ON TAP

• Aiming for just its second 10-game win streak in the last 14 seasons (the last coming in 2005-06), Boston University looks to sweep its season series with Maine for the third time in the last four years following Friday's 7-2 victory.

• BU has won its last seven meetings against the Black Bears and is 10-0-1 in the last 11 meetings.

• The Terriers are 16-1-1 since Nov. 25, marking their best 18-game stretch since closing their national championship season of 1994-95 with 10 straight wins, followed by an 8-1-0 start to the 1995-96 campaign.

• Following last night's five-goal margin, BU has now scored exactly twice as many goals as its opponents this season (114-57).

HAPPY TRAILS

The Terriers have won their last nine contests away from Agganis Arena with three of the games played at neutral sites. BU will attempt to win its seventh straight game in an opposing rink for the first time since stringing together 18 consecutive between the 1976-77 and 1977-78 seasons.

SERIES HISTORY

• The Terriers and Black Bears have played 101 times since first meeting in the 1923-24 season, and BU holds a 50-42-9 edge (.540), including an 19-21-4 (.477) record in match-ups at Alfond Arena.

• Since the beginning of the 2005-06 season, the Terriers have posted an 10-0-1 record against the Black Bears. The 11-game unbeaten streak against Maine is BU's longest in the series in over 20 years.

• Since the formation of Hockey East in 1984-85, the Terriers have a 37-31-9 (.539) league advantage.

• Nineteen meetings have gone into overtime and BU holds a 7-2-10 (.632) advantage in those

games. BU has recorded six of the 10 shutouts in the series.

• The Terriers' longest winning streak in the series was 13 games (Jan. 16, 1982 - Feb. 15, 1986).

The Black Bears' longest streak was 11 games (Oct. 31, 1986 - Nov. 10, 1989) and came just after the BU win streak.

LAST NIGHT

• Boston University scored on its first three shots and never looked back, rolling to a 7-2 road victory over Maine to extend its win streak to nine games.

• Sophomore Colin Wilson recorded his first career hat trick and added an assist.

• Senior Jason Lawrence recorded two goals and an assist and seniors Matt Gilroy and Chris Higgins both registered three assists on the night. The Terriers also got goals from freshman Chris Connolly and sophomore Kevin Shattenkirk and senior Brandon Yip earned two assists.

• The Terriers scored the first five goals of the game with three coming in the opening nine minutes of the first and kept pace in the league standings with Northeastern, a 5-3 winner at UMass.

• Wilson scored the first goal of each period, beginning with a tally just 16 seconds after the opening faceoff.

• Freshman goaltender Kieran Millan improved to 19-1-1 with a 15-save performance before classmate Grant Rollheiser played the final 12:31 between the pipes and stopped all seven shots he faced.

• Maine got both of its goals on the power play. Scott Darling only stopped two of the six shots he faced before yielding way to junior Dave Wilson, who made 12 saves in 39:49 of action.

SCOUTING THE BLACK BEARS

• After winning 10 of its 16 games (10-5-1) in the first half of the season, Maine is just 2-9-2 since returning to action after the holiday break.

HOCKEY ON CAMPUS

Bernie Corbett and Paul McNamara are once again teaming up on Wednesdays this winter to bring weekly college hockey talk to Boston's radio airwaves, co-hosting the popular "Hockey On Campus" program on ESPN Radio (890 AM) from 7 to 9 p.m.

• The Black Bears are coming off a weekend split in New Hampshire, posting a 1-0 victory over the Wildcats in Manchester on Saturday after dropping a 4-1 decision in Durham the previous night.

• Maine went 5-3-1 in non-conference play with wins over Alaska, Niagara (2) and Union (2).

• Maine's scoring defense is ranked 12th in the nation at 2.52, while its penalty kill ranks sixth with an 88.4-percent success rate.

• Freshman Gustav Nyquist has made an immediate impact with team highs in both goals (9) and assists (12) for 21 points. Classmate Bryan Flynn (8g, 9a) and senior Chris Hahn (6g, 10a) have recorded 17 and 16 points, respectively, while sophomore Tanner House (6g, 8a) and freshman Spencer Abbott (5g, 9a) have chipped in 14 apiece.

• Freshman goaltender Scott Darling has made 20 starts and has a .913 save percentage and a 2.24 goals against average.

• Tim Whitehead is in his eighth season at the Maine helm and has a record of 179-101-32 at the school.

LAST MONTH AT AGGANIS

• Led by a pair of goals from freshman Chris Connolly, BU rolled to a 4-1 win over Maine on Jan. 10 at Agganis Arena. Seniors Chris Higgins and Brandon Yip also scored for the Terriers.

• Higgins gave the Terriers the lead for good when he broke a 1-1 tie on a tally with just eight tenths of a second left in the opening period. Connolly, who opened the scoring under nine minutes into the game, scored

the lone goal of the second before Yip capped the scoring exactly midway through the third.

• BU outshot Maine, 26-16, and got a 15-save performance from freshman Kieran Millan.

LAST YEAR'S SERIES

• BU swept Maine last season, posting a 3-1 victory at Alford Arena on Jan. 12 before recording back-to-back overtime wins (2-1, 1-0) at home on Feb. 15-16.

• Colin Wilson had four points (2g, 2a) in the series, including the lone goal of the finale. Classmate Kevin Shattenkirk tallied the game-winning goal and added an assist in the 3-1 road win. Luke Popko scored the overtime winner on Feb. 15.

BEST VS. THE BLACK BEARS

• Senior Brandon Yip has 10 career points (1g, 9a) in 10 games against the Black Bears, while classmate Jason Lawrence (4g, 5a) has nine points in 11 tilts.

• Following his four-point night on Friday, sophomore Colin Wilson has eight points (5g, 3a) in just five games versus Maine. Senior Chris Higgins (4g, 4a) also has eight points in 11 contests.

• Senior Matt Gilroy has two goals and five assists in 11 match-ups with Maine.

TERRIERS HOIST BEANPOT FOR 29TH TIME

• Powered by three short-handed goals, Boston University captured the 2009 Beanpot - its 29th title in the 57-year history of the tournament - with a 5-2 win over third-ranked Northeastern on Monday night at the

- Sophomore Colin Wilson scored a goal and added two assists in the title game, while classmate Nick Bonino scored his third goal of the tournament to claim Most Valuable Player honors.
- Sophomore Kevin Shattenkirk and seniors Chris Higgins and Brandon Yip each tallied two assists in the victory.
- BU, which got a 23-save performance from freshman goaltender Kieran Millan, extended its winning streak against Northeastern in the Beanpot to a record 14 games.
- Senior Jason Lawrence broke a 2-2 tie midway through the second period with what ended up being his third career game-winning goal in the Beanpot and the second in as many weeks.
- A third-period slashing penalty on sophomore Joe Pereira ended up producing two short-handed goals, as freshman David Warsofsky and Wilson scored within 30 seconds of each other to seal the victory.
- Junior goaltender Brad Thiessen made 29 saves in a losing effort for the Huskies. Thiessen captured the Eberly Trophy for posting a tournament-best .925 save percentage.
- Northeastern, which was attempting to win the Beanpot for the first time since 1988, got goals from freshman Mike McLaughlin and sophomore Tyler McNeely.
- The Terriers never trailed in the contest, using a power-play tally from sophomore Colby Cohen at 16:09 of the first to open the scoring. Northeastern, however, potted a power-play goal of its own when McLaughlin knocked in a rebound just 26 seconds left to play in the opening period to allow his team to head into the first intermission tied.
- Bonino gave BU the lead back with his first career short-handed tally just 27 seconds into the second, as the sophomore sent home a rebound from a shot by senior Brandon Yip that bounced off the caromed off the glass and right to Bonino's stick in the left slot.
- McNeely scored what would be the Huskies' final goal of the night at 10:01 of the second to make it a 2-2 affair, but Lawrence countered just 65 seconds with the game-winner off assists from senior Chris Higgins and Wilson.

BONINO EARNS LEAGUE HONOR

- Sophomore Nick Bonino was named Reebok Hockey East Co-Player of the Week on Monday, becoming the fourth Terrier this season to earn the honor.
- Bonino rallied the Terriers back from a 2-0 deficit against Harvard in the first round of the Beanpot, scoring his eighth and ninth goals of the season to draw BU even in an eventual 4-3 victory.
- In BU's 5-3 home triumph over UMass Lowell on Friday, Bonino earned a pair of assists.

TERRIER NOTES

FASTEST TO 20

BU reached the 20-win mark earlier than ever before in the program's 88-season history with its triumph over Harvard on Monday (Feb. 2) in the Beanpot. The previous record was beaten by one day, as the 1983-84 team earned its 20th victory on Feb. 3.

A GOOD WINTER FOR THE TERRIERS

BU's women's basketball (11 straight) and men's ice hockey (nine straight) teams are on a combined 20-game win streak. The Terrier women's hoops squad owns a one-game lead atop the America East standings and is off to its best-ever start in conference play (10-0). The men's basketball team had an eight-game winning streak snapped on Wednesday in Vermont and is just a half-game behind the Catamounts for first place in the league standings.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

BU is the only team in the country to have a perfect non-conference record (9-0-0). Last year, the Terriers went 2-6-1 in non-conference play. BU went undefeated in its 10 non-conference games (9-0-1) during the 1995-96 season, but had not won its first eight non-league contests since the 1991-92 campaign, when it was a perfect 12-0-0.

EVERYBODY CONTRIBUTES

BU has 11 players with 16 points or more this season. No other team in the country can lay claim to that accomplishment, but Denver is right behind with 10.

RANK AND FILE

- The Terriers are ranked first in both national polls for the second consecutive week, marking the first time that feat has been achieved by a BU squad since the 1997-98 squad sat atop four straight USCHO polls from Dec. 8 - Jan. 5.
- On Nov. 10 of this season, BU was ranked first in both national polls for the first time since March 20, 2006. The Terriers had not been at the top of the polls during the regular season since Jan. 5, 1998.
- In just its fourth season at the varsity level, the Terriers' women's ice hockey team earned its highest ranking ever in November when it was fourth in the USCHO.com poll.

ROOKIE STANDOUT BETWEEN THE PIPES

- Freshman Kieran Millan is 19-1-1 so far in his rookie campaign and his winning percentage of .929 is the best in the nation. He has earned the win in goal in each of his last 13 starts.
- Millan set the program record for best winning percentage in the first 20 decisions of a career (18-1-1, .925). Brian Durocher,

- Millan's goals against average of 1.68 is good for fifth in the country and he is the only Hockey East goaltender in the top 10. His .928 save percentage ranks ninth nationally.
- He has given up more than one goal in a period just once in his last 47 stanzas between the pipes.
- Millan was named Hockey East Goaltender of the Month last Monday for the second consecutive time, posting a 7-0-0 record and 1.00 goals against average in January after putting together a December that included a 2-0-1 record with a 1.30 goals against average.
- Millan earned a win in each of his first five starts, becoming the first BU netminder to do so since Michel Larocque (1995-96 season).

PARKER REACHES 800

- Jack Parker became just the third Division I hockey coach to earn 800 career victories following the Terriers' 3-1 road win over Merrimack on Jan. 30.
- Parker, who is the first hockey coach in NCAA history to win 800 games at one school, joins Ron Mason (924) and Jerry York (814) in the 800-win club.
- Matt Gilroy scored the game's first goal and added an assist. Colin Wilson earned two assists, while Brandon Yip and Colby Cohen each tallied a power-play goal.
- BU opened the scoring with consecutive goals just 72 seconds apart late in the first period and never lost the lead.

MR. WILSON

- Sophomore Colin Wilson leads all Hockey East players in points with 40 points on 13 goals and 27 assists. He ranks second in the nation in both points per game (1.48) and assists per game (1.00), trailing only Quinnipiac's Brian Leitch in both categories.
- Wilson has tallied six goals and 11 assists during BU's current nine-game win streak.
- Wilson, the 2008 Hockey East Rookie of the Year, was selected seventh overall in last year's NHL Entry Draft by the Nashville Predators.

WHO'S HOT?

- Senior Jason Lawrence has scored at least one point in nine of the last 10 games, tallying 13 points (8g, 5a) during the stretch.
- Sophomore Nick Bonino (3-4—7) and senior Brandon Yip (1-7—8) are both on five-game point streaks.
- Sophomore Colby Cohen has 10 points (3g, 7a) over the last eight games.

BLUE LINE SCORING BOOST

- BU boasts four of the top eight scoring defensemen in Hockey East: Colby Cohen (23

points, 1st), Matt Gilroy (21, T-2nd), Kevin Shattenkirk (20, T-4th) and David Warsofsky (16, 9th).

- Warsofsky ranks eighth in the nation in points per game among freshman defensemen at 0.55.

POWERFUL POWER PLAY

- BU's power play is currently ranked first in the nation at 25.0 percent (42-of-168).
- The Terriers have tallied 20 power-play goals in the last 10 contests, scoring at least one each game during the stretch.
- Senior Jason Lawrence has 12 power-play goals, tied with Jacques Lamoureux of Air Force for first in the nation. The last time a Terrier had 12 power-play tallies in a season was in 1995-96, with Jay Pandolfo (16) and Chris Drury (13) combining for 29.

FASTER PACE

BU has already surpassed its win total of 19 from last season. The Terriers entered the semester break this season with 11 wins for the first time since the 1999-00 campaign.

CAREER YEARS

- Eleven of BU's returnees from last season have either matched or surpassed their career high in goals, assists and/or points so far this season.
- Senior John McCarthy entered the year with 16 career points (8g, 8a) and already has 17 (5g, 12a) this season.

PENALTY KILL STEPS UP

The Terriers have successfully killed off 102 of their opponents' last 112 power plays, including streaks of 27 straight (Jan. 17-30) and 28 straight (Nov. 29 - Jan. 10). BU's penalty kill was ranked 35th in the nation after being swept by Vermont on Nov. 21-22, but now ranks eighth at 87.8 percent (159-of-181).

GET SHORTY

The Terriers already have seven shorthanded goals this season - including three in the Beanpot title game - after tallying just two in 2007-08. The seven shorthanded goals have been scored by seven different players.

A DIFFERENT DEFENSE

BU has allowed 57 goals through 28 games, giving up more than two goals only seven times. Last year, the Terriers let in 92 goals in their first 28 contests and gave up three or more goals in 12 of their first 16 games.

TOUGH TO BLANK

- The Terriers have gone 82 games without being shut out - the longest active streak in the country. BU was tied with UNH at 75 games before ending the Wildcats' streak on Jan. 23 (5-0 win).
- BU has not been handed a shutout loss in 84 games (1-0, vs. BC, 12/2/06) - the longest such streak in the nation.
- It has been nearly five years since the Terriers have been shut out on the road (4-0, at BC, 3/12/04).

QUICK HITS

- BU's combined special teams percentage of .576 is the best in the nation.
- The Terriers are also first in the country in scoring margin (1.97).
- Dating back to Feb. 8 of last season, the Terriers are 34-8-1 in their last 43 games.
- BU has scored more than twice as many goals as its opponents in both the first (37-17) and third periods (40-18) this season.
- The Terriers' offense is ranked first in the country, averaging 3.93 goals per game. The defense is allowing just 1.97 goals per contest, good for fifth. BU is the only school in the country to be ranked in the top five in both.
- BU has outshot its opponent in all but three of their games this season, but won all three times.
- The Terriers are a perfect 14-0-0 when they record 30 or fewer shots, but just 9-5-1 when they record more than 30 shots.

EQUAL-OPPORTUNITY OFFENSE

The Terrier offense has spread out its chances this season, as 11 players have recorded 55 shots or more with Jason Lawrence putting a team-high 81 shots on net. Three of the 11 players are defensemen.

ON BOTH ENDS

Among Hockey East teams, BU has scored the most goals (114) and allowed the fewest (57).

SIBLING RIVALRY

Freshman Chris Connolly is tied for 21st nationally among freshmen in points per game (0.765). His younger brother, Jack (a freshman at Minnesota Duluth), is ranked 27th at 0.73.

POSITIVE IMPACT

Led by freshman David Warsofsky's league-best plus-16 mark, 21 of the 22 BU skaters that have played this season have a positive plus/minus rating.

HOME RUN

The Terriers are 12-3-1 at home this season and are 20-4-1 in their last 25 contests at Agganis Arena. They had a stretch of 11 straight regular-season home wins snapped in a 4-3 setback against Vermont on Nov. 21.

SOPHOMORE SENSATIONS

- Sophomore Colin Wilson has a team-best 40 points on the year with 13 goals and 267 assists and classmate Nick Bonino is third on the squad with 29 points (10g, 19a).
- Fellow sophomores Colby Cohen (4-19—23) and Kevin Shattenkirk (6-14—20) rank first and tied for third among Hockey East defensemen in points per game at 0.85 and 0.74, respectively.

BALANCED ATTACK

- Nineteen different Terriers have scored at least one goal so far this season. Only Wisconsin (21), St. Cloud State (20) and North Dakota (20) have spread out their scoring more.
- Senior Jason Lawrence has a team-high 16 goals, while sophomore Colin Wilson has 13. Seniors Chris Higgins and Brandon Yip are right behind with 11 each and sophomore Nick Bonino has 10. Freshman Chris Connolly and junior Zach Cohen have tallied eight and seven, respectively.

THE BEST OFFENSE IS A GOOD DEFENSE

- Freshman Kieran Millan was named Hockey East Defensive Player of the Week for the third time this season on Jan. 26. Senior defenseman Matt Gilroy earned the honor the previous week.
- Millan allowed just one goal on 52 shots in BU's weekend sweep of New Hampshire. He recorded his second career shutout with a 22-save performance in a 5-0 home victory over the Wildcats before turning in a stand-out 29-save effort 3-1 win in Durham the following night. It marked the Terriers' first home-and-home sweep of New Hampshire since 2001.
- When UNH scored its lone goal of the weekend on Saturday (which went off the skate of a BU defender), it ended a streak of over 315 minutes during which Millan did not allow an even-strength goal.
- Millan who also named the national Player of the Week by Inside Hockey for his efforts.
- For the year, Gilroy has 18 points on five goals and 13 assists. The two-time All-American has played in 129 consecutive games and boasts a career rating of plus-66, including a plus-10 mark so far this season.
- Gilroy was one of Sports Illustrated's "Faces in the Crowd" on Jan. 26 and was the subject of a *New York Times* feature by George Vecsey.

EVEN STRENGTH A STRENGTH

BU has more than doubled up its opponents in even-strength play this season (61-30).

TWO TERRIERS AT WORLD JUNIORS

• Sophomores Colin Wilson and Kevin Shattenkirk served as alternate captains for the U.S. National Junior Team at the 2009 IIHF World Junior Championship, in Ottawa, Ont., on Dec. 26 - Jan. 5. Team USA placed fifth in the tournament.

• Wilson, Shattenkirk and UNH's James van Riemsdyk were named Team USA's three best players of the tournament. Shattenkirk was the top scoring defenseman in the event and tied for eighth overall with nine points (1g, 8a), while Wilson recorded eight points (3g, 5a).

• Wilson played at Juniors for the second straight year, as the centerman scored seven points, including a tournament-best six goals, for the 2008 U.S. squad that finished fourth. Shattenkirk made his World Junior debut.

• BU was one of five schools (Michigan, Minnesota, UNH, Notre Dame) to have multiple players named to the team and Hockey East led all conferences with five players selected.

HIGGINS TALLIES 100TH POINT

Senior Chris Higgins became the 75th Terrier to reach the 100-point mark with an assist on Colin Wilson's second-period power-play goal in a 4-1 win over St. Lawrence on Nov. 29.

OFF AND RUNNING

The Terriers won six of their first seven games for the first time since winning 11 of their first 12 games during the 1997-98 campaign.

DEFENSE MAKES OPENING STATEMENT

For the first time in program history, BU allowed two or fewer goals in each of its first six games.

OCTOBER REVERSAL

Last season, BU went 0-4-1 in October, resulting in its worst start since 1976. This year, the Terriers posted a 4-1-0 record in October.

TERRIER TRIO

• Following sophomore Nick Bonino's selection on Monday, four Terriers have earned Hockey East Reebok Player of the Week honors this season.

• Sophomore Colin Wilson earned the accolade on Nov. 10 after scoring a career-high four points (2g, 2a) in a 6-4 come-from-behind road victory over UMass Lowell.

• After scoring two power-play goals in a 7-2 victory over perennial power Michigan, senior Jason Lawrence earned the honor on Oct. 27.

• Sophomore Kevin Shattenkirk was the first honoree on Oct. 13 after scoring two goals in the Ice Breaker, including the game-winner against Michigan State, and bolstering a defense that held each opponent to one goal.

NTDP REPRESENTATION

Nine current BU players played for the Ann Arbor-based USA Hockey National Team Development Program, marking the highest total of any school in the country. Minnesota has eight former NTDP players on its roster, while Michigan has six. Each of the last three captains of the U.S. National Under-18 Team (Brian Strait, Kevin Shattenkirk, David Warsofsky) is part of the Terriers' defensive corps this season.

BU PICKED SECOND IN HOCKEY EAST

Boston University was picked second in the Hockey East Preseason Coaches' Poll, as announced at the league's annual media day on Sept. 29. The Terriers, who finished second in last year's regular-season standings, received 80 points, including three first-place votes, and trailed only Boston College, who received six first-place votes and 86 total points. BU has claimed seven Hockey East regular-season crowns and six conference tournament titles.

FUTURE PROS

Boston University has 13 NHL draftees on its roster this year, tying it with Michigan and North Dakota for the second most in the country. Minnesota has a nation-high 17 NHL picks. The 13 Terriers were taken by 10 different clubs between 2004-08. Three of the them were taken by the Colorado Avalanche (Kevin Shattenkirk, Colby Cohen, Brandon Yip).

WEARING THE "C"

Senior forward John McCarthy (Andover, Mass.) and classmate Matt Gilroy (North Bellmore, N.Y.) are serving as co-captains of the Terriers this season. Junior defenseman Brian Strait (Waltham, Mass.) is an assistant captain.

HONORING HIS BROTHER

Senior Matt Gilroy is just the second Terrier to wear a number higher than 40 (Jason Tapp wore 83 for his sister from 1998-02). The North Bellmore, N.Y., native made a promise to his mother, Peggy Ann, that he would always wear 97 to honor his brother, Timmy, who died after a bike accident. Timmy wore 97 while playing hockey at the Mite level. His brother, Kevin, is his freshman teammate this season.

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

Senior defenseman Matt Gilroy, who earned first-team All-America honors last season, was named to the Inside College Hockey Preseason All-America Third Team and the All-College Hockey News Preseason Second Team. Sophomore forward Colin Wilson earned a spot on the INCH Preseason Second Team, while freshman defenseman David Warsofsky was selected to the INCH Preseason All-Rookie Team.

WELCOME ABOARD

The Terriers welcome 10 freshmen to their roster this season, including six forwards, two defenseman and two goaltenders. The class was ranked third in the country by Inside College Hockey and half of the class has been drafted by an NHL team. The 10-man group represents eight different states and Canadian provinces.

88TH SEASON

The Terriers are in their 88th season of intercollegiate play and currently hold a 1354-777-128 (.628). BU's 1,354 wins are only surpassed by Minnesota (1,589 wins - 88 seasons) and Michigan (1,470 wins - 87 seasons). The three geographically separated programs represent a trio of the top NCAA Division I college hockey conferences in the WCHA (Minnesota), CCHA (Michigan) and Hockey East (BU), and hold a combined 18 national titles between them.

COACH PARKER NOTES

36th SEASON

- Jack Parker is now in his 36th season and holds an overall record of 804-411-98 (.650). His 804 wins mark the most of any college hockey coach at the same institution.
- He ranks second among active coaches in wins and fourth in winning percentage.

VS. THE BLACK BEARS

Parker has coached 100 games against Maine and has posted a record of 50-41-9 (.545). In league play, Parker is 44-34-9 (.558) versus the Black Bears, including a 37-31-9 (.539) mark in Hockey East.

VS. WHITEHEAD

This marks the 43rd time that Parker and Tim Whitehead have been on opposing benches. In the previous 42 meetings, Parker holds a 23-15-4 (.595) record. Since Whitehead took over the Maine helm in 2001, Parker holds a 14-9-3 (.596) advantage. When Whitehead was the head coach at UMass Lowell, the two met on 16 occasions and Parker was 9-6-1 (.594).

GOOD COMPANY

Head coach Jack Parker ranks second among active coaches with 804 career victories. Of the seven other active bench bosses with 400 or more career wins, BU has faced six of them (Jerry York, Boston College; Rick Comley, Michigan State; Red Berenson, Michigan; George Gwozdecky, Denver; Dick Umile, New Hampshire; Joe Marsh, St. Lawrence) this season.
