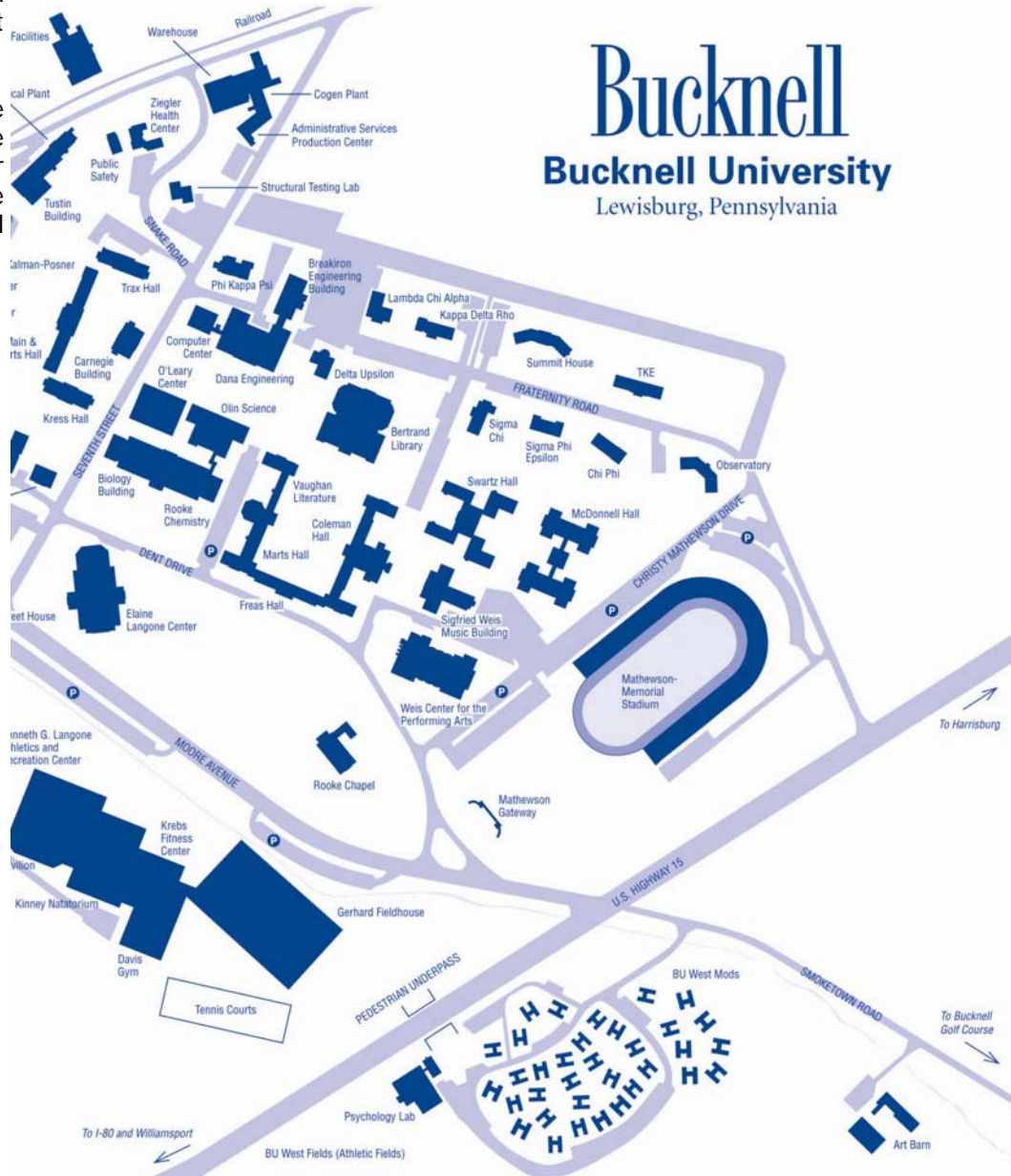


Visiting Football Athletic Trainers

Your sideline set up will consist of two ten gallon coolers of water, 240 lbs. of ice (less during cooler weather), 4 sleeves of cups, one ice chest filled with ice bags, and one biohazard container. There will also be a hose to refill water as needed.

We will have our team physician, two orthopedic surgeons, and an ambulance present at all games.

Facilities

Stadium

The Stadium Training Room is located on the East side of Christy Mathewson Memorial Stadium. Access to this facility may be made by entering through the door labeled "BISON FOOTBALL". The training room will be located immediately to your left. The training room will open 2 1/2 hours prior to each home game.

Sports Medicine Center

The Sports Medicine Center is located in the back of Davis Gymnasium. Access is through the main entrance of the Recreation and Athletic Center into the new portion of Davis Gym. The Sports Medicine Center will be open two hours prior to a scheduled event, and will close approximately one hour after the event.

Services

Treatments will be limited to athletes accompanied by a trainer or a written prescription from an athletic trainer or team physician. **Athletes requesting to be taped must bring sufficient supplies.** Please call ahead to make arrangements if an athletic trainer or student trainer is not traveling with your team.

Event Supplies

For your convenience, we will provide the following:

1. Taping area—located in the Sports Medicine Center.
2. Ice Bags
3. Water and Cups
4. Splints and Crutches (home bench)

Event Supplies

In-Season

The Office of Athletic Training Services has established the following policy for coverage of home events:

1. A certified athletic trainer must be present (on-site) during home *in-season* contests.
2. The training room must have a certified athletic trainer present to manage the delivery of athletic training services to those sports engaged in practice or those student-athletes who require rehabilitation.
3. Student assistants serve as an extension of the staff trainers' authority while on campus, and are in communication with a certified trainer via two-way radios.

Out-of-Season

The Office of Athletic Training Services recognizes that a minimum standard of health care is due student-athletes. We have limited human resources and therefore cannot cover every event which is scheduled. When a certified athletic trainer is not available, the head coach is responsible for first-aid and for summoning emergency care.

Advanced emergency care will be provided through the Evangelical Hospital Emergency Room or Geisinger Medical Center Emergency Room
