



## 2007 PHILLIPS 66 BIG 12 CHAMPIONSHIP Ford Center – Oklahoma City, Oklahoma

### \*\*\* CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES \*\*\* Oklahoma vs. Kansas March 9, 2007

#### CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- With the win, Kansas is now 10-1 overall in quarterfinal play.
- Bill Self is now 6-2 (.750) in Big 12 Championship play and has the second-best winning percentage of any coach in Big 12 Championship history (Roy Williams, Kansas, .778).
- Kansas advances to play the winner of the Kansas State/Texas Tech game. Kansas is 5-0 overall against K-State in Big 12 Championship play and 1-0 against Tech.

#### TEAM NOTES

- Kansas opened on a 30-9 run in the first 14 minutes of the second half after leading by only two (28-26) at half.
- Kansas beat Oklahoma 67-65 in Norman on 2/26 in their lone regular season match-up.

#### **Oklahoma**

- Oklahoma finishes the Championship with a 1-1 record and a 5-11 record overall in the Big 12 Championship. They dropped to 7-4 overall in quarterfinal play.
- Oklahoma finished shooting a season-low and an OU Big 12 Championship-low 31 percent (15-48 FG).
- Junior center Longar Longar finished with 14 rebounds, the most for an OU player since the 2002 Big 12 Championship (Aaron McGhee-15). He also finished with 13 points, collecting his seventh double-double of the season.

#### **Kansas**

- This is Kansas' 11<sup>th</sup> appearance in the Big 12 Championship, they improved to 20-6 overall with the win.
- KU has held every opponent under 50 percent shooting this season. A total of 28 straight opponents and 67 of 68 have been under the mark.
- Kansas has held 15 different opponents under 60 points in 2006-07, including seven in Big 12 play.
