College/University Team Entries:

Each coach must have a Direct Athletics username and password for his/her school – all meet entries for Boise State Track and Field meets will run through Direct Athletics.

Non-Collegiate/Unattached/Club Entries:

A limited number of open athletes will be accepted to enhance the fields.

- Please visit www.directathletics.com. You must create an INDIVIDUAL athlete account.
- If you are entering a club/open relay or are a coach submitting multiple club/open entries from one club affiliation, you should create a team account at www.directathletics.com and select “Club” as the team type.
- Open/club relays must be entered through a TEAM account – not an individual account.
- All athletes not registered by collegiate teams must pay online via credit card to be accepted into the field – if your entry fee is not paid online by the entry deadline, your entry will be scratched.

Entry Marks: Accurate seed marks will assist us in accurately seeding the races and providing the best competition for your athletes. **All entries must be verifiable marks from either the 2015 or 2016 INDOOR track season – no outdoor times will be accepted and any non-verifiable TFRRS times will not be accepted.**

Meet management will use their discretion when setting up heats and flights.

NCAA Rule 4-1: Misconduct is any act of dishonesty, unsportsmanlike conduct, unprofessional or breach of law occurring at the locale of the competition or warm-up that discredits the event or intercollegiate athletics. Misconduct includes the intentional reporting of false marks for entry purposes. Acts of misconduct are subject to reprimand or ejection by the referee or meet management.

Individuals registering for any meet are **NOT** assured of a place in the meet. Meets held at Boise State University give preference to collegiate teams and their competing individuals FIRST and then will fill in the fields of competition with the individual/unattached individuals that register for the meet.

FIELD SIZES MAY BE LIMITED IN ALL EVENTS - Based on the number of Entries

LANES 1-6 may be utilized in the 200M and 400M dashes

Entry Fees: \$15 per athlete

All athletes not registered by collegiate teams must pay online via credit card at www.directathletics.com to be able to be accepted into the field. Collegiate teams may pay entry fees online via credit card prior to the meet or by cash or check the day of the meet at the designated packet pick up area at Jacksons Indoor Facility. Teams must have made payment prior to the start of competition or that team/individual will be scratched from the meet.

Spike Specifications

No needle or compression (Christmas tree) spikes will be allowed. Only pyramid spikes that are ¼ inch or less will be allowed. The only exception will be for high jump spikes that have a recessed spike plate where 3/8 inch pyramid or compression spikes will be allowed (so that ¼ inch is exposed). Spike size will be strictly enforced. Athletes not complying will not be allowed to compete.

Heat Sheets and Results

- Accepted entries and heat sheets will be posted within 24 hours after entries are closed on the Track and Field page at www.broncosports.com.
- Results will be posted on the boards on either side of the training room and on www.broncosports.com after the completion of the meet.

Team Scoring

Each meet will be team scored separately by division using invitational scoring standards (10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1).

Idaho Center/Jacksons Indoor Facility - 16200 Idaho Center Blvd, Nampa, Idaho 83687

The Jacksons Indoor Facility features a 200m Mondo Track. The track has six lanes on the oval and eight lanes on the straightaway. The facility offers separate weight and shot put areas, two 150 ft. long jump/triple jump runway, one pole vault runway, and one high jump area. Men's and Women's showers are available. Teams should furnish their own towels, and soap. Athletes are responsible for their own valuables.

Warm Up Areas

- The Jacksons Indoor Facility is open the day before the meet from 1:00 pm and 6:00 pm for practice.
- The day of the meet, participants may warm up around the concourse area of the track as well as on the straight for sprints and hurdles. Throwers may only warm up in the throws area. No athletes are allowed to be on the track during oval races.

Event Check-in

The Clerk of the Course is located at the southeast end of the track. Athletes "first call" check-in is 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

Implement Weigh-ins

All implements will be weighed in at the throws area up to 45 minutes prior to the start of the event.

Starting Heights

Starting heights and progressions for the pole vault and high jump will be provided during the pre-meet warm up and based on entries.

Athletic Training

Athletic training staff will have access to ice, water, and modalities or may bring their own and will be allowed to set up in the areas provided. Trainers will have access to all competition areas as needed.
