- Posted a record of 17-16 overall in 2006-07, 7-9 and tied for fifth (Wisconsin) in the Big Ten
- Minnesota was the second-youngest team in NCAA Division I women's basketball in 2006-07
- Minnesota advanced to the second round of the WNIT Tournament before losing to Western Kentucky
- Junior Emily Fox, an All-Big Ten Second Team selection, is the Gophers' leading returning scorer averaging 12.9 ppg. a year ago
- Fox was the Golden Gophers' leading scorer during the Big Ten season averaging 14.5 points per game. She finished among the top 10 in several Big Ten statistical categories, including scoring (10th), assists (3.88 apg. - 5th), steals (2.31 spg. - 5th) and free throw percentage (.848 - 10th).
- Fox is a member of the U.S. Pan American Games Team
- Brittany McCoy was named to the Big Ten's All-Freshman Team, the first Gopher rookie honored since Janel McCarville in 2002.
- McCoy was the first Minnesota freshman to collect over 100 assists in a season.
- Emily Fox (131 assists) and Brittany McCoy (105 assists) were the second duo in school history to dish out over 100 assists in the season since April Calhoun (121) and Janel McCarville (119) did it in the 2004-2005 season.
- Ashley Ellis-Milan and Korinne Campbell both finished with 105 offensive rebounds to tie for third in the Big Ten.
- In 2006-07, Minnesota's freshmen logged 54 percent of the minutes played as well as tallied 48 percent of the points scored.
- Landed five of eligible six players from the 2006-07 roster on the Academic All-Big Ten Team
- Minnesota finished 12th nationally and third in the Big Ten in attendance averaging 5,942 fans per game in 2006-07
