2009 NCAA CHAMPIONSHIPS PREVIEW

Six teams will represent the Big Ten Conference in the 2009 NCAA Softball Championship with regional play beginning on Thursday, May 14, and continuing through the evening of Sunday, May 17. Illinois, Iowa, Michigan, Northwestern, Ohio State and Purdue were selected to compete in the 64-team field.

Illinois will travel to Columbia, Mo., to begin NCAA Tournament competition against host No. 12-ranked Missouri on Friday, May 15. The Illini are returning to the NCAA Championship for the first time since 2004, marking the team's third post-season berth in program history. In their last appearance, the Orange and Blue advanced to the Super Regionals. Illinois finished the regular season with a 29-15 overall record and went 12-7 in conference action. The Illini will look to halt the momentum of the Missouri Tigers, who are coming off an upset over No. 9 Oklahoma to capture the Big 12 Tournament title. The winner of the nightcap will face the victor of the DePaul vs. Bradley matchup.

The Iowa Hawkeyes have Georgia on their mind as they head to the Atlanta Regional to begin first-round action on Friday against Auburn, slated for a 4 p.m. (CT) first pitch. This marks the ninth NCAA Championship appearance in the last 10 seasons for the Hawkeyes, and their 16th trip overall. Iowa is currently 31-31 in NCAA action, and 26-23 in regional contests. The Hawkeyes completed the 2009 campaign fourth in the Big Ten standings, compiling a 42-14 overall record. Friday will mark the first clash between Iowa and Auburn in NCAA Tournament play, and the first meeting between the two teams since 2005 when the Hawkeyes split the series with the Tigers. Georgia Tech and Boston will follow the afternoon contest, with Friday's winning teams scheduled to face off at Noon Saturday.

The No. 7-ranked Michigan Wolverines earned the No. 5 overall seed in this year's championship and will play host for the eighth straight season at the Wilton Softball Complex. The Wolverines (41-10, 17-3) will double three conference tournament champions in No. 25 Notre Dame, Cleveland State, and Miami (Ohio) in the double-elimination event. The 2009 Big Ten Champion will open regional action against Miami on Friday at 7 p.m. Michigan owns a near-perfect 8-1 record in the all-time series against Miami (32-22), with the last meeting coming at the 2008 Louisville Classic when the Wolverines topped the RedHawks, 12-0, in five innings. U-M is making its 15th straight appearance in the NCAA Championship and its 16th in program history. Last season, the Wolverines earned three straight victories en route to their fourth consecutive Super Regional showing.

Northwestern will travel to the Lone Star State to square off against Texas State in its opening contest at 5 p.m. (CT) Friday. The two teams will join Louisiana-Lafayette and host Baylor in the Waco Regional. The No. 13-ranked Wildcats enter their seventh straight and 12th overall appearance as the No. 12 overall seed in the NCAA Championship. NU continues to uphold its strong championship history, earning a seed in every season since the tournament went to the current 16-team Regional format in 2005. The Wildcats currently hold a 25-15 record in their six previous NCAA appearances. Northwestern finished the regular season with a 31-13 overall record.

The 11-seeded Ohio State Buckeyes welcome the NCAA Championship back to Columbus for the second time in three years this weekend and will host Canisius, BYU and Kentucky in regional action. OSU is making its sixth appearance in the NCAA Championship and is currently 7-10 at the regional level. The Buckeyes (44-9, 16-4) will look to capture their first trip to a Super Regional as they begin play against the Golden Griffins (26-23) on Thursday.

Purdue (29-18, 12-8) is making its second straight NCAA Regional appearance after posting its best conference mark since 1997 and finishing sixth in Big Ten play. The Boilermakers will travel to Louisville, Ky., to face off against No. 19 Louisville on Friday. The two squads will be joined by UT-Martin and No. 6 Arizona, to complete the four-team regional lineup. The Boilermaker squad, which returns 14 letterwinners from the 2008 team that earned the first NCAA berth and victory in program history, posted four wins over top-25 foes in 2009 and faced off against 12 members of the NCAA field.

The regional winners will advance to Super Regional competition for a best-of-three series May 21-24 at eight campus sites.

Player of the Week

Candace Curtis | Purdue
Sr. | 3B | Danville, Calif. | Carondelet

Candace Curtis posted a .556 average with five hits, including three doubles, and had a hand in eight of Purdue's 10 runs in its sweep of Indiana on Saturday. Curtis posted six RBI and two runs, while boasting a .889 slugging percentage and a .556 on-base percentage. In Game 1 vs. the Hoosiers, Curtis went 2-for-4 and drove in both of the Boilermakers' runs. A sixth-inning double put Purdue on the board, and then an eighth-inning single plated the game winner. In the 8-7 Game 2 victory, the Danville, Calif., native went 3-for-5 with four RBI and the game-winning run. Curtis put two on the board with a first-inning double, and then tacked on two more RBI with a second-inning single. With the game on the line in the eighth, Curtis capped her final regular season game with a lead-off double before coming home to seal the victory. This is the first weekly laurel of her career.

Senior Brittany Weil spent the week tearing apart the Iowa record books. She tossed her fifth no-hitter of the season in Game 1 against Wisconsin, breaking Iowa's career record for most hitless games in a career. She took a perfect game into the fifth with the Hawkeyes leading 8-0, but committed a throwing error with one out in the inning. She managed to get the final two outs after a 45-minute rain delay to secure the no-hitter. On "Senior Day" at Pearl Field, Weil shattered Iowa's single-season strikeout record, along with tying the Iowa career record for wins (99), complete games (109) and games pitched (181). In the series versus Minnesota, Weil fanned 20 batters Saturday to set the new single-season mark at 328. The Garden Grove, Calif., native threw 14-straight innings of shutout ball against the Golden Gophers. In Game 1, Weil broke the single-season strikeout mark at Iowa, recording 11 K's and giving up only five hits. In Game 2, Weil had a no-hitter heading into the seventh, but Minnesota managed to break it up with a single. She tossed another complete game, allowing just two hits with only one walk and 11 strikeouts. For the week, Weil went 4-0 with complete game shutouts and a 0.30 ERA. She threw 23.2 innings and struck out 32 of the 51 batters she faced. This is the fourth honor of the season for Weil and ninth of her career.
