Christa Harmotto, Penn State
Jr., MH, Aliquippa, Pa./Hopewell
Harmotto earns the fifth conference honor of her career and her third of the season after leading Penn State to victories over Ohio State and No. 15 Michigan last week. Against the Buckeyes on Wednesday, the junior recorded 10 kills on 14 errorless swings to hit at a match-high .714 mark, also contributing eight blocks and three digs in the effort. The Aliquippa, Pa., native helped the Nittany Lions stay unbeaten in conference against the nationally ranked Wolverines on Friday, putting down 12 kills on .550 hitting with two service aces, four blocks and two digs. For the week, Harmotto averaged 3.7 kills per game on .618 hitting with two blocks per game.

Jocelyn Wack, Wisconsin
Sr., LIB, Salem, Wis./Westosha Central
Wack takes home the first weekly award of her career after helping the Badgers stay perfect in Big Ten play with road wins against No. 11 Minnesota and Iowa over the weekend. The senior broke an 18-year-old school record against the Gophers on Friday with 26 digs in a three-game match, helping Wisconsin to its first win in the Twin Cities since 2001. Against the Hawkeyes on Saturday, Wack posted a team-high 17 saves to finish the weekend with a 6.1 digs-per-game average. The Salem, Wis., native received serves at a .966 (56-of-58) percentage and also added six assists and a service ace on the weekend as the Badgers held their opponents to a combined .165 hitting average.

Big Ten on TV

Three conference matchups will be televised this week with two matches airing on the Big Ten Network and another appearing on ESPN2.

Wednesday's showdown between in-state rivals **Purdue** and **Indiana** will be broadcast live at 8 p.m. ET on the Big Ten Network. The appearance will be the Hoosiers' first, while the Boilermakers are 1-0 in Big Ten Network games.

ESPN2 will televise Friday's contest between **Ohio State** and **Wisconsin** in a broadcast that will air on Sunday at Noon ET.

The Badgers will once again reach a television audience as they face **Penn State** on Sunday in a match that will be aired on the Big Ten Network that day at 5 p.m. ET. Wisconsin is 2-0 in games on the Big Ten Network while Penn State is 1-0.

Badgers Off to Best Start Ever

At 16-1 overall, **Wisconsin** is off to the best start in the program's history. With an 8-0 mark in conference games, the Badgers are off to their second-best Big Ten start, bested only by the 2001 squad that opened the conference season at 11-0. Wisconsin has won its last 13 matches, which ties the longest streak in the Big Ten this season.

Fast Starts Nothing New to PSU

Penn State is out to an 8-0 conference start for the third straight season and the eighth time in the last 17 years. The Nittany Lions have swept all eight of those matches for a perfect 24-0 mark in conference games played. Over the last three seasons, Penn State has won 46 of its 48 Big Ten matches, amassing a .958 winning percentage.

NEWS & NOTES

Packing the House

Iowa drew its largest home crowd in program history on Saturday, bringing in 2,191 fans in a match against Wisconsin. Minnesota's attendance of 5,458 on Friday vs. the Badgers marked the second-largest volleyball attendance at the Sports Pavilion. The Big Ten boasts three of the nation's top 10 teams in terms of attendance and seven of the top 25. Both marks are the highest total for any conference in the nation.

Road Warriors

With wins at Iowa and No. 11 Minnesota over the weekend, Illinois recorded consecutive conference road victories for the first time since the 1992 season. The win over the Gophers marked Illinois' first road win over a top-15 team in five years as the Illini last defeated No. 6 Minnesota in five games in Minneapolis in 2002.

Big Ten in the Polls

For the second week in a row, the Big Ten is home to four of the top 15 teams in the nation. After spending eight weeks at No. 3, Penn State is up one spot to No. 2, while Wisconsin is also one place higher from a week ago in eighth. Minnesota dropped two spots from last week to 13th, and Michigan holds steady at No. 15 for the second straight week.
