Harmotto helped the No. 3 Nittany Lions to two wins over No. 4 Texas over the weekend, posting a .535 hitting percentage in her team's two matches. The junior fell just shy of her career high in kills, putting up 15 on Friday to the tune of a .545 clip while also contributing a match-high six blocks. On Saturday, Harmotto tallied 13 kills on a .534 percentage with four blocks and two digs. For the weekend, Harmotto averaged 3.50 kills and 1.25 blocks per game. The award is the third weekly conference honor of Harmotto's career.

DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Stesha Selsky, Michigan Sr., LIB, Manhattan Beach, Calif./Marymount
A member of the ASICS Rainbow Wahine Invitational All-Tournament Team, Selsky helped the Wolverines to the event's title over the weekend, averaging 5.75 digs per game, including 24 vs. No. 10 Hawaii on Friday and 25 against Colorado State on Sunday. The senior also contributed four service aces in Michigan's 3-2 win over the Rainbow Wahine. This is Selsky's third career weekly defensive honor as she was also recognized during the first week of the 2006 season and once in 2005.

Anne Mastandrea, Purdue Sr., LIB, Downers Grove, Ill./South
Mastandrea receives her second career weekly honor after setting a school record for digs in a four-game match with a career-high 31 saves against Winthrop on Friday. With the performance, the senior became just the third Boilermaker in program history to post 30 or more digs twice in her career. On the weekend, Mastandrea posted 83 saves over 11 games for 7.55 digs-per-game average and is now just 10 away from reaching 1,000 in her career. The Downers Grove, Ill., native also converted on 96 percent of her service opportunities, including a perfect 30-for-30 mark against Winthrop.

Join the Club

Wisconsin senior **Taylor Reineke** became the 21st member of the Big Ten's 500 career blocks club with her first stuff of the season on Friday. Reineke totaled 12 blocks on the weekend and now has 511 in her career. Also on Friday, Penn State junior **Nicole Fawcett** became the 18th Nittany Lion to record 1,000 career kills, while Purdue senior **Samantha Mader** became the 18th Boilermaker to reach the same milestone on Saturday.

Fresh Faces

Several Big Ten newcomers had big impacts with their teams during the first weekend of the season, including Minnesota's **Brook Dieter**, who became the first Golden Gopher since 2001 to record double-figure kills in her debut with 18. Dieter also became just the third Gopher since 1985 to record a double-double as she contributed 14 digs in Minnesota's 3-0 win over Notre Dame. Also with stellar debuts, Illinois' **Laura DeBruler** notched 62 kills and 26 digs in three matches while **Johannah Bangert** recorded 24 kills and 15 blocks on the weekend. Iowa redshirt freshman **Becky Walters** put down 16 kills to the tune of a .412 hitting percentage against No. 17 BYU on Saturday.

Packing the House

Iowa's season opener against No. 17 BYU on Saturday marked the second-largest home crowd in the history of Hawkeye volleyball.

No Getting Past Mother Nature

Indiana's opening contest against Western Kentucky at the Northern Illinois Tournament was postponed as DeKalb, Ill., was declared a state of emergency due to flooding. When the Hoosiers began their season on Saturday, first-year head coach **Sherry Dunbar** won her first two matches at IU, breaking the school's 19-game losing streak that extended to last season.

Movin' On Up

Six Big Ten teams are ranked in the current edition of the CSTV/AVCA Top 25, including Michigan, who went from receiving votes last week to No. 20. The Wolverines made the jump on the strength of a 3-2 upset over then-No. 10 Hawaii, eventually winning the ASICS Rainbow Wahine Invitational. Also representing the conference are No. 3 Penn State, No. 9 Minnesota, No. 10 Wisconsin, No. 13 Ohio State and No. 17 Purdue.
