cox revenged her runner-up position from last year's NCAA meet with a gold medal performance in the 400 meters in a time of 50.97. She then went on to anchor the winning 4x400-meter relay squad of Aleesha Barber, Dominique Blake, Cox and Gayle Hunter in a blistering time of 3:27.69. The Michigan women's squad garnered the other two first-place finishes with junior Tiffany Ofili defending her 2007 title in the 100-meter hurdles, breaking the tape at 12.84. Geena Gall took the top podium spot in the 800 meters, coursing the two-lap race in 2:03.91.

PSU had many contributors to its 39 team points. Sophomore Bridget Franek received a third-place medal for her efforts in the 3,000-meter steeplechase and Barber claimed fourth in the 100-meter hurdles. Hunter racked up two fifth-place points competing in the long jump and heptathlon. Hunter earned All-America honors in three different events at the NCAA Championships, more than any other Big Ten participant.

The Wolverine women also received help from junior Bettie Wade and senior Nicole Edwards. Wade proved to be one of track and field's top athletes as she racked up 5,738 points in the heptathlon to place third. Edwards earned a sixth-place finish in the 1,500-meter run in a time of 4:15.00, ending what was one of the best track careers by a Michigan woman.

In all the Big Ten women yielded 14 top-five finishes, doubling last year's total. Other top conference performers were Illinois' Angela Bizzarri (2nd - 1,500m.) Minnesota's Heather Dorniden (5th - 800m.) and Liz Roehrig (2nd - heptathlon), Purdue's Kara Patterson (5th - Javelin) and Wisconsin's Katrina Rundhaug (5th - 10,000 m.).

The Big Ten men produced five top-five medals at this year's Championships, three of them being Wisconsin distance runners. Badger sophomore Jack Bolas claimed the conference's highest place at third in the 1,500 meters, followed closely by teammate Craig Miller for fourth. The Michigan 4x400-meter relay squad took home fourth to gain All-America status. Fifth-place performers included Ohio State's Jeff See (1,500 m.) and Wisconsin's Christian Wagner (10,000 m.).

The USTFCCA recently honored the 2008 NCAA Outdoor Track and Field All-Americans. The Big Ten women displayed 27 student-athletes on this list, up five from 2007. The men garnered 13 recipients, up four from the previous season.

## BIG TEN ANNOUNCES 2008 INDIVIDUAL POSTSEASON HONORS

Michigan's **Adam Harris** was named the Big Ten men's Track Athlete of the Year and of the Championships while Purdue's **Billy Hardcastle** was named the Field Athlete of the Year and of the Championships. On the women's side, Penn State's **Shana Cox** was named the Track Athlete of the Year and of the Championships, while Purdue's **Kara Patterson** was named Field Athlete of the Year and of the Championships, the Big Ten office announced on Wednesday.

**Ron Warhurst** of Michigan was named the men's coach of the year for the first time in his career, while Penn State mentor **Beth Alford-Sullivan** received the women's honor for the first time in her career.

Rounding out the postseason awards, Hardcastle was named the men's Freshman of the Year, and Michigan's **Emily Pendleton** earned the women's first-year honors.

Harris becomes the Wolverines' first Track and Field Athlete of the Year and Championships since 1998 (Kevin Sullivan and John Mortimer, respectively). The junior sprinter paced his Michigan squad to its first team title since 1983, racking up 26.5 individual points. His two first-place finishes came in the 200-meter dash (20.75) and the 400-meter relay (40.26), while also placing third in the 100 meters (10.36). Harris show-cased his versatility by placing second in the long jump with a distance of 25-4.75 (7.74).

Hardcastle becomes Purdue's first Athlete of the Year since the award's inception in 1988. The newcomer swept both of his events at the 2008 Big Ten Outdoor Championships, taking home gold in the discus and shot put. His discus toss of 187.50 (57.13) bettered the conference field by almost four meters and his shot put throw of 61-10.25 (18.85) ranks 13th in the country. Hardcastle also becomes the second-consecutive Boilermaker thrower to garner Big Ten Freshman of the Year accolades as teammate Jon Pullum was honored in 2007.

Cox now has two Athlete of the Championships laurels as she won the award in 2006. She posted three first-place finishes at this year's championships guiding the Nittany Lion squad to their first team title in school history. Her winning 400-meter dash time of 52.0 currently ranks as the fourth-fastest time in the country and her first-place 200 performance of 23.15 ranks third in the East Regional. The senior sprinter also ran a leg of Penn State's gold medal 1600-meter relay team (3:36.24) and the runner-up 400-meter relay squad (44.97).

Patterson had arguably the most impressive performance at the 2008 Championships with her American-leading javelin throw of 202-00 (61.56). The junior smashed both the Purdue and Big Ten Championships records and nearly missed the NCAA record of 61.82 meters. Her toss is the second-longest throw in U.S. history and in the NCAA. She bettered the 'A' standard for the Beijing Olympics and currently holds the world's ninth-best throw.

Pendleton becomes just the second Wolverine to garner the Big Ten Freshman of the Year award and the first since Carly Knazze in 2000. Pendleton stood atop the podium at this year's championships winning the discus with a throw of 171.5 (52.26). She provided 11 total points in Michigan's second-place championships finish.

The conference office also announced honorees from each team for the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award. The student-athletes chosen are individuals who have distinguished themselves through sportsmanship and ethical behavior. In addition, the student-athletes must be in good academic standing and have demonstrated good citizenship outside of the sports-competition setting.

Honorees for men's and women's outdoor track and field are Illinois' **Gakologelwang Masheto** and **Tiara Armstrong**; Indiana's **Kyle Jenkins** and **Yndal Carr**; Iowa's **Shane Maier** and **Caleigh Bacchus**; Michigan's **Grant Till** and **Bettie Wade**; Michigan State's **Kevin Dacres** and **Paris Mandy**; Minnesota's **Ibrahim Kabia** and **Liz Podominick**; Ohio State's **Leonard Jatsek** and **Colleen Farrell**; Penn State's **Ryan Taylor** and **Heidi Nadeau**; Purdue's **Brain Kaluf** and **Lauren Scott**; and Wisconsin's **Peter Dykstra** and **Jessica Stoltenberg**. These 20 student-athletes are now candidates for the Big Ten Sportsmanship Award, as the conference office will honor one male and one female student-athlete from each institution at the end of the school year.
