### ON THE ROAD AGAIN

• The Boston University women's ice hockey team will open up a three-game road trip Saturday when they face Vermont in the first game of a weekend series that is set to conclude on Sunday.  
 • Puck drop for both games is scheduled for 2 p.m.



### BACK TO BURLINGTON

• This is the Terriers' second trip to Burlington, Vermont, this season.  
 • BU faced off against Cornell and Ohio State as part of the inaugural Windjammer Classic that was hosted by UVM on Nov. 28 and 29.  
 • The Terriers suffered a 4-2 setback against the Big Red before besting the Buckeyes, 5-3.

### LAST TIME AGAINST VERMONT

• The Terriers defeated the Catamounts, 5-2, on Oct. 25 at Walter Brown Arena.  
 • Junior Maddie Elia led the Terriers with two goals and an assist while senior Rebecca Russo and junior Sarah Steele each contributed a goal and an assist apiece.  
 • Sophomore Victoria Bach tallied the other Terrier goal.  
 • Freshman Sammy Davis collected her first

two collegiate assists and was one of nine different Terriers to record at least one helper.  
 • Sophomore Rebecca Leslie, senior captain Kayla Tutino, junior Alexis Crossley, and

seniors Sarah Lefort and Alexis Woloschuk all had an assist as well.

• Sophomore Erin O'Neil stopped 23 shots to earn the victory between the pipes.  
 • Dayna Colang and Rachel Ade scored for UVM, with Colang's marker bringing Vermont to within 3-1 before the Terriers scored a pair of insurance goals over the final two periods.

### HISTORY WITH THE CATAMOUNTS

• BU owns a 25-5-3 all-time record against Vermont, including a 10-4-1 mark at Gutterson Fieldhouse.  
 • The Terriers have won four straight and five of their last six games against UVM.  
 • During that four-game win streak, BU has averaged 7.25 goals per game while allowing a mere 1.75 goals per game.  
 • BU has lost two straight games to the Catamounts just once, and that came in a weekend series at Gutterson during the 2013-14 campaign.

## BEST OF BU AGAINST UVM

- Kayla Tutino has enjoyed plenty of success against Vermont in her career at BU, including a six-point performance (5g, 1a) in the 2015 Hockey East quarterfinal games.

- Overall, Tutino has tallied a point in nine of her 13 games against UVM, totaling 17 points (8g, 9a).

- Sarah Lefort has collected 12 points (3g, 9a) in her career against Vermont.

- Victoria Bach has notched four goals and six assists in just six fixtures against UVM.

- Rebecca Leslie has also been great in her brief career against Vermont, having scored six goals and added three helpers in six total games.

- Maddie Elia has secured seven career points against UVM with two goals and five assists.

- Lillian Ribeirinha-Braga has chipped in six career helpers and also had a goal on Jan. 25, 2015.

- Victoria Hanson went 4-0-0 against Vermont last season with a 1.09 goals-against average and a .945 save percentage.

- Erin O'Neil has never allowed more than two goals in either of her two starts against UVM.

## CHECKING IN ON THE CATAMOUNTS

- Vermont enters the weekend having

earned three of four points at Maine last weekend thanks to a 4-1 win on Jan. 10 and a 3-3 tie on Jan. 9.

- UVM outshot the Black Bears, 44-29, and scored twice in the third period to erase a 3-1 deficit and salvage the draw.

- The Catamounts then scored three third-period goals on Jan. 10 to secure a victory.

- Senior Dayna Colang leads the Catamounts in points (19), goals (10) and assists (9); she is one of just two Catamounts with at least 10 points.

- Sophomore Taylor Willard has four goals and six assists for 10 points.

- UVM averages just 1.74 goals per game while allowing 3.17 goals per game.

- Junior Madison Litchfield is 3-9-1 with a 2.76 goals-against average and an .898 save percentage in 15 games, 13 of which she started.

- Sophomore Molly Depew is 3-7-0 with a 3.65 GAA and an .880 save percentage.

## TERRIERS ALMOST KNOCK OFF NO. 1 BC

- BU held a 3-2 advantage early in the second period but BC scored twice to regain the lead and then held on through a scoreless third period to earn a 4-3 victory on Saturday at Walter Brown Arena.

- Seniors Kayla Tutino, Dakota Woodworth and Rebecca Russo all scored for the Terriers.

- Senior Sarah Lefort finished with two assists to extend her point streak to 10 games.
- Sophomore Erin O'Neil stopped 26 shots, including all 11 she faced in the third period.
- Junior Samantha Sutherland, sophomore Rebecca Leslie and senior Lillian Ribeirinha-Braga each added an assist as well.

## PRETTY GOOD AGAINST NO. 1

- The Terriers have been the only team to come within a goal of defeating BC, which remained undefeated after Saturday's victory.
- Twice now the Terriers have suffered 4-3 setbacks to the Eagles, with the first one coming on Nov. 10 in OT at BC.
- If BU and BC meet again in late February or early March, history suggests that it will bode well for the Terriers; BU went 1-0-1 against a top-ranked BC squad after Feb. 20 last year and also bested BC in the 2014 Hockey East title game.

## PLAYING GREAT DESPITE A LOSS

- BU may have lost on Saturday, but the Terriers have been playing some terrific hockey over the last 10 games.
- The Terriers finished 2015 on a 7-1-1 run, with both losses coming by an average of 1.5 goals per game.
- Over their last 10 tilts, the Terriers have outscored their opponents, 41-26, and averaged 4.10 goals per game.

## LEFORT EXTENDS POINT STREAK

- That 7-2-1 stretch for the Terriers has been in large part to the resurgence of senior Sarah Lefort.
- Lefort extended her point streak to 10 games with her two-assist effort against the Eagles.
- In those 10 contests, Lefort has scored nine goals and added 12 assists for 21 points, and she has factored on four of the seven game-winning goals (2g, 2a).
- Lefort has multiple points in each of her last three games.
- Prior to the streak, Lefort had just one goal and three assists for four points in 10 games.

## ANY MORE POINT STREAKS?

- Three other Terriers have one, led by senior captain Kayla Tutino, who has a point in each of her last three tilts (2g,

3a).

- In addition, senior Dakota Woodworth (2g), junior Samantha Sutherland (3a) and sophomore Rebecca Leslie (2a) have all secured at least one point in back-to-back contests.
- Leslie now has a point in six of her last seven games, totaling one goal and six assists in that stretch.

## WHO ELSE IS PLAYING WELL?

- Sophomore Victoria Bach's four-game point streak was snapped against BC, but she still has six goals and five assists for 11 points over her last five fixtures.
- Bach factored on two of the Terriers' three game-winners during that four-game streak and has recorded 10 goals and seven assists for 17 points in her last nine contests.
- Junior Alexis Crossley had a five-game point streak snapped on Dec. 6, but notched two assists in her next game and has collected seven points (1g, 6a) in her last eight tilts.

second-most efficient power play in the country despite.

- The Terriers have converted on 41.7 percent of their opportunities, going 5-of-12 during that stretch en route to a 3-1-1 record.
- The five power-play markers rank second in the nation behind Robert Morris' 11, thanks to the Colonials' absurd 26 power-play chances.
- Meanwhile, the Terriers have the 24th fewest power-play attempts of any team during the last five games.

### BACH, LESLIE GOLDEN FOR CANADA

- Sophomores Victoria Bach and Rebecca Leslie claimed gold for Team Canada at the Nations Cup (Jan. 4-7) in Füssen, Germany, on Jan. 7.
- Bach lit the lamp in the gold-medal game, which was won in overtime, 4-3; she also added two assists during the tournament to finish with three points.
- This is the second time this season a Terrier has been on international duty for Canada; Sarah Lefort helped Canada win silver at the Four Nations Cup in November.
- For Bach and Leslie, their participation in the Nations Cup was their second time donning a Canada sweater; Bach secured a gold medal with last year's squad and also skated with Leslie for Canada in a three-game series against the United States in August.

### SOPHOMORE SENSATIONS

- Victoria Bach and Rebecca Leslie have avoided any sophomore slump this season, as both players have turned in impressive numbers in 2015.
- Leslie leads the team with 28 points while Bach is next with 27.
- Entering the weekend, Leslie is tied for third in the league and tied for fourth in the NCAA with 23 assists.
- Bach is fourth in Hockey East and tied for 12th in the NCAA with 13 goals.

### WAY TOO OFFENSIVE

- The Terriers are sixth in the nation with an average of 3.55 goals per game.
- Amazingly, they are only third in the conference in goals per game, since Boston College (5.48) and Northeastern (4.43) are second and third, respectively in scoring offense.

### TOP-TIER TALENT IN HOCKEY EAST

- BU boasts three skaters in the top 10 of the conference's scoring race entering this weekend.
- Sophomores Rebecca Leslie is sixth with 28 points, followed by Bach in seventh (27 points) and Lefort in a tie for eighth (25).
- Senior Rebecca Russo is right outside the top 10, tied for 12th with 22 points.
- Bach, Leslie and Lefort are also in the top 10 in points per game, with Lefort fifth (1.32), Leslie in sixth (1.27) and

- Sophomore Erin O'Neil ended 2015 on a high note thanks to her 27-save shutout at Providence.
- It was the first shutout of O'Neil's collegiate career; she finished a shutout at Maine on Oct. 24, 2014, after Victoria Hanson got hurt with 13:01 remaining in regulation.
- O'Neil's shutout was the first by a Terrier since Nov. 15, 2013, when Kerrin Sperry made 28 saves in a 2-0 win over St. Cloud State in Vail, Colorado.

## TOP LINE TAKING OVER

- The Terriers' trio of senior Sarah Lefort, sophomore Victoria Bach and senior captain Kayla Tutino have been terrific over the last three games.
- Against BC last Saturday, Tutino lit the lamp thanks to a nifty Lefort feed, with Lefort also adding another helper.
- At Providence on Dec. 9, the trio had a hand in four of the six goals and finished with seven points (4g, 3a).
- Bach and Lefort scored two goals apiece in that win.
- On Dec. 6 against UConn, they combined for all four goals and five assists.
- Lefort logged two of the goals while Bach and Tutino each had a marker.
- The line started the game and scored just 37 seconds into the contest.

- On the season, those three Terriers have combined for 29 goals and 41 assists for 69 points.

## SHORTHANDED SUCCESS

- BU has scored a shorthanded goal in three of its last four games entering this weekend.
- The Terriers are tied for second with BC and Northeastern for the most shorthanded markers in the country with five.
- Senior Rebecca Russo notched her second shorthanded strike of the season against BC on Saturday.
- She also scored one on Dec. 5 which was assisted by sophomore Rebecca Leslie; Leslie also had the primary helper on Russo's marker against BC.
- On Dec. 6, senior Sarah Lefort collected an unassisted shorthanded tally en route to a Terrier win.
- Leslie has the other two shorthanded strikes this year.

## TERRIERS WASTING NO TIME

- BU leads the country with six goals and nine assists for 15 points in the first minute of a period this season.
- The Terriers scored twice within the first 40 seconds of the first and second periods on Dec. 6 against UConn.
- Senior captain Kayla Tutino opened the scoring 37 seconds into the proceedings and sophomore Victoria Bach notched a goal only 35 seconds into the second stanza.
- BU nearly added to that total against BC, but the Terriers scored 1:05 into the second stanza.
- That goal did move the Terriers into a tie for first with nine goals within the first two minutes of a period this year.

## RARE THIRD PERIOD SLIP UP

- The Terriers entered the weekend of Dec. 5-6 as one of the best teams in the country at closing out games, but UConn managed to erase a three-goal deficit and earn a 4-4 tie on the 5th.
- Prior that draw, BU was 29-0-0 over the last two seasons with a lead after 40 minutes.
- BU held on for the win on Dec. 6 and on Dec. 9 after having a 40-minute lead; the Terriers have lost just once with a lead after two periods since the beginning of the 2013-14 campaign.
