Four Named to Naismith Watch List

Four Big Ten women's basketball players were named to the Naismith Trophy early season watch list, the Atlanta Tipoff Club announced on Friday. Illinois' Jenna Smith, Michigan State's Allyssa DeHaan, Northwestern's Amy Jaeschke and Ohio State's Jantel Lavender are among the 50-member list currently in the running for one of college basketball's most prestigious awards. Jaeschke and Lavender are two of just eight sophomores to make the cut.

And They're Off

Big Ten conference play began on Saturday night as Indiana defeated Northwestern in Bloomington. Intraconference play continued on Sunday and Monday with all teams except Minnesota having played one conference contest. The Golden Gophers open their Big Ten slate on Monday at Wisconsin in a game that will be televised live by the Big Ten Network.

Double Dipping

Ohio State sophomore Jantel Lavender racked up two more 20-point games last week, scoring 29 against Delaware State on Tuesday before netting 28 versus Michigan on Sunday. Lavender has registered 20 or more points in 10 of OSU's 12 games this season and has scored in double digits in each of her 43 career games. With 11 double-doubles this season, Lavender boasts 24 in her career, which places her second among active Big Ten players. Only Indiana senior Whitney Thomas has more (26), while Illinois junior Jenna Smith also has 24 in her career.

Re-Writing History

Ohio State sophomore Jantel Lavender earned her seventh career Player of the Week award on Tuesday, tying her for fifth all-time in the conference records books. Kelly Mazzante of Penn State (2001-04) is the only other Big Ten player to earn seven Player of the Week selections in her freshman and sophomore seasons. Mazzante needed 26 weeks to accomplish the feat, while Lavender reached the mark in 23.

Still Streaking

Indiana boasts the conference's longest active winning streak at seven games. The Hoosiers closed out their non-conference schedule by rattling off six consecutive victories before downing Northwestern, 81-57, on Saturday in the Big Ten opener. The streak is tied for 11th-longest active streak in the NCAA this year and is the program's longest since the 2000-01 season.

Home Sweet Home

Big Ten teams are a combined 50-14 on their home courts, which amounts to a .781 winning percentage. Eight conference teams have either zero or one loss at home, including Iowa and Michigan State who are both undefeated on their home courts with 5-0 records. Ohio State is the winningest Big Ten team at home, owning nine home-court victories.

Milestone Tracker

With eight rebounds against Northwestern on Saturday, Indiana's **Whitney Thomas** upped her career boards total to 905 and is less than 100 rebounds shy of becoming the 10th member of the Big Ten's 1,000 career rebounds club. Thomas would be the second Hoosier on the list, trailing the conference's all-time rebounds leader, Denise Jackson, who grabbed 1,263 boards from 1981-84.

Wisdom-Hylton Steals a Place in Records Book

Purdue's **Lindsay Wisdom-Hylton** recorded four steals in the Boilermakers' win over Illinois on Monday, becoming the 29th member of the Big Ten's 250-steals club. Wisdom-Hylton is the seventh Boilermaker in the club and is the Big Ten's career leader in steals among active players with 251. Wisdom-Hylton's teammate **FahKara Malone** is second in steals among active players with 225.

DeHaan Swats Away the Competition

Michigan State junior **Allyssa DeHaan** owns 341 career blocks, ranking third in the Big Ten records book. The 6-9 center needs 26 more swats to move into a tie for second place and 43 to tie current conference leader Jessica Davenport who blocked 384 shots from 2004-07. DeHaan leads the Big Ten and ranks third in the NCAA with 3.83 blocks per game. At her current pace, she will need 12 games to break the conference record. If her trend holds up, she will break the Big Ten mark while playing against the alma mater of the current record holder, versus Ohio State on Feb. 8.

Double Trouble

Illinois' **Jenna Smith**, Ohio State's **Jantel Lavender** and Penn State's **Tyra Grant** are the only three Big Ten players to have scored in double digits in every game this year. The trio also represent the top three scorers in the conference this season as Lavender fronts the pack with 22.8 points per game, followed by Grant (19.5 ppg) and Smith (18.2).

Coming to a TV Near You

Big Ten women's basketball teams will experience a record amount of exposure with 119 games set to be broadcast nationally during the regular season. The Big Ten Network will air 55 games on its linear channel and an additional 56 contests on BigTenNetwork.com. All internet games will be streamed live and free of charge. During the 2008-09 season, Big Ten women's basketball can also be found on CBS Sports, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU. In addition, for the second time in history, all 10 games of the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament will reach a live national audience. The Big Ten Network is set to broadcast the first nine games of the event, while ESPN2 will cover the championship game.

Big Ten Tournament Returns to Indy

The conference will once again return to Indianapolis for the 2009 Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament. 2009 marks the second of a five-year agreement that places both the men's and women's tournaments in the Circle City. This year's tournament will be the eighth straight and 14th overall in Indianapolis and will be held on four consecutive days, March 5-8.

More than Just a Game

The 2009 Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament will feature more than just exciting on-court action. Events surrounding the tournament include the annual girls' basketball youth clinic, fan pep rallies and the Big Ten's annual event to promote and support cancer awareness, held during the semifinal games. Following last year's event, the Big Ten donated over \$10,000 to the Indianapolis affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

Three Big Ten Teams to Host NCAA Action

Iowa's Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Michigan State's Breslin Center and Ohio State's Nationwide Arena will serve as three of the 16 host sites for the first and second rounds of the 2009 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship, held March 21-24, 2009. Columbus, Ohio, will welcome four teams on March 21 and 23, while Iowa City, Iowa, and East Lansing, Mich., will host four teams each on March 22 and 24.

Big Ten Begins March to the Arch in 2009

Big Ten women's basketball will march toward the Arch during the 2008-09 season as the 2009 NCAA Women's Final Four will be held April 5 and 7 at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis. The conference has sent five teams to the past 10 Final Fours, including two in the last five seasons. The 2009 championship event is hosted by the Missouri Valley Conference.

Get to Know Her

The Big Ten announced its latest public service effort for women's basketball at Basketball Media Day on Oct. 26. The *Get to Know Her* campaign is a fully integrated effort that allows fans to see the non-basketball sides of their favorite student-athletes via multimedia tools and on-campus functions. The *Get to Know Her* campaign is funded in-part by the NCAA as part of a grant program that is designed to foster the growth of women's basketball on NCAA member campuses and within NCAA member conferences.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK



Jantel Lavender, Ohio State So., C, 6-4, Cleveland, Ohio/Central Catholic

Lavender earns her third Player of the Week honor this season and the seventh of her career after

leading the Buckeyes to a pair of wins last week. Against Delaware State on Tuesday, the sophomore put up 29 points on 12-of-13 (.923) shooting with 11 rebounds and four blocks as OSU rolled to a 68-35 win. In Ohio State's Big Ten opener against Michigan on Sunday, the 6-4 center netted 28 points, going 13-of-19 (.684) from the floor, grabbing eight boards and blocking one shot in a 70-50 win. For the week, Lavender averaged 28.5 points on .781 shooting with 9.5 rebounds and 1.5 blocks. With seven career Player of the Week honors, Lavender is now tied for fifth all-time in the conference records book.

Veteran McKeown Joins Crop of Young Coaches

When Joe McKeown signed on to become the sixth head coach in Northwestern women's basketball history, he joined a group of conference coaches that has spent an average of three years at their respective institutions. Among the group of 11 mentors, seven have been at their schools less than three years, and five have been at their institution for one year or less. Iowa's Lisa Bluder is the dean of the Big Ten coaches with eight years at the helm of the Hawkeye program. Big Ten Mentors Reaching Major Milestones

Several Big Ten head coaches achieved major milestones in 2007-08, including Ohio State's Jim Foster who became just the 13th coach in NCAA Division I history to reach 650 career wins on Jan. 28. On Feb. 10, Iowa's Lisa Bluder became the third active Big Ten coach to reach 500 career wins, joining Foster and Michigan's Kevin Borseth. Minnesota's Pam Borton became the sixth active conference mentor to reach 200 career victories on Feb. 28, joining Bluder, Borseth, Foster, Michigan State's Suzy Merchant and Wisconsin's Lisa Stone. Already during the 2008-09 campaign, Bluder won her 150th game at Iowa with a 83-58 win over Boston and Stone won her 450th career game with a 47-45 victory against Villanova.
