Baylor vs. Texas March 9, 2007

CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- The Longhorns mounted the largest comeback in Big 12 Championship history, overcoming an 18-point, 43-25 halftime deficit. They trailed by 20, 48-28, with 16:59 to play, but then outscored the Bears 46-21 to close the game. The previous record was 13 by OU on 3/11/04.
- Texas is 2-2 when meeting Oklahoma State in the Big 12 Championship.

TEAM NOTES

- Texas defeated Baylor twice in the regular season: 84-79 in Austin on 1/27 and 68-67 in Waco on 2/17.
- The Horns led for a total of 2:47 in the game.

Baylor

- Sophomore center Mamadou Diene came down with a career-high 12 rebounds (was 10 done twice).
- Sophomore guard Curtis Jerrells led the Bears with 19 points, his 14th straight double-figures scoring game.

Texas

- This is Texas A&M's 11th Big 12 Championship Appearance. They are 11-10 overall and 7-2 in quarterfinal play.
- Freshman Kevin Durant set a Texas Big 12 Championship record with 29 points (was 28 by Kris Clack vs. TTU, 3/5/99). He began the game by going 0-12 FG and 0-4 3-pt FG. His first point came on a free throw with 5:55 to go in the first half. He scored five points in the first half.
- Durant also set a Texas Big 12 Championship record with 24 FGA (was 21 done twice), 11 FTM (was 10 done twice).
- Freshman guard D.J. Augustin, who averaged 15.0 ppg into tonight, scored just six points on 2-11 FG, 2-2 FT. He did not hit a field goal seven minutes remained in the game. He had scored in double-figures his previous eight outings.
- Augustin scored UT's last four points (a jumper and two free throws) in the game's final minute.
