2007-08 BIG TEN WRESTLING SEASON IN REVIEW

Iowa won its 21st National Title as the Big Ten dominated the 2008 NCAA Wrestling Championships. Ohio State was runner-up and Penn State took home third place to round out the top three spots for a conference sweep. It is the first time since 1968 that three teams from the same conference have garnered the top three spots in the event. Michigan finished tied for seventh and Minnesota placed 10th to round out the top 10.

Individually, the Big Ten took home seven of 10 national crowns. 2008 national champions include Indiana's Angel Escobedo (125 lbs.), Iowa's Brent Metcalf (149 lbs.) and Mark Perry (165 lbs.), Ohio State's J Jagers (141 lbs.) and Mike Pucillo (184 lbs.), Northwestern's Dustin Fox (285 lbs.) and Penn State's Phil Davis (197 lbs.). Along with these seven, Illinois' Mike Poeta, Iowa's Joey Slaton, Michigan's Steve Luke and Eric Tannenbaum, Minnesota's Jayson Ness, Ohio State's J.D. Bergman and Penn State's Bubba Jenkins all placed second in their respective weight classes. With that, the Big Ten had at least one representative in the finals of each weight class totaling 14 finalists.

Of the 72 Big Ten competitors in the Championships, 32 earned All-America honors, accounting for 44 percent of Big Ten participants and totaling one more than a year ago.

IOWA CLAIMS BIG TEN TITLE

Top-ranked Iowa came back with a strong performance to win its 32nd Big Ten Championships on March 9 at Williams Arena. The Hawkeyes, who entered the day 12.5 points behind reigning national champ Minnesota, scored 127 points to surpass the Gophers, who tallied 112.5.

After the event, the conference announced the All-Conference team and individual award winners.

The Hawkeyes took home three of the four individual honors with Brent Metcalf being voted as Big Ten Wrestler of the Year and Wrestler of the Championships. Iowa head

coach Tom Brands was selected as Coach of the Year. Rounding out the individual awards was Michigan's Kellen Russell as Freshman of the Year.

The 2008 All-Big Ten Team was also named with the members consisting of champions in each weight class. Michigan had the most honorees with three All-Big Ten selections. The Wolverines were represented by Steve Luke (174), Russell (141) and Eric Tannenbaum (165). The rest of the team consists of Illinois' Mike Poeta (157), Indiana's Angel Escobedo (125), Iowa's Metcalf (149), Michigan State's Franklin Gomez (133), Northwestern's Dustin Fox (Hwt.), Ohio State's Mike Pucillo (184) and Penn State's Phil Davis (197).
