### GAME #18 BOSTON UNIVERSITY (6-11, 3-2 AE) VS. UMBC (7-12, 3-3 AE)

**THE GAME:** BU and UMBC come into this afternoon's game each having snapped a streak. The Terriers lost their first game in four contests at Stony Brook on Jan. 18, while the Retrievers ended a three-game losing skid with a victory at home against Hartford on Jan. 18.

**RADIO-TV COVERAGE:** The game will air on WTTT 1150 AM, with Doug Brown and Brian Mauer sharing play-by-play duties in the first and second halves, and Mike Shalin providing color analysis. The radio broadcast can be accessed on the internet at <http://www.bu.edu/athletics/fans/tv-radio-schedule.html>. All home games and selected road games will also be broadcast by WTBU. Those broadcasts can be accessed by visiting [www.wtburadio.com](http://www.wtburadio.com).

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Terriers hold a commanding 8-2 lead in the series. The rivalry dates back to the 1989-90 season. BU won the first two games before UMBC claimed the third. The Terriers were on a five-game winning streak from Jan. 5, 1995, to Feb. 9, 2005, before the Retrievers won their second of the series by one point, 65-64, in overtime on Jan. 5, 2006. BU won the last meeting, 59-47, on Feb. 8, 2006 for the series split in '05-'06. The Terriers' average margin of victory is 8.4 points, while both of their losses have been by three or fewer points.

**SCOUTING THE RETRIEVERS:** UMBC has lost three of its last four, but the Retrievers are coming off a five-point win at home over the Hartford Hawks. Five players posted double digit points for UMBC - Brian Hodges led with 20 points followed by Chris Pugh's 15, Justin Fry's 14, Tom Young's 12 and Jay Greene's 10 points. The Retrievers never trailed but they couldn't shake the Hawks either. UMBC held an 11-point lead, 52-41, with 12:11 remaining, but Hartford gradually whittled the advantage to two points, 68-66, on a Jaret Von Rosenberg jumper with 3:37 remaining. Fry came up big on UMBC's next two possessions, hitting a pair of free throws with 2:45 remaining and adding a baseline jumper with 1:54 to play to restore the lead to 72-66 and give the Retrievers a cushion through the end of the game.

**THE LAST TIME VERSUS UMBC (W, 59-47; 2/8/06):** BU led 28-16 at the half after going on an early 11-0 run to take control of the game, 19-6. UMBC did not go down

easily, as the Retrievers trimmed a second-half 12-point deficit to three, 35-32, with 13:26 remaining in the game, as Jay Greene hit a three and John Zito scored down low. The Terrier advantage was just five, 43-38, with 8:16 left, but BU hit two free throws then powered home a putback on an offensive rebound to stretch the lead to nine, 47-38, with 7:16 left. That putback sparked a 12-1 run over the next five-and-a-half minutes to put the game away for BU. The Terriers hit 8-8 free throws down the stretch to secure the victory.

**3-POINT SHOOTING DOGFIGHT:** The 3-pointer could go a long way this afternoon in deciding the winner of this contest as the Terriers rank second in the league in 3-point shooting (36.3 percent) and the Retrievers are last in the conference in 3-point field goal percentage defense (40.8 percent). BU averages 7.18 made threes a game and have made ten or more triples seven times so far this season.

**LAST TIME OUT (SBU 68, BU 62 (OT)):** Neither team was able to put together two good halves in regulation. BU shot 35 percent (7-for-20) in the first half, while Stony Brook sputtered in the second, going 6-for-19 (31.6 percent). BU held a slim 49-47 lead with eight seconds left, but Stony Brook's Ricky Lucas hit a buzzer-beater in the lane to send the game into overtime. The Seawolves strung together a 10-2 run to begin overtime and take a 59-54 lead with 1:21 on the clock. BU got as close as three, 61-58, on a 3-pointer by Tyler Morris with 41 seconds left, but SBU shot 7-for-8 from the free throw to seal the win.

**BU 0-4 IN OT GAMES THIS SEASON:** The Terriers have not had any luck this season when play extends beyond regulation. With the 68-62 overtime loss at Stony Brook on Jan. 18, BU is now 0-4 this season and 43-34 (.558) all-time in overtime games. The Terriers played three overtime games, including a double-overtime contest, in four games between Dec. 28 and Jan. 6 this season. One would have to look to 1999-2000 to find more overtime results and three OT games in four contests. That year, BU lost to James Madison 91-79 on Nov. 22, 1999 in overtime before playing Towson on Jan. 16, 2000 (L, 54-52; OT), Vermont on Jan. 23 (L, 86-85; 2OT), and Drexel on

Jan. 28 (L, 62-61; OT). The Vermont and Drexel overtime games were back-to-back, similar to this year's consecutive Holy Cross and Hartford games that each required extra time.

**COREY LOWE LEADS BU IN SBU LOSS:** Freshman Corey Lowe posted his fourth 20-plus point game of the season in the Terriers' overtime loss at Stony Brook on Jan. 18. The Newton, Mass. native scored a game-best 20 points and led both teams with eight boards and six assists. His rebound total was a career-high for Lowe. The freshman has posted double figures in points a team-leading 12 times and has led the Terriers in scoring in 10 games. Lowe currently has a six-game streak of scoring 10 or more points in a game.

**LOWE NAMED AMERICA EAST CO-ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:** Corey Lowe averaged 15.7 points and 7.0 rebounds in three games to lead the Terriers to earn his third America East Rookie of the Week distinction for the week of Jan. 14. Lowe went a combined 14-for-16 (.875) from the free throw line. He also averaged 2.0 steals, 2.0 assists and 1.0 blocks per game. The freshman had a game-high 13 points and seven boards in the 53-29 victory over New Hampshire on Jan. 13. Lowe tallied another game-best 17 points at Binghamton in a 61-49 win, and in the 65-63 win over Maine, his lay-up with 17:31 remaining in the game gave BU the lead for good, 41-39. He finished that contest with a team-high 17 points, seven rebounds, four assists and three steals.

**BU HOLDS SEVEN TEAMS TO SEASON LOW IN POINTS:** The Terriers have limited seven opponent to their lowest point totals of the season so far in 2006-07. UNH was BU's latest victim, tallying just 29 points as a team on Jan. 13. The Terriers had a streak of five games going earlier in the year, holding St. Joseph's to 55 on Nov. 27, St. Bonaventure to 46 on Dec. 2, Massachusetts to 56 on Dec. 6, Rhode Island to 51 on Dec. 22, and St. John's to 45 on Dec. 28. In addition to UNH in conference play, BU held Binghamton to 49 points for the game on Jan. 11.

**HIGH ON LOWE:** Corey Lowe has stepped right into a starting role as a true freshman and flourished there. He began the year scoring 10 or more points in seven of the first eight games, including a career-high 28 at Manhattan on 9-for-20 (.450) shooting, before struggling for three games at the end of December. Lowe seems to have shaken the slump to score 10-plus points in the last six games - 24 against Holy Cross on Jan. 3, 23 at Hartford on Jan. 6., 17 against Maine on Jan. 9, at Binghamton on Jan. 11, 13 versus New Hampshire on Jan. 13, and 20 at Stony Brook on Jan. 18.

**KEY THREES:** So far in 2006-07, the Terriers as a team have made 10 or more 3-pointers seven times, including a school record 15 in a double overtime loss at Hartford. This year's output so far exceeds that of the totals of the last four seasons combined. The Terriers as a team totaled 10-plus triples a total of three times each in '05-'06, '03-

**BU TO HOST 2007 AMERICA EAST TOURNAMENT:** The Boston University Terriers will once again play host to the America East Conference Tournament. The conference playoffs return to Boston after two years in Vestal, N.Y. BU will host the first two rounds in Agganis Arena from Friday, March 2 to Sunday, March 4. The championship game, televised on ESPN2, will take place at the site of the highest remaining seed at noon on Saturday, March 10.

**PETERKIN POSTS 2ND CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE VS. BINGHAMTON:** Senior co-captain Omari Peterkin scored 10 points and pulled down 12 rebounds in the Terriers' win over Binghamton on Jan. 11. That marked his second career double-double as well as his second of the season. Peterkin last accomplished the feat with 15 points and a career-high 14 rebounds at Northeastern on Nov. 21.

**WOLFF GETS 100TH WIN IN CASE AGAINST MAINE:** Head coach Dennis Wolff recorded a milestone win when the Terriers claimed a 65-63 victory against Maine on Jan. 14. He posted his 100th career win in Case Gym, one of BU's two homes. Wolff is now 100-37 (.730) at Case in his 13 years at the helm in Boston. BU's best record in Case under Wolff, and in program history, was a perfect 10-0 season in 1996-97 when the Terriers finished 25-5 overall, 17-1 in the America East and went to the NCAA Tournament. So far this year, BU is 2-2 at The Roof.

on Jan. 6 to eclipse the old team mark of 14 set at Florida State on Dec. 28, 2002. Lowe attempted 16 3-pointers to move one ahead of Billy Collins' 15 attempted against Maine on March 3, 2001. Lowe made six threes, which was one shy of the single-game school record for 3-pointers made he tied earlier this year with a 7-for-16 performance from deep against UMass. The single-game made threes record originally was set by Matt Turner twice during the 2000-01 season.

### SCOTT BRITTAIN RECORDS 1ST CAREER DOUBLE

**DOUBLE:** With his career-high 13 points and ten rebounds, the Canadian freshman recorded his first career double double against Hartford. His previous career best in points was nine against Rider on Nov. 18. Brittain tied his personal record in boards he set at St. Bonaventure on Dec. 2. He is the second Terrier this season to record not only a double double but also a first career double double.

### NON-CONFERENCE NOTABLES

**A GOOD MIX:** BU faced teams from six difference leagues during its non-conference slate... The Terriers went 0-1 against the Patriot League (Holy Cross), the Colonial Athletic Association (Northeastern), and the Big East (St. John's)... BU had a 1-0 mark against Ivy teams (Harvard), a 1-1 record against the MAAC (Rider and Manhattan), but a 1-5 record against Atlantic 10 opponents (George Washington, Manhattan, St. Joseph's, St. Bonaventure, Massachusetts and Rhode Island).

**ON THE ROAD AGAIN:** BU's eight road games in its first 11 games are the most since the Terriers played ten contests away from home in 1996-97. That year BU did not have a home game until Jan. 4, a 67-62 overtime victory against Maine. BU played in the Red Auerbach Colonial Classic Nov. 22-23, faced East Carolina in Halifax, Nova Scotia on Nov. 30, faced Towson, Delaware, Harvard, Texas Christian and URI on the road before capping the ten-game road trip with two games at the Christmas Shootout in Tampa, Fla. on Dec. 27-28. The fewest scheduled road games in the first ten contests came during the 1979-80 season when BU played just two games away from home - LSU (Dec. 28; L, 92-72) and U.S. International (Jan. 5; W, 111-80).

**HOLIDAY HIATUS:** BU's 15-day break between games this December is unusually long for the Terriers. In fact, that is the longest Boston University has gone between games since the 1988-89 season, when the Terriers took 18 days off. This season, BU's last game was Dec. 6, a 56-54 last second loss to UMass. In '88-'89, the Terriers played Tennessee Tech in the Forest Industries Classic in Montana on Dec. 10 and won, 84-62, before taking on UNC-Charlotte on Dec. 29 at the Far West Classic in Oregon and dropping a 76-53 decision.

**BU 75, HARTFORD 80 (2OT) - JAN. 6:** This was the Terriers' third OT game in four games but first 2OT game in three years... BU had six turnovers in the first half but finished the game with 23... Carlos Strong's 18 points were one shy of his career high set versus George Washington on Nov. 7... Scott Brittain posted his first double double... Corey Lowe (24) had 20 or more points for the second consecutive game and third time this season.

**HOLY CROSS 73, BU 70 (OT) - JAN. 3:** Both teams had a blistering first half, shooting 50 percent or better - BU at 57.1 percent - from the floor... Tyler Morris hit a 3-pointer as time expired to send the game into overtime... The Terriers took 12 free throw attempts in the overtime period - one more than BU took in the prior two halves combined.

**AEROPOSTALE HOLIDAY FESTIVAL - ST. JOHN'S 45, BU 44 (OT), ST. JOSEPH'S 58, BU 53 - DEC. 28-29:** Omari Peterkin earned a spot on the All-Tournament team after averaging 10.5 ppg, 7.0 rpg, and 3.0 bpg in two games... The game against St. John's on Dec. 28 was the first time since Nov. 29, 2005 BU did not have a scorer in double figures... The combined point total between St. John's and BU (89) was the lowest combined total since Jan. 22, 2006 when BU took a 43-41 decision from Vermont... Peterkin recorded a career-high five blocks against the Red Storm... Valdas Sirutis had his best game as a Terrier versus St. John's with six points and six rebounds... The Terriers and St. Joseph's met twice this season - the last time the Terriers played a non-conference opponent twice in one season was during the 1978-79 season when UConn won both games.

**UMASS 56, BU 54 - DEC. 6:** With the 56-54 loss, BU is still winless at home and against the Minute-

men... UMass holds a 5-0 advantage in the series... BU's largest source of scoring in the paint came from its two guards - Brian Macon and Corey Lowe who each had eight points in the paint, 33.3 percent of BU's points... For the first time all season, BU's bench was out-scored by an opponent.

**BU 74, ST. BONAVENTURE 46 - DEC. 2:** Senior Omari Peterkin's most important contribution during the game was the one that didn't show up on the stat sheet - his three charges drawn... BU out-scored St. Bonaventure 45-28 in the second half, due mainly to the Terriers' 3-point shooting. BU went 7-for-10 from deep in the second frame compared to SBU's 3-for-10... The Terriers out-rebounded St. Bonaventure 34-21 to mark the second time this season BU has out-rebounded an opponent.

**ST. JOSEPH'S 55, BU 39 - NOV. 27:** It was a turnover-prone game for both teams. St. Joseph's turned the ball over 19 times, while BU made 26 ball handling errors... The Terriers did find success on the free throw line, shooting 13-for-15 on foul shots (86.7 percent)... The 26-25 halftime score was the lowest produced by BU and an opponent since a 25-25 halftime score in the America East Quarter-final game against Vermont (L, 64-61) on March 4, 2006... The 13 points BU scored in the second half were the fewest tallied in a half since Dec. 13, 1991 when BU played Indiana and mustered just 13 points. The Terriers ended up falling 88-47 to the Hoosiers. BU shot 19.4 percent (6-31) in that first half... BU's 39 total points were the fewest since an output of 38 versus Rhode Island on Nov. 29, 2005 when the Terriers lost 48-38 to the Rams.

**BU 74, MANHATTAN 65 - NOV. 25:** Corey Lowe was 7-for-13 from behind the arc (53.8 percent) to tie the school record for made threes in a game... The Terriers scored 28 of 74 points in the paint despite Omari Peterkin, Scott Brittain, and Ibrahim Konate all picking up a fourth foul by 11:36 in the second half... Five of the six Terriers who took at least three shots against Manhattan shot 45.0 percent or better. Ibrahim Konate was a perfect 4-for-4 and Omari Peterkin shot four-for-five (80.0 percent). Scott Brittain (three-for-four, 75.0 percent), Tyler Morris (5-for-10, 50.0 percent) and Corey Lowe (9-for-20, 45.0 percent) rounded out the bunch... Manhattan is one of two opponents this season who is as young

as BU. The Jaspers have seven true freshmen and one red-shirt freshman who, along with the rest of the team, combine for 185 Division I games played and 90 DI starts entering this season.

**NORTHEASTERN 73, BU 54 – NOV. 21:** Omari Peterkin recorded his first double double of his career (15-14). His rebound total shattered his previous career high of nine boards... BU had a 20-12 scoring advantage in the paint and an 11-5 edge in second chance points... The Terriers out-rebounded Northeastern 36-23, the first time BU has done so to an opponent this season.

**RIDER 66, BU 60 – NOV. 18:** Corey Lowe (13), Tyler Morris (13) and Omari Peterkin (12) all scored in double figures a game after four Terriers accomplished the feat against Harvard... Tyler Morris recorded a game-high (and career-high) six assists, which was tied for the single game high in the conference that week.

**BU 78, HARVARD 74 – NOV. 14:** BU forced 20 turnovers and limited Harvard's two shooting guards, Jim Goffredo and Drew Housman, to a combined 4-for-16 shooting... The Terriers totaled 20 assists on 27 baskets against Harvard and those assists came from six different players... Tyler Morris (22), Corey Lowe (14), Carlos Strong (13) and Omari Peterkin (11) all scored in double figures for BU... Ibrahim Konate grabbed a career-high eight rebounds, the most important coming with one second left. He drew a foul and made both free throws to put BU up four and ice the victory... The win marked the sixth straight time BU has beaten Harvard and the 14th in the last 16 meetings (since 1991-92)... BU shot 13-for-14 from the free throw line (92.9 percent) as a team.

**LOWE A TWO-TIME AMERICA EAST ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:** On Dec. 11, freshman Corey Lowe earned his second conference honor of the season for his 16-point, seven-rebound performance against UMass on Dec. 6. The seven boards were a career high, and he showed his versatility by driving the lane after shooting primarily threes in the prior three games. He was also a spark to BU's late 8-0 run that got the Terriers within two points and nearly won them the game. Lowe shot 9-for-20 from the floor (45 percent) in the 74-65 victory over Manhattan on Nov. 25 to receive his first Rookie recognition. Seven of his nine shots were 3-pointers, to tie a school record for most treys made in a game.

**STRONG NAMED AE CO-ROOKIE OF THE WEEK:** For his 19-point effort off the bench for BU against George Washington on Nov. 10, true freshman Carlos Strong earned America East Co-Player of the Week honors. He shared the award with Maine's Junior Bernal. Strong totaled 19 points and two assists in 27 minutes.

**DUAL HOMES OF BU BASKETBALL:** BU played the second of two contests at Agganis Arena on Dec. 6 against UMass, which opened in January 2005. The games at Agganis Arena featured some of the heavyweights on BU's schedule, as the Terriers hosted George Washington (11/10) and Massachusetts (Dec. 6), which was the nightcap of a doubleheader with the women's team. Agganis Arena seats 7,200 and was christened in basketball in 2004-05 when the Terriers upset Vermont 61-55. It is the permanent home of BU men's hockey, and the facility will host the early rounds of the 2007 America East Men's Basketball Championships.

BU has nine games Case Gymnasium and has played at The Roof since 1972-73, compiling an extraordinary 185-78 (.703) record there. Dennis Wolff-coached teams have even better, running up a 99-36 (.733) mark at Case since his arrival in 1994-95. BU is 44-12 (.785) there since the beginning of 2001-02.

**DENNIS WOLFF: DEAN OF AMERICA EAST COACHES:** With the retirement of Vermont's Tom Brennan at the end of the 2004-05 season, Dennis Wolff became the elder statesman among America East coaches. Wolff is in his 13th season on the bench; no other coach in the conference has coached at his current school for more than five years. Wolff's 204 wins at BU to start the season are more than the coaches at the other eight schools in the America East combined (129). In terms of total years coached among conference colleagues, Wolff's 14 total years of experience trails just Binghamton's Al Walker (18) and New Hampshire's Bill Herrion (15).

**BU ON TV:** The Boston University Terriers have the potential to be on regional and national television seven times this season. BU appeared on CN8 twice in 2006-07, falling 70-57 to George Washington at Agganis Arena on Nov. 10 and falling in overtime to Holy Cross, 73-70, on Jan. 3. BU's first game in the Aeropostale Holiday Festival was on the MSG Network, and the Terriers will appear on NESN on Jan. 24 against Albany, Feb. 22 against Vermont in Case Gym and Feb. 25 at Albany. Once again, the America East Championship will be televised by ESPN2 at the site of the highest remaining seed on Mar. 10.

**PRESEASON PROGNOSTICATIONS:** Despite receiving one first-place vote, BU was picked to finish fifth in the Preseason Coaches Poll, the program's lowest selection since 2000-01 when it was slated to finish sixth. Several injuries in 2005-06 and a line up with six new faces poses some questions for BU in 2006-07. Seniors Omari Peterkin and Brian Macon are the top returning Terriers, while red-shirt freshman Tyler Morris and highly touted true freshmen Corey Lowe and Carlos Strong may be key contributors.

**A LITTLE GREEN:** The 2006-07 edition of BU basketball ranks as the youngest in the America East, in terms of proportion of freshmen and sophomores (76.9) and in terms of game experience. The 12 players on the active roster have combined to play 144 Division I games in their college careers - 108 of which have come from three players. Seniors Brian Macon and Omari Peterkin and red-shirt sophomore Matt Wolff together total 108 games played and 41 starts, leaving the other nine Terriers with 36 games played and nine starts between them. In terms of total games played on the current roster, this is the youngest BU team in Dennis Wolff's 13 years. The team that previously held the title was the 1999-2000 Terriers, which combined for just 231 career games played heading into the season.

**MACON: A RARE JUCO FIND FOR BU:** Guard Brian Macon became just the second junior college transfer to suit up for the Terriers in Dennis Wolff's 12 seasons when he joined the team in 2005-06. Last season, he started all 28 games and averaged 32.1 minutes per contest. Macon led the team in free throw shooting (.846) and averaged 5.7 points per game and 3.9 assists per game. He is the team's top returning 3-point shooter, having connected on 27.8 percent from behind the arc last season. Macon came to BU from Miami Dade College, where he averaged 10.1 ppg and 7.1 apg for a Sharks team that went 27-5 and won the Southern Conference. Stijn Dhondt (BU, '02) is the only other juco player in the Dennis Wolff era.

**(JUNIOR) NATIONALLY KNOWN:** Senior forward Omari Peterkin, red-shirt sophomore forward Ibrahim Konate and freshman forward Scott Brittain all arrived at BU with experience on their respective country or territory's junior national team. Peterkin played for the Virgin Islands team for two years. Konate played for the Mali team for two years and traveled to France and Guinea for tournaments. Brittain was co-captain of the Canadian team as a junior and played for two years.

**A COSMOPOLITAN PROGRAM:** Boston University's 13-man roster for this season includes players from Africa, Eastern Europe, Western Europe, the United States, Canada, and the U.S. Virgin Islands. Sophomore Ibrahim Konate comes from the western African nation of Mali. Freshman Valdas Sirutis hails from Gargzdai, Lithuania. Junior transfer Max Gotzler is from Weilheim, Germany. Freshman Scott Brittain grew up in Ontario, Canada, and senior Omari Peterkin comes from St. Thomas on the U.S. Virgin Islands. Senior Brian Macon; sophomores Matt Wolff, Marques Johnson, and Tyler Morris; and freshmen Corey Lowe, Carlos Strong, and Sherrod Smith all hail from the U.S. Freshman Tunde Agboola was born in western Massachusetts but his father emigrated to the United States from Nigeria.

**FRESH FACES:** BU welcomes six freshmen and a transfer to the program in 2006-07. Freshman walk on Tunde Agboola played one year of high school basketball before becoming the first player in Dennis Wolff's 12 years as head coach at BU to be taken from open try outs. Freshman forward Scott Brittain, a two-year member of the Canadian Junior National Team, is a perimeter scorer on the wing and willingly gets into the mix on the boards. Freshman guard Corey Lowe, a much heralded recruit from nearby Newton North High School, led his team to back-to-back Massachusetts state titles and averaged 18 points per game and ten assists per game as a senior. Freshman forward Valdas Sirutis played three years of basketball at Tidewater Academy in Virginia and averaged 22 ppg, 13 rpg, four bpg, three apg. Freshman forward Sherrod Smith is an athletic scorer on the wing who averaged 19 ppg and five rpg as a senior. Freshman guard Carlos Strong averaged 19 ppg, seven rpg and five apg while leading his team to state championship title and was the 2006 Gatorade Player of the Year in Maine. Junior transfer Max Gotzler, a forward from Oregon Institute of Technology, helped his team appear in the NAIA Sweet Sixteen as a junior and in the NAIA Final Four a year later. He will sit out 2006-07 in compliance with NCAA rules.

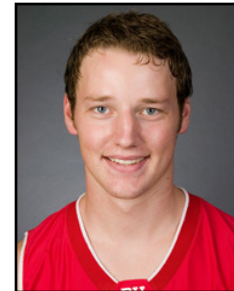

## DENNIS WOLFF

**HEAD COACH, 13TH SEASON**  
CONNECTICUT '78

Over the last five years, the Boston University men's basketball team has been a fixture at the top of the America East Conference standings, and head coach Dennis Wolff has been the architect of what has become one of the winningest programs in the nation. Since the beginning of the 2001-2002 season, the Terriers have compiled a 104-67 (.608) record, including a dominating 69-20 (.775) mark in America East games. Under Wolff's guidance, the Terriers won three straight conference titles (2002-2004) and

made four consecutive postseason appearances (2002-05) for the first time in school history.

Wolff has been recognized nationally for his stellar efforts at BU. The National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) named Wolff its District 1 Coach of the Year following the Terriers 23-6 season in 2003-04. The award recognizes the country's best men's collegiate basketball coaches.

Although Boston University's 2005-06 season was beset by injury, the Terriers still produced highlights. BU opened the season with a solid defensive effort against No. 1 Duke in the pre-season NIT. On Jan. 25, Wolff notched his 200th victory as head coach of the Terriers with a 54-40 win over Hartford.

In 2004-05, Boston University went 20-9, reaching the 20-win plateau for the fourth straight year – another school first – and prior to the current run, Terrier hoops claimed just seven 20-win seasons in its 104-year history. BU advanced to the NIT for the third time in four years, and the Terriers led the nation in field goal percentage defense (37.1%). BU was 14-4 in league play and handed 2005 NCAA Tournament darling Vermont one of its two America East losses during the regular season.

In 2003-04, the Terriers put up one of the program's best regular-season performances ever, going 23-4 and winning 23 of their last 24 games. Included in that total was a 12-game winning streak, one shy of the program's best-ever 13-game streak (1996-97). The team also won its third straight America East regular-season championship. A loss in the first round of the America East Tournament did not diminish the tremendous season the Terriers had. BU accepted its second straight NIT bid, going to the post-season for a third straight year.

The 2001-02 season kicked off a terrific run for the Terriers that included the 2002 America East regular season and conference titles (22-10 overall, 13-3 AE) and the program's sixth trip the NCAA Tournament that same year, followed by another America East regular season title in 2003 (20-11 overall) and three consecutive post-season appearances in the NIT through 2005.

Wolff is 210-160 (.568) in 13 years at BU, and is the school's all-time leader in victories. He became the Terriers' all-time leader in coaching wins with a 69-42 victory over Hartford at Case Gym on January 22, 2001. He passed Mike Jarvis (1985-90, 101-51) to move into the top spot. Wolff is also 136-76 (.642) in America East play while at BU. Including two years at Connecticut College in the early 1980's, Dennis Wolff is 240-178 (.574) in 15 years as a head coach.

### BEFORE BOSTON UNIVERSITY

Wolff arrived at BU following a four-year (1990-94) stint as an assistant coach under head coach Jeff Jones at the University of Virginia. During his tenure in Charlottesville, Wolff was an integral part of three Cavalier NCAA appearances, including a "Sweet Sixteen" appearance in 1993, and one N.I.T. Championship in 1992.

Prior to his tenure at Virginia, Wolff spent four years (1985-89) as an assistant coach under Bob Staak at Wake Forest, and one year (1989-90) at Southern Methodist University under John Shumate.

Wolff began his coaching career at Trinity College, a Division III school in Hartford, Conn., where he served as an assistant from 1978-80. At the age of 25, he was named as the head coach at Connecticut College and guided the Camels to a two-year mark of 30-18, including a successful 16-8 record in 1980-81, his first year as a head coach.

In 1982, he began his first of three years as an assistant coach at St. Bonaventure under Jim O'Brien. There, he helped lead the Bonnies to a 20-10 record, resulting in an NIT berth in 1983.

### PERSONAL

A 1978 graduate of the University of Connecticut, Wolff was a two-year letterman under head coaches Dee Rowe and Dom Perno after transferring from Louisiana State University in 1975. In his first season, Wolff appeared in 26 games for the 17-10 Huskies, averaging 6.0 points and 2.2 rebounds.

In his senior season, Wolff received the team's Most Inspirational Player Award after averaging 8.2 points and 3.6 rebounds a game. Second on the team in assists with 77, Wolff led the Huskies with an 84.0 percent success rate from the free-throw line.

During his playing days, Wolff and his Husky teammates faced Boston University on four occasions, winning three. The lone loss was a 66-61 decision in Case Gymnasium on Dec. 10, 1977. However, Wolff did score 14 points in the losing effort.

Born March 1, 1955 in New York City, Wolff was a standout guard for Holy Cross High School, helping his team to an overall mark of 55-11 as a three-year varsity starter. As a senior captain, he guided the club to the 1973 Brooklyn-Queens Championship. In recognition of his scholastic efforts, Wolff has since been inducted into the Holy Cross Athletic Hall of Fame.

Wolff and his wife JoAnn reside in Walpole and have three children, Nicole, 22, Matt, 21, and Michael, 18. Nicole, the 2002 McDonald's National Player of the Year, recently graduated and finished her four-year career on the UConn women's basketball team. Matt, who is a redshirt sophomore on this year's team, played in every game as a freshman for the Terriers.
