### PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**Megan Hodge, Penn State So., OH, Durham, N.C./Riverside**  
Hodge was named the Most Valuable Player of the Penn State Classic after leading the Nittany Lions to the tournament title. Against No. 24 St. John's on Friday night, Hodge led all players with 18 kills on .556 hitting, also adding two service aces and nine digs. Against Colgate on Saturday, Hodge tallied 15 kills on a .583 clip, also contributing a team-high nine digs and five blocks. In the event's title match against VCU, the sophomore tallied 12 kills with a .381 hitting percentage, adding 12 digs for her 13th career double-double. On the weekend, Hodge averaged 5.00 kills per game on the strength of a .514 hitting mark with 3.33 digs and 1.22 blocks per game. The award is the fourth of Hodge's career, as she was honored three times as a freshman in 2006.

### DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

**Jenilee Rathje, Michigan State Fr., MB, Mount Pleasant, Mich./Mount Pleasant**  
Rathje tallied 29 blocks in four matches as the Spartans won the Harvard Invitational. Rathje set a Michigan State freshman blocks record with 11 stuffs against Harvard on Sunday, earning her first career double-double with 11 kills in the 3-1 victory. The freshman missed a triple-double by just two digs in the match, finishing the tournament's championship contest with eight saves. The Mount Pleasant, Mich., native contributed three service aces in the opening game of the weekend, a 3-0 sweep over Wofford.

**BIG TEN NEWS & NOTES**

**Making History**

Northwestern's **Kate Nobilio** broke the Wildcats' single-match record for a three-game contest with 31 digs against Towson on Saturday. The sophomore posted 11 saves in each of the first two games before setting the record with nine digs in the third. Also writing her name in the record books, Michigan's **Katie Bruzdinski** tallied the fourth-highest kill total in Michigan history with 32 against Xavier on Friday. The senior is now second on the Wolverines' all-time kills list.

**1K Kills**

Three Big Ten volleyball players eclipsed the 1,000 career kills mark over the weekend. Michigan State's **Ashley Schatzle** reached the mark against Wofford on Friday, while Purdue's **Danita Merlau** and **Kelli Miller** each reached the mark against Florida A&M on Saturday.

**Crazy Eights**

Owning the best record in in the conference this season, **Michigan** is off to its third 8-0 start in four years. The Wolverines began the 2004 campaign 8-0, and started the 2006 season with a program-best 13-match unbeaten streak.

**Coaches' Corner**

With the Spartan's win over Wofford on Friday, Michigan State head coach **Cathy George** reached the 400 career win milestone. Also on Friday, Northwestern leader **Keylor Chan** earned his 100th victory with the Wildcats. Illinois' head coach **Don Hardin** is just two wins away from 200 with the Illini and 10 shy of 400 in his career.

**How Low Can You Go?**

Purdue held Furman to nine points in Game 1 on Friday, marking the first time in the 30-point era that the Boilermakes held a team to single-digit scoring. Also on Friday, **Wisconsin** set a school record by surrendering just 39 points in its match against Columbia, breaking the previous mark by four.

**Undefeated**

Big Ten teams went undefeated in 13 games on Friday, winning 39 of 43 games. On the week, conference squads went 27-3, allowing their opponents to take just 13 of the 103 games played.

**In the Polls**

Five Big Ten schools received spots in the CSTV/AVCA poll, led by No. 3 **Penn State**. **Michigan** earned its highest ranking ever at No. 10, while No. 9 **Wisconsin**, No. 13 **Minnesota** and No. 20 **Ohio State** also represent the conference in the top 25.
