**GET TO KNOW HER**



**Ashlee Trebilcock, Ohio State**

**Still Streaking**

With a win at Michigan State on Monday, Indiana extended its winning streak to eight games, which is the longest active streak in the conference and is tied for the 10th longest active streak in the NCAA. The streak is the program's longest since the 1998-99 Hoosier squad won nine in a row.

**Legette-Jack Joins Century Club**

Indiana head coach Felisha Legette-Jack recorded her 100th career win as the Hoosiers defeated Michigan State, 62-48, on the road on Monday. Legette-Jack is in her seventh year as a head coach and her third season at Indiana and is one of nine Big Ten coaches with 100 or more career victories.

**Fast Starters**

Indiana and Purdue are both off to 2-0 starts in conference play. For the Hoosiers, the 2-0 start is the program's first since 2005-06 and the team's second in the last five years. It is the first 2-0 head start for Indiana under head coach Felisha Legette-Jack. Purdue jumps out to a 2-0 Big Ten start for the second time in three years and, for the first time since 2000-01, is 2-0 after playing its first two conference games on the road.

**Double Trouble**

Illinois juniors Jenna Smith and Lacey Simpson each recorded double-doubles in the Illini's close loss to Penn State on Sunday. Smith put down 23 points and grabbed 12 boards while Simpson netted 10 with 12 rebounds. Smith's double-double was her third this season and the 25th of her career, while Simpson's was the seventh in her career and her third this year. Overall this season, Smith and Simpson rank third and 12th, respectively, in the conference and scoring and eighth and seventh, respectively, in rebounding.

**BIG TEN. BIG NEWS.****Home Sweet Home**

Michigan's 66-54 win over Northwestern on Sunday marked the 200th victory for the Wolverine women's program in Crisler Arena. The team is now 200-210 all-time in the arena and 5-1 at home this year.

**Elite Company**

With a season-high 11 rebounds against Indiana on Monday, Michigan State junior **Allyssa DeHaan** became just the 10th Spartan in program history with 1,000 career points and 600 career rebounds. The 6-9 center owns a total of 1,069 career points, placing her eighth in the Big Ten among active players, and 606 rebounds, making her fourth in the conference among active players. DeHaan is also the career leader in blocked shots among active players with 343, placing her third all-time in the Big Ten.

**Within Striking Distance**

Several Big Ten players are within striking distance of major career milestones. Indiana's **Whitney Thomas** needs just seven points to become the 9th active conference player with 1,000 career points, while teammate **Kim Roberson** is just two swipes away from becoming the sixth active player with 200 or more steals. Illinois' **Lacey Simpson** needs just two boards to become the seventh active player with 500 career rebounds, and Penn State's **Brianne O'Rourke** needs just 10 helpers to become the only active member of the 500 career assists club. O'Rourke would become just the 22nd all-time member of the 500 career assists club and the fourth Lady Lion on the list.

**Cardiac Kids**

Illinois leads the Big Ten in close games, having played in five contests decided by five points or less. The Illini are 2-3 in those games, while 38 percent of the Orange and Blue's games have been decided by two or fewer possessions. Overall, just 17 percent of all games played by Big Ten teams have been decided by five points or less. Wisconsin owns the best record in those games at 3-0, while Minnesota and Purdue have yet to play in a game that close.

**Four Named to Naismith Watch List**

Four Big Ten women's basketball players were named to the Naismith Trophy early season watch list, the Atlanta Tipoff Club announced on Dec. 19. Illinois' **Jenna Smith**, Michigan State's **Allyssa DeHaan**, Northwestern's **Amy Jaeschke** and Ohio State's **Jantel Lavender** are among the 50-member list currently in the running for one of college basketball's most prestigious awards. Jaeschke and Lavender are two of just eight sophomores to make the cut.

**Coming to a TV Near You**

Big Ten women's basketball teams will experience a record amount of exposure with 119 games set to be broadcast nationally during the regular season. The Big Ten Network will air 55 games on its linear channel and an additional 56 contests on BigTenNetwork.com. All internet games will be streamed live and free of charge. During the 2008-09 season, Big Ten women's basketball can also be found on CBS Sports, ESPN, ESPN2 and ESPNU. In addition, for the second time in history, all 10 games of the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament will reach a live national audience. The Big Ten Network is set to broadcast the first nine games of the event, while ESPN2 will cover the championship game.

**Big Ten Tournament Returns to Indy**

The conference will once again return to Indianapolis for the 2009 Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament. 2009 marks the second of a five-year agreement that places both the men's and women's tournaments in the Circle City. This year's tournament will be the eighth straight and 14th overall in Indianapolis and will be held on four consecutive days, March 5-8.

**More than Just a Game**

The 2009 Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament will feature more than just exciting on-court action. Events surrounding the tournament include the annual girls' basketball youth clinic, fan pep rallies and the Big Ten's annual event to promote and support cancer awareness, held during the semifinal games. Following last year's event, the Big Ten donated over \$10,000 to the Indianapolis affiliate of Susan G. Komen for the Cure.

**Three Big Ten Teams to Host NCAA Action**

Iowa's Carver-Hawkeye Arena, Michigan State's Breslin Center and Ohio State's Nationwide Arena will serve as three of the 16 host sites for the first and second rounds of the 2009 NCAA Women's Basketball Championship, held March 21-24, 2009. Columbus, Ohio, will welcome four teams on March 21 and 23, while Iowa City, Iowa, and East Lansing, Mich., will host four teams each on March 22 and 24.

**Big Ten Begins March to the Arch in 2009**

Big Ten women's basketball will march toward the Arch during the 2008-09 season as the 2009 NCAA Women's Final Four will be held April 5 and 7 at the Scottrade Center in St. Louis. The conference has sent five teams to the past 10 Final Fours, including two in the last five seasons. The 2009 championship event is hosted by the Missouri Valley Conference.

**Get to Know Her**

The Big Ten announced its latest public service effort for women's basketball at Basketball Media Day on Oct. 26. The *Get to Know Her* campaign is a fully integrated effort that allows fans to see the non-basketball sides of their favorite student-athletes via multimedia tools and on-campus functions. The *Get to Know Her* campaign is funded in-part by the NCAA as part of a grant program that is designed to foster the growth of women's basketball on NCAA member campuses and within NCAA member conferences.

**PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

**Danielle Campbell, Purdue Sr., C, 6-4, Chicago, Ill./Whitney Young**

Campbell earns Player of the Week honors after leading Purdue to a 69-60 win at Iowa on Sunday. The senior netted 15 points and grabbed 12 rebounds to record her second double-double of the season and the eighth of her career. The 6-4 center was 6-of-11 (54.5 percent) from the field and was a perfect 3-for-3 at the free-throw line. The Chicago native also dished out two assists and swatted away two shots as the Boilermakers defeated the 2008 Big Ten Co-Champion Hawkeyes. The weekly award is the first of Campbell's career and the third for Purdue this season.

**Veteran McKeown Joins Crop of Young Coaches**

When Joe McKeown signed on to become the sixth head coach in Northwestern women's basketball history, he joined a group of conference coaches that has spent an average of three years at their respective institutions. Among the group of 11 mentors, seven have been at their schools less than three years, and five have been at their institution for one year or less. Iowa's Lisa Bluder is the dean of the Big Ten coaches with eight years at the helm of the Hawkeye program. **Big Ten Mentors Reaching Major Milestones**

Several Big Ten head coaches achieved major milestones in 2007-08, including Ohio State's Jim Foster who became just the 13th coach in NCAA Division I history to reach 650 career wins on Jan. 28. On Feb. 10, Iowa's Lisa Bluder became the third active Big Ten coach to reach 500 career wins, joining Foster and Michigan's Kevin Borseth. Minnesota's Pam Borton became the sixth active conference mentor to reach 200 career victories on Feb. 28, joining Bluder, Borseth, Foster, Michigan State's Suzy Merchant and Wisconsin's Lisa Stone. Already during the 2008-09 campaign, Bluder won her 150th game at Iowa with a 83-58 win over Boston, Stone won her 450th career game with a 47-45 victory against Villanova, and Indiana's Felisha Legette-Jack won her 100th career game at Michigan State in a 62-48 decision.
