BIG TEN PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Whitney Thomas, IND
Jr, F, 6-0, Bloomington, Ind./North

Thomas earns her first career Player of the Week award after leading Indiana to wins over Purdue, Minnesota and Michigan State last week. The junior posted double-doubles in each contest, giving her seven on the season and 17 in her career. Against the Boilermakers on Monday, Thomas netted 17 points with 18 rebounds, adding three blocked shots and two steals to give the Hoosiers the 12-point road victory. Thomas led IU to a double-overtime win against Minnesota on Thursday with 12 points, 17 boards and a block as the Hoosiers climbed to second place in the conference standings. The junior wrapped up the week with an 11-point, 12-rebound performance against the Spartans on Sunday, also adding five steals and four assists. On the week, Thomas averaged 13.3 points, 15.7 boards, 2.3 steals, 1.3 assists and 1.3 blocks per game. She also eclipsed the 700 career rebounds mark, tallying 47 over the course of three games.

BIG TEN NEWS & NOTES

Big Ten on TV

Five women's basketball contests will be featured on the Big Ten Network this week, including three matchups on Sunday. Coverage began on Monday as Iowa defeated Illinois. Televised action continues on Thursday when conference-leading Ohio State travels to Minnesota to take on the Golden Gophers at 7 p.m. CT. The week's action concludes on Sunday as Minnesota hosts Michigan State at Noon CT, Iowa welcomes Michigan at 2 p.m. CT and Northwestern travels to Wisconsin for a 4:30 p.m. CT tip.

Big Ten Mentors On Track For Coaching Records

Ohio State head coach Jim Foster picked up his 649th career victory with the Buckeyes' 79-74 win against Wisconsin on Sunday. Foster is just one win shy of becoming the 13th head coach in Division I history to reach the 650 career wins mark. Foster will join Vivian Stringer (Iowa, 1984-95), Rene Portland (Penn State, 1981-07), Tara VanDerveer (Ohio State, 1981-85) and Theresa Greutz (Illinois, 1996-07) as coaches with 650 or more career wins that have spent time on a Big Ten campus. Iowa's Lisa Bluder is just six wins shy of 500 career victories. Bluder would become the third active Big Ten head coach in the 500 wins club, joining Foster and Michigan's Kevin Borseth.

Packing the House

Big Ten teams are drawing some of the largest crowds in the nation, with five teams in the top 20 of average national attendance, according to a weekly unofficial report issued by the University of Wisconsin. Purdue ranks fourth with an average of 9,534 fans per contest, while Michigan State is 10th (6,902), Minnesota is 14th (5,717), Wisconsin is 15th (5,408) and Penn State is 19th (4,911). Purdue welcomed the largest Big Ten crowd of the season on Sunday when 12,592 fans packed Mackey Arena to see the Boilermakers take on Northwestern.

Underclassmen are Overachievers

Freshmen and sophomores are at or near the top in several statistical categories including rebounds, blocks and steals per game. Ohio State freshman Jantel Lavender leads the conference with 10.3 boards per contest, while Illinois sophomore Jenna Smith is second at 10.0. Smith is also second in scoring with 18.4 points per contest and first with a .561 field-goal percentage. Michigan State sophomore Allyssa DeHaan is first in the conference and second in the nation with 4.40 blocks per game. Ohio State sophomore Shavelle Little leads the conference with 3.06 steals per game, while Illinois sophomore Lacey Simpson is second with 2.672 swipes per contest.

BIG TEN NEWS & NOTES

No Place Like Home

Big Ten teams have combined to go 24-15 (.615) at home in conference competition. Two teams are undefeated on their home courts in Big Ten games as **Ohio State** is 4-0, and **Michigan** is 3-0. Six other squads -- **Indiana**, **Purdue**, **Minnesota**, **Penn State**, **Iowa** and **Illinois** -- have just one home loss in Big Ten competition.

OSU's Packer Joins Elite Company

Ohio State's **Marscilla Packer** became just the third player in Buckeye history to reach 1,000 career points and 200 career three-pointers last week. The senior also became just the fourth Big Ten player this season to score 30 points in a game when she tied her career high with 32 against Wisconsin on Sunday, including a season-high six three-pointers. Packer joins Penn State's **Kamela Gissendanner** and Wisconsin's **Jolene Anderson** and **Janese Banks** as the only active conference players with 1,000 or more career points. She also joins Anderson, Illinois' **Jenna Smith** and Minnesota's **Emily Fox** as the only players to have scored 30 or more points in at least one game this season.

Double Trouble

Ohio State freshman **Jantel Lavender** leads the Big Ten with 10 double-doubles this season and has also scored in double digits in each of her 18 career games. Lavender and Illinois' **Jenna Smith** are the only two players averaging double-doubles in overall action as Lavender puts up 16.5 points and 10.3 rebounds per game, while Smith contributes 18.4 points and 10.0 boards per contest. In conference action, Lavender averages 15.1 points and 10.9 boards per game and is joined by Indiana's **Whitney Thomas** as the only other player averaging a double-double in Big Ten action (12.6 points, 11.3 rebounds). Thomas is tied with Lavender for most double-doubles in conference play with four.

IU's Braun Making a Buzz

Indiana sophomore **Jamie Braun** is one of 23 players listed as "Making a Buzz" and in contention for the 2008 Nancy Lieberman Award. The award is a project of the Rotary Club of Detroit which honors the women's college basketball point guard of the year. Braun is averaging 14.6 points, 6.3 rebounds and 3.58 assists per game overall, and 16.3 points, 5.7 rebounds and 3.71 assists in Big Ten play.

Movin' On Up

Wisconsin senior **Jolene Anderson** became the 12th player in Big Ten history to crack the 2,000 career points mark last week, and is continuing to climb the conference's all-time scoring list. The senior is currently 11th with 2,052 tallies to her name and is 37 points away from cracking the Big Ten's top 10 list.

Triple Threat

Illinois junior **Lori Bjork** has made four three-pointers in back-to-back games and is in sole possession of second place on Illinois' career three-point field goals list with 176. Bjork is 18 treys shy of tying the Illini record of 194, which was set by **Krista Reinking**. Bjork is 50 threes away from cracking the Big Ten's top 10 list for three-pointers made in a career.

Purdue Thinks Pink

Purdue will "Think Pink" on Sunday as it hosts Illinois at 2 p.m. The Boilermakers are one of several Big Ten squads and one of over 600 teams in the nation participating in the initiative sponsored by the Women's Basketball Coaches Association in an effort to raise money and awareness for breast cancer research. Other Big Ten "Think Pink" events will be held in February.

More Television Coverage Than Ever

Big Ten women's basketball will enjoy more television coverage than ever before with 65 regular-season games scheduled to air on CBS, the Big Ten Network, ESPN2, ESPNU, ESPN360.com and FSN this season. The conference's 11 teams will enjoy twice as much national television exposure than any other conference in the nation.

The Big Ten Network will carry 55 regular-season women's basketball games and nine contests in the Women's Basketball Tournament. A total of 11 games will be broadcast nationally on CBS, ESPN2, ESPNU, ESPN360.com and FSN, including the Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament championship game, set to air on ESPN2.

Big Ten Standouts Candidates for National Awards

Wisconsin's **Jolene Anderson**, Ohio State's **Marscilla Packer** and Michigan State's **Allyssa DeHaan** are each candidates for the State Farm Wade Trophy Player of the Year Award and have all been recognized with spots on the Wooden Award watch list. The Wade Trophy is awarded to the player who best embodies the spirit of Margaret Wade according to the following criteria: game and season statistics, leadership, character, effect on their team and overall playing ability. The Wooden Award honors the most outstanding female basketball player in the nation. Northwestern's **Sara Stutz** is a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which recognizes an individual based on personal qualities that define a complete student-athlete, emphasizing classroom, character and community.

Big Ten Tournament Returns To Circle City

The Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament will remain in Indianapolis in 2008, marking the seventh consecutive season the event has been held in the Circle City. The Big Ten men's and women's tournaments will be held in Indianapolis for five years beginning this season. New to this year's women's bracket is the addition of Saturday competition. The 2008 Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament Presented by Xbox 360 Live will be played on four consecutive days for the first time since 2001 when the tournament was held in Grand Rapids, Mich.

All-session tickets for the 2008 Big Ten Women's Basketball Tournament presented by Xbox 360 Live are on sale now. All-session tickets are \$65 and are available at all 11 university ticket offices, the Conesco Fieldhouse box office, Ticketmaster outlets, www.ticketmaster.com, or by calling Ticketmaster at (317) 239-5151.

Mackey Arena to Host NCAA Competition

An Elite Eight participant in the 2007 NCAA Tournament, **Purdue** looks to replicate its postseason success on its home court this year, as Mackey Arena (14,123) has been selected to host NCAA First- and Second-Round action. The Boilermakers will welcome eight teams to West Lafayette on March 23 and 25.

Big Ten Aims for Fun in the Sun at Final Four in Tampa

The Big Ten has sent five teams to the past nine Final Fours, including two in the last four seasons, and hopes to add to that total in 2008. This season, the conference has its eyes set on sunny skies and clear blue water as the 2008 NCAA Women's Final four will be held in Tampa Bay, Fla. The championship event will be played April 6 and 8 at the St. Pete Times Forum (21,497). The University of South Florida will serve as the event's host.
