***** CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES ***** **Texas Tech vs. Kansas State** **March 9, 2007**

CHAMPIONSHIP NOTES

- Texas Tech senior guard Jarius Jackson became the Big 12 Championship all-time points leader with 175 points, surpassing former Tech guard Andre Emmett (164 points, 2001-04).
- Jackson also moved up to first all-time in Big 12 Championship play with 45 free throws made, passing former Sooner Hollis Price (41 free throws made, 2000-03). He remains at seventh on the all-time list at 19.4 points per game and first in minutes played per game at 38.1.
- Kansas State senior guard Lance Harris moved up to a tie for fourth place in three-point field goal percentage (.515) in Big 12 Championship history.
- Kansas State will face Kansas tomorrow in the semi-finals. K-State is 0-5 all-time in the Big 12 Championship against the Jayhawks. Kansas State lost to Kansas, 58-69, in the 1999 Big 12 semis as the #7 seed.

TEAM NOTES

- Kansas State lost to Texas Tech in the teams' lone meeting of the season, 52-62, on 1/8 in Manhattan. The Wildcats shot 30 percent in the game, while the Red Raiders shot 42 percent from the field.

Texas Tech

- Texas Tech set team Big 12 Championship-lows in free throw attempts (7), total rebounds (25), defensive rebounds (17) and points (45).

Kansas State

- This is Kansas State's 11th appearance in the Big 12 Championship, they improved to 7-10 overall and 2-4 in quarterfinal play.
- K-State connected on a Wildcat Big 12 Championship-record 10 three-pointers (previous record was 9, 3/7/02 vs. Baylor).
- Senior forward Cartier Martin and senior guard Lance Harris tied a K-State Big 12 Championship-high with four three-pointers a piece.
- Kansas State held Texas Tech to a Wildcat Big 12 Championship low 45 points (previous record was 58, Nebraska, 3/8/01).
