2009 NCAA WOMEN'S COLLEGE WORLD SERIES PREVIEW

Michigan earned the right to compete in the Women's College World Series for the ninth time in program history. The Wolverines topped Baylor, 8-1 and 7-1, in NCAA Super Regionals last week to advance to the WCWS for the first time since 2005 when they captured the NCAA crown. U-M's nine WCWS appearances ranks fifth among all Division I programs. Ohio State also battled in Super Regional play, but fell at Georgia by scores of 6-4 and 7-6.

The Wolverines open action in the tournament's third game vs. No. 4 seed Alabama on Thursday, May 28, at 6 p.m. CT on ESPN with a simultaneous broadcast on ESPN360.com. Michigan's half of the double-elimination bracket consists of No.1 seed Florida and No. 9 seed Arizona, which face off in Game 4 on Thursday at 8 p.m. CT. The winner of that four-team bracket moves on to the best-of-three championship series versus the survivor of the other half of the bracket beginning Monday, June 1. The four other squads comprising the eight-team championship are No. 10 seed Arizona State, No. 6 Georgia, Missouri and No. 3 Washington.

DIAMOND NOTES

THE WOLVERINES VS. THE FIELD:

vs. Alabama: This will be the eighth meeting all-time between the two teams. U-M holds the series advantage, 4-3.

vs. Arizona: The Wildcats own the series advantage over the Wolverines, 4-9. U-M has shut out Arizona in its last two meetings, the most recent was a 4-0 triumph in March at the Judi Garman Classic.

vs. Arizona State: The all-time series between Michigan and Arizona State is tied at eight games apiece after U-M claimed a decisive 7-2 win over the Sun Devils earlier this season.

vs. Florida: Michigan is 8-2 in the all-time series against Florida. The Wolverines fell to the Gators earlier in the season, 4-0, in Gainesville.

vs. Georgia: Michigan is 4-1 in the all-time series against Georgia. The two teams have not met since a 4-2 U-M win in 2006.

vs. Missouri: The Tigers lead the all-time series, 3-2. The two teams last met in 2002 when Missouri claimed a 2-1 victory.

vs. Washington: The Cougars lead the all-time series, 8-7, after defeating U-M, 1-0, in this year's Judi Garman Classic.
