****The Student Host should review the rules below, receive compliance education, and agree to follow the rules by signing below **PRIOR** to the Official Visit taking place.****

The role of a student host is very important in the recruiting process. You have the responsibility to understand and abide by NCAA and MWC rules. Additionally, you are responsible for ensuring compliance with the Department of Athletics Campus Visit Recruiting Policies and the Boise State University Student Code of Conduct as outlined in the Student Handbook. You may be subject to disciplinary action if you violate these policies during a campus visit for the above named prospective student-athlete. Please carefully review the following guidelines:

1. You must be a full-time enrolled student-athlete at Boise State, and a designated qualifier by the NCAA Initial Eligibility Center or a non-qualifier who has been awarded an AA degree.
2. A maximum of \$40 per day (\$20 for each additional prospect) of the visit may be provided to cover all actual costs of entertaining yourself, the prospect, the prospect's parents, legal guardian or spouse, excluding the cost of meals and admission to campus athletic events.
3. Student host money may not be used to purchase anything other than food and/or entertainment for yourself or the prospect (e.g., t-shirts, hats, sweatshirts, blankets, toothbrush, deodorant).
4. No cash may be given to the prospect or anyone accompanying the prospect.
5. You may not use vehicles provided or arranged for by any coach, institutional staff member, or booster of the athletic program. Prospects are not permitted to use or drive your car.
6. You may not transport the prospect or anyone accompanying the prospect more than 30 miles from campus.
7. You should not allow recruiting conversations to occur on- or off-campus between the prospect and a booster of Boise State athletics. If an unplanned meeting occurs, only an exchange of greeting is permissible.
8. A prospect may engage in recreational workout activities as long as the activities are not organized or observed by members of the coaching staff and are not designed to test the athletics ability of the prospect.
9. You may receive a complimentary admission (no hard ticket) when accompanying a prospect to a campus event.
10. It is the responsibility of the student host to notify the coach at the conclusion of the official visit as to how and where the money was spent, and to turn in any receipts or remaining cash.
11. Involvement in **any type of inappropriate behavior or activities** could result in your and/or the prospect's loss of scholarship, eligibility, or participation in the athletic program.
12. You may not publicize a prospect's visit to campus in any way. This includes publicizing his/her visit through social media, i.e. Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, etc. It is not permissible to post pictures of yourself and the recruit until after the recruit has signed an NLI.

Additionally:

1. The use of sex, prostitution, strippers, alcohol, drugs, gambling and any other illegal activities are strictly prohibited.
2. Curfews for all visiting recruits is set for _____.
3. Private or chartered airplanes cannot be used to transport the recruits to campus. Only commercial air travel at coach-class fares can be used.
4. Standard vehicles must be used to transport the recruit to and from campus.
5. Recruits may only be housed in standard lodging and meals must be similar to those offered on campus.
6. The institution is prohibited from arranging miscellaneous recruiting aides (e.g., personalized jerseys, personalized audio/video scoreboard presentations) and any game-day simulations during the recruit's official visit.

CODE OF CONDUCT – POST OFFICIAL VISIT REVIEW
