Vineece Verdun joined the Spartans as a walk-on last season and due to an injury, was forced to redshirt during her freshman campaign. Showing perseverance and dedication to the game, Verdun has seen plenty of success in her first regular action with the Spartans in 2008. A political science/pre-law major, Verdun's success is not limited to the classroom. She has excelled on the court this season, averaging 1.52 kills per set while ranking third on the team in blocks. Verdun hit .341 with 64 kills during the Spartans 10-match winning streak earlier this season.

PSU Striking into NCAA Records Book

With a 3-0 win over Michigan State on Friday, Penn State won its 52nd consecutive match, tying the NCAA record set by USC from 2002-04. The Nittany Lions remain one of just two undefeated teams in NCAA Division I and are the only team that has not lost a single set. Dating back to last season, PSU has won its last 79 straight sets, ranking second all-time in NCAA history. The Lions have also won their last 39 consecutive Big Ten matches, which is the fourth-longest streak in conference annals. Penn State is looking to win its sixth consecutive Big Ten title and become the first team since the 1998-99 Nittany Lion squads to finish the conference season undefeated in back-to-back years.

Playing With Their Heads

Ten Big Ten volleyball players were honored with spots on the Academic All-District teams, presented by *ESPN The Magazine*, CoSIDA announced last week. Four student-athletes made the first team in their respective divisions, while five were honored on the second team and one on the third team. First-team honorees **Emily Hiza** of Iowa, **Christa Harmotto** and **Megan Hodge** of Penn State and **Kristen Arthers** of Purdue are now eligible for Academic All-America selection. Harmotto was an Academic All-America third-team honoree a season ago.

Big Ten Network Makes Wildcard Pick

The Big Ten Network selected the Penn State at Michigan match on Saturday, Nov. 29, as its wildcard matchup. The match will be aired live, but will be moved from its original time and will be played at 6 p.m. ET. With the selection, Michigan and Penn State will each have made eight appearances on national TV by the conclusion of the regular season.

Triple Threat

Wisconsin freshman **Janelle Gabrielsen** became the first Big Ten player to record a triple-double this season when she tallied 13 kills, 15 assists and 10 digs against No. 20 Michigan on Saturday. She became just the third Badger ever and the first since 1988 to accomplish the feat. Gabrielsen's triple-double is the first in the Big Ten since Oct. 27, 2007, when Minnesota's Lauren Gibbemeyer and Ohio State's Briana McCarthy recorded triple-doubles in the same match.

20-20-20 Vision

Three Big Ten teams reached the 20-win plateau over the weekend, giving the conference four 20-win teams so far this season. Minnesota will finish with at least 20 wins for the sixth time in the last seven years, while Purdue reaches the 20-wins marker for the third time under head coach **Dave Shondell**, and Michigan collects 20 wins for the third straight season. Illinois is one win away from its first 20-win season since 2003.

Big Ten Rips up the RPI

According to the latest RPI report issued by the NCAA on Monday, the Big Ten boasts four of the top 10 teams in the nation. Penn State has the country's highest RPI, followed by No. 4 Minnesota, No. 6 Illinois and No. 7 Purdue. No other conference boasts more than three top-10 RPI squads. Also ranking high on the list for the Big Ten are No. 22 Michigan, No. 31 Indiana and No. 46 Wisconsin. RPI is one of several tools used by the NCAA selection committee when evaluating teams for the NCAA Championship.

Big Ten on TV

The Big Ten's 11 volleyball squads are enjoying vast exposure during the 2008 regular season with 23 matches airing on national television. This week's schedule features two matches live on the Big Ten Network. Action begins on Wednesday as Michigan hosts Ohio State at 7 p.m. ET. Michigan is 4-2 in TV games, including a 3-0 win over Ohio State on Sept. 24, while the Buckeyes are 1-1 in nationally televised games. On Saturday, the Big Ten Network will broadcast Penn State at Purdue and air the match on Sunday at 8 p.m. ET. The Nittany Lions are 5-0 in TV games while the Boilermakers are 1-2.

OFFENSE



Laura DeBruler, Illinois So., OH, Downers Grove, Ill./Downers Grove North
DeBruler became just the second player in Illinois history to eclipse the 1,000 career digs mark in her first two seasons, now with 1,023. The sophomore recorded two double-doubles on the road over the weekend, first with 22 kills and 14 digs in a 3-1 win over Iowa, followed by a 29-kill, 13-dig performance in a five-set match against No. 17 Minnesota. The Downers Grove, Ill., native leads the conference with 16 overall double-doubles and eight in Big Ten play. She is also the only player in the conference to rank in the top 10 in kills and digs per set. For the weekend, DeBruler averaged 5.7 kills per set on .305 hitting with 27 total digs and five total blocks for an average of 6.06 points per set. The award is DeBruler's second this season and the fourth of her career.

Christine Tan, Minnesota Jr., LIB, Safety Harbor, Fla./Palm Harbor
Tan helped the Golden Gophers climb into a tie for second place in the conference standings with a pair of home wins against No. 18 Purdue and No. 16 Illinois over the weekend. The junior recorded 21 digs and an ace and was perfect on 17 service reception attempts as Minnesota swept the Boilermakers on Friday. On Saturday, the libero recorded 26 saves, one ace and two assists while converting on 31 of 33 service reception opportunities in a five-set win over the Illini. Behind Tan's passing, the Gophers hit for a combined .288 percentage on the weekend while limiting their opponents to a .213 average. Tan recorded her 10th and 11th 20-dig performances over the weekend and moved into third place at Minnesota with 1,299 career digs. The award is Tan's fifth of the season and the seventh of her career, tying her for fifth all-time in the Big Ten.

Arielle Wilson, Penn State So., MH, Broadview, Ill./Proviso East
Wilson helped the Nittany Lions remain perfect in matches and sets last week, averaging 2.0 blocks and 2.8 kills as Penn State swept Indiana and Michigan State. Against the Hoosiers on Wednesday, Wilson tallied five kills on nine errorless attacks to hit at a .556 clip. She also tied her season high with nine total blocks, holding Indiana to -.020 hitting on the night. Versus the Spartans on Friday, Wilson racked up a season-high 12 kills on 17 errorless swings to hit .706 while adding three stuffs at the net. Behind Wilson's block, PSU's opponents hit at a combined .027 mark last week, while the Nittany Lions' foes are hitting at a season-long average of .066. On the year, Wilson is averaging 1.37 blocks per set and is part of the Nittany Lion squad that leads the nation with a 3.26 blocks-per-set average. The weekly award is Wilson's second this season and the fourth of her career.
